The Tournament will be held over 200 targets and Teams will consist of the following:

Seniors:	Teams of 12 shooters (10 scores to count)
Ladies:	Teams of 3 shooters (2 scores to count)
Juniors:	Teams of 2 shooters (2 scores to count) Under 21 on 01/01/2017
Veterans:	Teams of 2 shooters (2 scores to count) 55 or over on 01/01/2017
Super-Veterans:	Teams of 2 shooters (2 scores to count) 65 or over on 01/01/2017

The entry fee is £60 per person for the HCIT competition. Please use the attached ICTSC Team application form. ALL payments and entries should be made directly with the ICTSA National Shooting ground.

Squad selection will take place at 3pm on Thursday 31st August 2017 at ICTSA National Shooting Ground, with Team Managers required to be in attendance.

Practice will be available at the ground from Monday to Thursday (10am-8pm), with the ABT British Open competition taking place on Sunday 3rd September 2017.

The post-Tournament banquet and Team photographs will also take place at The Ashbourne House Hotel, Ashbourne, Co Meath. The photographs' will take place at 7.30pm, with the banquet commencing at 8:00pm. Banquet tickets will cost £40 per person, with final numbers attending, top table names, and any special dietary requirements, all required at least 3 weeks prior to the event. ALL payments for the banquet to be made directly with ICTSA National Shooting Ground.
