Protection of your Shotgun Certificate and Legal Expenses (For Full members only)

In the event of a shotgun certificate being revoked or not renewed

There have been some concerns over firearms licencing decision making, resulting in revocation of or refusal to renew shotgun certificates. Some police forces leave it to the courts to decide, but it is expensive for certificate holders to challenge this decision. By providing enhanced cover we can support members who have been treated unreasonably and help them continue to enjoy their sport.

Since its introduction in April 2014, the CPSA has supported a number of claims on behalf of members. The authorities appear to be tightening up on certification and it could be something as trivial as an argument with a neighbour that sparks interest in your suitability to own a gun.

Being covered for this type of claim will also help us to stand together to defend the legal rights of responsible shotgun owners without the worry of the potential costs for the individual
