

CPSA WORLD CHAMPIONSHIPS 2021



FAQ Sheet

1. Do I need to check in for each of my events?

a. No, you only need to check in once! As you have received your pack you have been signed in for all events. Please take a photo of the front of your envelope, as this contains all your start times.

2. How do I get to the different courses?

a. The FITASC Open and English Sporting Prelim competitions are being held at the ground and will take a c.10-minute walk from the clubhouse to reach. For the World Sporting and World Sportrap Championships, shuttle buses will be taking shooters to the relevant courses. Please be at a pick-up point **no later than** 45-minutes before your shooting time. Bring all shooting equipment. Masks must be worn in the buses. There will be no unofficial vehicle access to the course, you must use the buses. Please do not be late, we cannot guarantee bus traffic times.

3. What facilities will there be while I am out shooting?

a. Toilets and water stations will be available throughout all courses.

4. How much time will each course take me to shoot?

a. Allow three hours per Sporting course, one day for the FITASC Open and two hours for Sportrap. This does not include travel time to and from the courses.

5. How do I get back from the course?

a. If you were collected by shuttle bus for the World Sporting and World Sportrap courses, you will be dropped back to the E.J. Churchill clubhouse by the shuttle bus from the drop-off/pick-up points. If you are at the ground for the FITASC Open or Prelim English Sporting, please make your own way back to the clubhouse following relevant signs.

6. Is there catering on site?

a. Yes, the Trade Village outside the E.J. Churchill clubhouse will have a range of catering suppliers, along with businesses from the clay-shooting trade, as well as Sponsors, with their stands spread throughout the village. Do enjoy a walk about the village and ask any questions you may have at the relevant stands. You may also enjoy your own picnic (no alcohol to be brought onto site, only site-purchased alcoholic beverages may be consumed).

7. Can I use cash or card payments?

a. Card is preferred payment all-round.

8. Where can I see my scores?

a. Scores will be available live on the website as completed scorecards come-in, via cpsa.co.uk/scores and selecting E.J. Churchill Group Ltd, and the date and discipline. The CPSA-site office is for urgent issues with scores only, please keep the office as free as possible. You will be directed to the website if you wish to check your scores.

9. Can I buy more cartridges if I need them?

a. Yes, fibre/plastic are sold by E.J. Churchill's gunroom in the clubhouse.

10. Will there be a pool shoot?

a. Yes, please visit the EJ Churchill reception in the clubhouse to purchase pool shoot tickets. The CPSA site office cannot sell pool shoot tickets.

11. Can I store my guns somewhere?

a. E.J. Churchill's Gunroom in the clubhouse are offering gun storage for £10 a day per gun, or £40 for the week per gun.
