INTERNATIONAL TRAP GRAND PRIX FOR DISABLED SHOOTERS

DATE AND VENUE:

The International Trap Grand Prix for Disabled Shooters will take place next September 2-4, 2011 at the Tiro a Volo Cascata delle Marmore (ITA).

PARTICIPATION:

Open to Italian and International disabled shooters, licensed members of ISSF Member National Federations.

RULES AND REGULATIONS:

The competition will be conducted according to ISSF Rules and Regulations concerning Trap Shooting. The equipment control will be conducted according to the ISSF Rules and Regulations.

FUNCTIONAL CLASSIFICATION:

Competitors will be classified according to their functional ability as determined by a functional classification panel composed by a doctor and/or physiotherapist and a coach, both recognized by FITAV. The Functional Classification routines shall be performed on Friday, Sept. 02, 2011 time and venue to be communicated later on.

TRAINING:

All ranges used for the Grand Prix shall be available for training sessions on the day prior to the event. After 4:00 PM such availability can be subject to temporary suspension, in case of technical needs.

PROGRAMME

Saturday, Sept. 03rd - 75 targets
Sunday, Sept. 04th - 50 targets followed by finals (first 6 ranked in each class) and shoot-offs

FIREARMS AND AMMUNITIONS:

All shooters must declare all the firearms and ammunition to be brought into Italy and return to the Organizing Committee not later than July 22th, 2011. The armory at the shooting range will be opened from the official arrival day till the official departure day, not earlier. It is not allowed to take any arms and ammunition out of the shooting range.

ACCOMMODATION:

Accommodation and meals will be offered free to all international participants, courtesy of FITAV.

TRANSFERS:

Transfers between the nearest international airport (Rome Fiumicino) and the shooting range shall be offered free to all international participants.
