The Tournament will be held over 150 targets over 2 days and Teams will consist of the following:

Seniors:	Teams of 10 shooters (5 scores to count)
Ladies:	Teams of 3 shooters (2 scores to count)
Juniors:	Teams of 3 shooters (2 scores to count) Under 21 on 01/01/2019
Veterans:	Teams of 3 shooters (2 scores to count) 55 or over on 01/01/2019
Super-Veterans:	Teams of 3 shooters (2 scores to count) 65 or over on 01/01/2019

The entry fee is £48 per person for the HCIT competition. Please use the attached ICTSC Team application form. ALL payments and entries should be made directly to Mulroy CPC.

Squad selection will take place at 3pm on Thursday 22nd August 2019 at Mulroy Shooting Ground, with Team Managers required to be in attendance.

Practice will be available at the ground from Monday to Thursday from 10am to 6pm, with an Open competition taking place on Sunday 25th August 2019

The post-Tournament banquet and Team photographs will also take place at the Clanree Hotel, Derry Road, Bunnagee, Letterkenny, Co Donegal (00 353 74 912 4369) will take place at 7.30pm, with the banquet commencing at 8:00pm. The cost per certificate is €40 (plus €5 p+p) and applications plus payment (cheques or drafts made payable to: The Superintendent, An Garda Siochana) should be sent to Salem Rayes, Gortmacall, Milford, Letterkenny, Co Donegal, Ireland. The minimum age for the granting of a visitor's certificate is 16 and therefore all Team members MUST be a minimum of 16 years at the time of the event and we would like to remind you that a licence is required for each firearm. We would request that applications for visitor's certificates be made en-bloc please and at least 40 days in advance of the event to allow for processing.
