My top tip for others would be to believe in yourself – use different competitions as training regardless of the discipline as this will help you gain that competition experience. Above all it is important to remember

that shooting is just a game, so enjoy it, and if you miss one target learn to forget it and focus on your next shot/routine.

Helice was based on a minimum of 10 targets at a minimum of one ground. CPSA categories are based on the member's shooting category on 30 November 2022.
