CLAIRE BAGEHOT ENDORSES EVOLUTION SHOOTING EYEWEAR

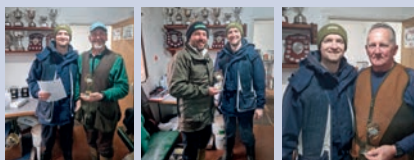

2026 ICTSF NEW ZEALAND WORLD DTL CHAMPIONSHIPS

The World DTL Championships took place from 15-17 March, and the 2026 DTL New Zealand National Championships were held from 7-14 March at Canterbury Clay Target Club in Christchurch.

Before the Opening Ceremony, the England team gathered for the Captain's talk – John Barnett encouraged the team to enjoy the competition without stressing themselves out and do the best that they can for both themselves and country. The Opening Ceremony started late afternoon with England being led out by Mark Shaw, as the England name bearer. Unfortunately, some of the National teams were absent due to the commotion in the Middle East and had more worries of getting back home than arriving. We all have a story to tell of getting to New Zealand, but we had a full complement of shooters which goes

to show the determination of shooting for your country. The march was followed by canapes and the opening of the competition. This was carried out by the local MP who fired the first shot.

At the end of the first day, it was looking good for the Veterans, Super Vets and Juniors with Edward Armett posting a 100/299, Toby Hurstfield in the high 290 plus and Mark Shaw a 100/296, Ian Dougal on a 294 for the Veterans and two Super Vets Clive Weston and Colin Heathcote, both on 292, which gave the 3 teams a chance with good podium finishes if they did well on the second day. The Senior and Ladies teams were a few points outside third places.

The second day for the team events saw the Vets, Super Vets and Juniors push really hard and they all finished in silver medal position, which certainly boosted the team's morale. With the team event over all eyes were on the third day where all the individual position are contested.

Every competitor shoots another 50 targets then after that the top 10% from each Class/Category go forward to decide the final individual honours. For the England team it was all about the young (Juniors) and the not so young (Super Vets). The way the two legendary Juniors of Edward Armett (Cockett Farm) and Toby Hurstfield (Holmes Chapel) and the experience of long-time campaigner super vet Colin Heathcote showed no emotion in their body demeanour, what was going through their head I just don't know.

What I can tell you was that the last 50 targets were hit to smithereens! It gave Edward a silver in the Juniors to go with



his team silver and sixth overall which at that World level it takes some doing (889/900). Not to be outdone, Toby shot a cracking last 50 to give him first in A, to add to his team silver, ten points in front of his nearest rival.

Colin does what he does best in keeping in the zone which he did, winning a well-deserved bronze. Veteran and Super Vets are hard categories to win owing to the number of experienced shooters.

For the Seniors and Ladies, it just never happened with the scores, but in true professionalism they rallied around the other categories to support them.

New cap junior Lewis Dalton finished on a high on the third day.

Gordon and son Aaron McDowell friends and competitors on the circuit came as individuals from Northern Ireland with Aaron taking home second in A class.

Sam Winterburn just lost the High Gun in a shoot-off from the triples in

the NZ Championships and I took silver in my class in the same event. Captain John Barnett played a major part in the England team. All England competitors contributed to both the England Team and the event in one way or another.

The Canterbury Clay Target Club worked very hard to make it happen, and did it in spectacular fashion. There are always key figures in the Club, and I would like to mention Sheryl the Administrator, Hamish the President, Arthur Cozens from the ICTSF plus all the committee.

The last word has to go the eventual High Gun winner from Australia, Dan Power who after an exciting shoot off with fellow Aussie, Royce Normington both on 892 took the title. So, congratulations to him and all the teams and individuals who took part. The next DTL Worlds are in two years time and will be held in Ireland at Esker. 🍀





ENGLISH OPEN COMPAK

been a challenging day and the conditions had a part to play in the scores, but the wind had been reasonably consistent.

The ladies champion was Georgia Moule who shot 92ex100 and Charlotte Kerwood took second place with Amy Easeman in third. Juniors was won by Connor Davies, seniors by Paul Gillett and Veterans by Anthony Dean.

Georgia Moule told me: "I'm absolutely over the moon to have won in one of my favourite disciplines. It was a fantastic event with brilliant targets, made even more memorable by taking place through rain, wind and hail." Henry Arnold, also happy with his day said: "I'm absolutely delighted... I've had a good weekend and this has just topped it off."

It's great to see events like this sold out and Orston is having

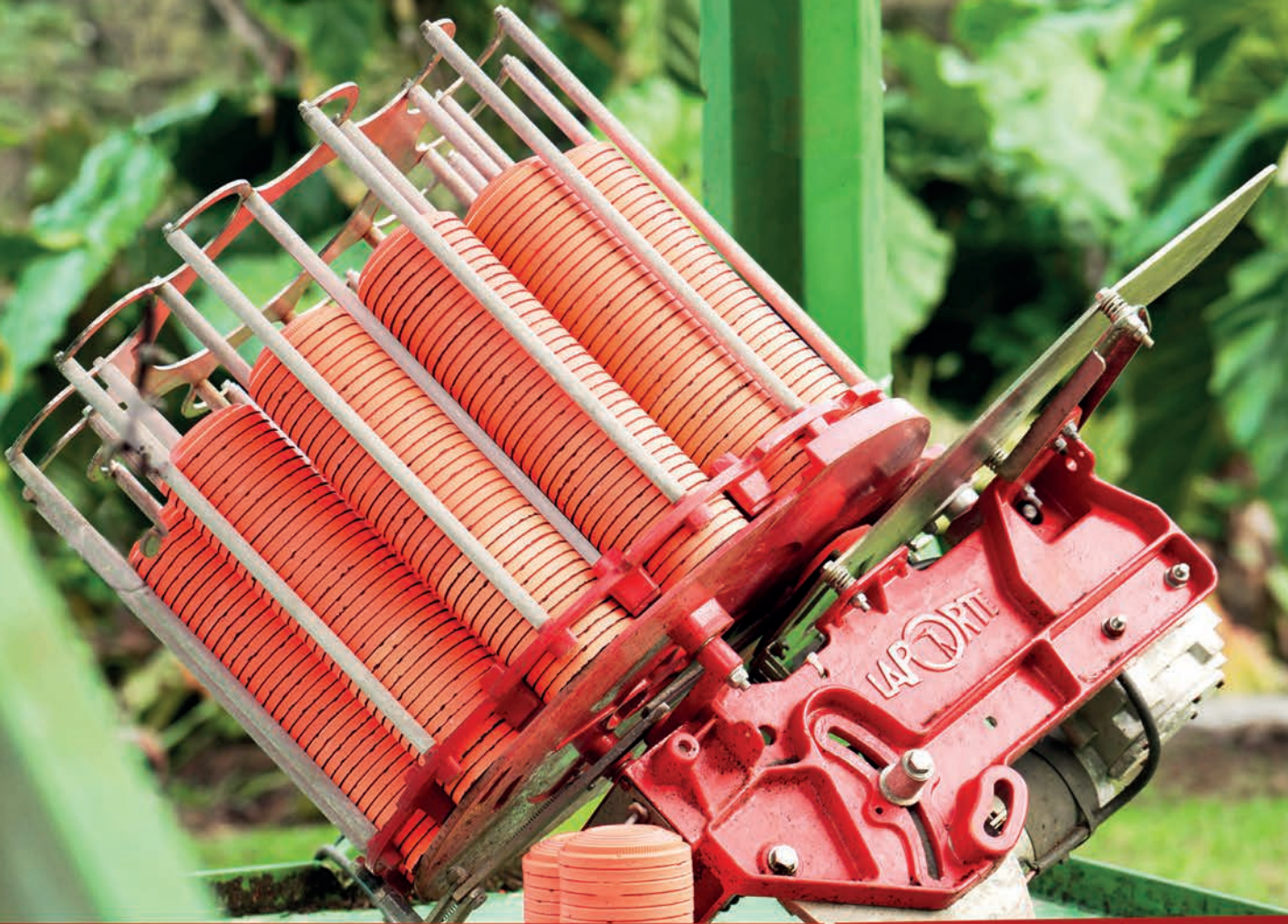

The annual CPSA Awards ceremony is always much anticipated, and 2026 was no exception. After the long winter break, it provides a welcome social get-together, a chance to dress up and enjoy a glamorous evening – and recognise the contribution of all those who make our sport strong and vibrant at every level. That includes all the volunteers, coaches, ground staff, referees, course-setters and many more, as well as the shooters themselves, from beginners to top international competitors.

The 2026 ceremony, the 15th such event, was a year in the making, with much work in the background by the CPSA team. It saw a return to the ever-popular Hilton at St George's Park, near Burton-upon-Trent in Staffordshire, famous as the home of England's national football teams. Nearly 200 people gathered from all over the country to enjoy the evening, and were welcomed by CPSA Director and England ESP Team Manager Colin Burrows, who announced the nominees for each of the evening's awards and brought them to the stage.

After a sumptuous three-course meal, served in the venue's usual smooth and efficient style, it was time for the formal business of the evening. CPSA Chairman Dr John Martin kicked off the proceedings and introduced our host, the popular entertainer Shaun Williamson, perhaps best known for portraying Barry Evans in the legendary BBC soap *EastEnders*, and a familiar face on reality TV and quiz shows such as *Pointless* and *The Chase*. Shaun stepped up to the stage and instantly had the audience singing and clapping along. As at previous Awards

ceremonies, the Dancing Squirrel production team had done a great job of setting up the staging, lighting and audio-visuals, creating a real sense of atmosphere for the occasion.

Then it was down to the business of announcing the winners, presented by the sponsors of each award in turn. The awards have a special significance because the nominations and voting are carried out by the CPSA members themselves, reflecting not only measurable achievements through the year but also appreciation by their peers. This year the list of awards had seen some refinement, with for example a Rising Star award instead of a Young Shot of the Year, and Volunteer of the Year replaced by Community Champion of the Year. All in all, though, every aspect of the sport was covered, and there was something for everyone.

We began with the Rising Star award and went on through Coach of the Year, Club/Ground of the Year, Lady Shooter, Referee and the rest, culminating in the much-anticipated Clay Shooter of the Year. In this coveted category, Phil Gray's remarkable and historic double of English and British Open Sporting Champion in 2025 earned him the top spot against a strong field of contenders, to tumultuous applause.

That concluded the formal part of the evening, but guests were in no rush to leave, enjoying a relaxed drink and catching up with friends and rivals from far and wide until well past midnight. During the evening a raffle was held to raise money for this year's chosen charity, Access Sport, a national sports inclusion charity formed in 2004 which trains, equips and supports community

sports clubs, among them shooting clubs, to be more inclusive.

And so to the big one, the coveted Clay Shooter of the Year award, sponsored by Browning. There were five nominees in all, each deserving recognition for their achievements over the year, and representing a range of disciplines and ages which reflects the strength in depth of the sport in this country. Dan Price, for instance, had chalked up an impressive list of victories in DTL, scooping the Dougall Memorial trophy and Grand Masters championship as well as making his 7th England cap and finishing the year at number one in the CPSA's DTL rankings.

Fifteen-year-old John Porter has shown tremendous

commitment and dedication over recent years, and the results certainly show in his successes last year, winning a new DT11 at the Beretta World championship, taking the English and British Sporting Colt titles for the third year running, and winning both World Colt titles held in the UK.

James Attwood won both the Europe and Compak and FITASC championships in 2025, along with a string of wins that included the Essex Masters, World Sportrap and World Prelim, narrowly missing out on winning the British Open Sporting, English Open Skeet and Hull Pro One. Also nominated for Clay Shooter of the Year was Amy Easeman, whose successes had seen her



scoop the Lady Shooter of the Year award.

Of course the top award went to Phil Gray, and deservedly so after a phenomenal season that saw him do 'the double' of English Open and British Open Sporting champion – the first time that has been achieved since George Digweed in 1995. "After working on the Fujairah Mountain Shooting Championship at the start of 2025, this was my first year stepping into a coaching role and it has also been my most consistent year shooting," he said. "Balancing both has grounded me, and reminded me why I love this sport so much."

Phil declared he was over the moon to win the award. "It's one that everyone would like to win at some point in their career. The many years of training and hard work have finally paid off I guess. It's nice to see that people recognise the hard work that we do. Here's to hopefully a few more good years," he said, adding: "The World Championship is the one everyone wants, and it's the one missing from my trophy cabinet, so that would be great this year." ▶

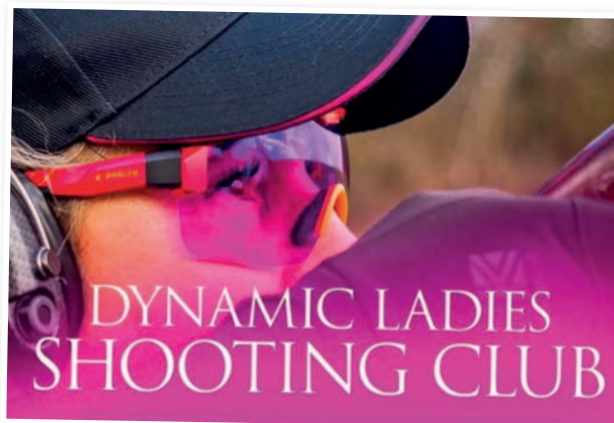

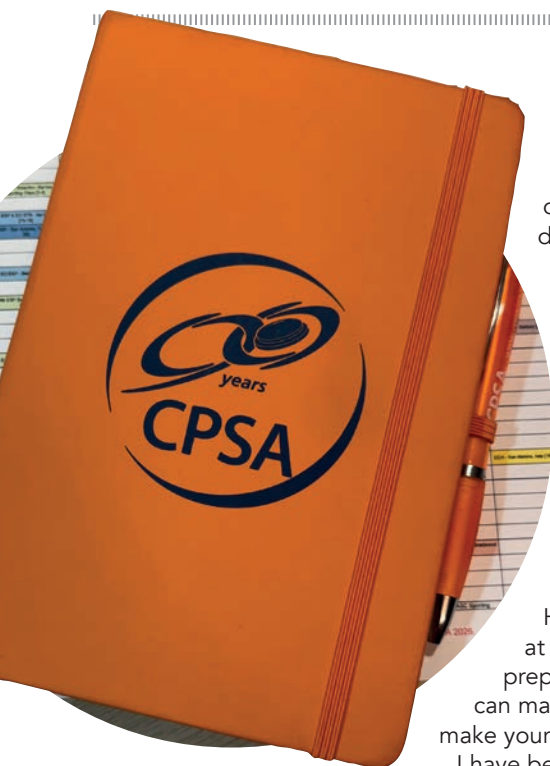

PLANNING FOR SUCCESS

Anita North explains how making a plan and writing it down will help you reach your shooting goals this year.



So you've fallen in love with this wonderful sport and set your sights on competing, but how do you progress? What tools do you need in your kit bag? I propose pen and paper will be of great use to you. I'm a big fan of pen and paper and not just because I am a traditionalist. Research suggests writing by hand is better for your memory than typing.

YOU'VE GOT TO HAVE A PLAN

A plan with goals and timelines pulls things together. How are you going to perform at your best? How will you prepare? If you are organised, you can make your goals achievable and make your life less stressful.

I have been fortunate to interview a good number of successful shooters.

One common element in their varying stories is success did not come accidentally, but by following a plan. They were all clear on where they wanted to go and used a 'roadmap' to get there. Attention to all details combined with a good work ethic helps you perform your best when it matters.

Olympian Lucy Hall said: "Sit down, have a good chat with yourself, understand what your strengths are as well as where you can improve. Get a plan together for the work ahead, gather ideas from the team around you."

And Mhairi-Ann Troup, M.I.C.S.I., said: "A plan turns talent into consistency. Without one, you're guessing. With one, you're building confidence within the shooter."

ESTABLISH YOUR GOALS

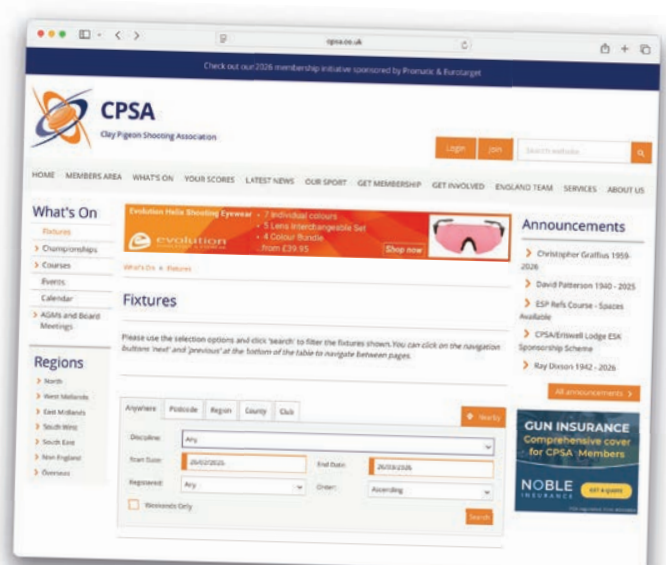
So it is worth taking some time, getting organised and sorting your own roadmap. It can all begin by writing down your ultimate goal. Be that win a certain competition, represent your county or country. Indeed you could aspire to Olympic greatness. Big goals are made up of lots of small goals. Consider them the bitesize pieces. Look at your goals and identify what you can work on when you go train. You can do this with your coach.

WRITE IT DOWN

Look at the time that you have, look at the competitions that you want to take part in and schedule your training. Get these dates into your plan, into a calendar. If you have it written down or captured digitally, use a format which allows you to take a good view of the coming weeks and months. Writing it down makes it so much more real, as part of your daily life.

This will also allow you to do some budgeting, so you have a grasp of the financial implications of your journey.

USE THE CPSA WEBSITE

The CPSA website has lots to help you with your planning. The What's On section includes Fixtures, Championships, Courses, Events and Calendar. In Fixtures you can search by discipline in a specific time period – great for seeing which registered competitions are on that can go into your plan and be part of your training. The Calendar lays out championships and significant competitions for the year across disciplines. The Championship section includes a list of Major Championships with their venues, competition entry fee and more. There's help on how to book championships including information on how you can change your entry or cancel it if needed.

The Scores section on the website is good to use when it comes to reviewing how you are doing in competitions – you can see all your scores, averages and classifications and dig deeper with filters. This can be useful for identifying trends.

TRAIN WITH PURPOSE AND KEEP A RECORD

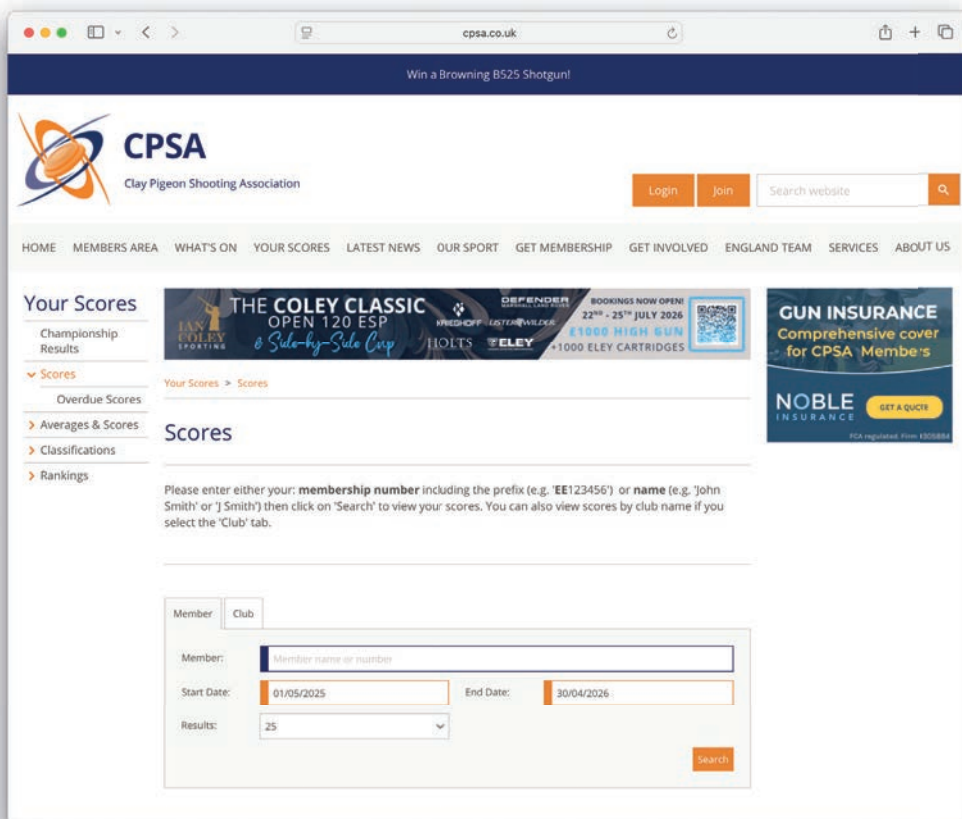
When it comes to your (planned) training, use your time wisely and train with a purpose and remember those bite-sized small goals to help guide you. Also, remember you can use competitions as training – testing your progress.

Sarah Wixey, Olympian and coach, said: "Training is the time to ensure technique is as good as it can be and competition is a time to get lead

(shot) on clay. It is very important to see and understand the difference. The more shooting you do technically correctly in training, the easier competitions become."

Do keep a shoot journal but remember it's not just recording numbers. You should also record lessons learned and notes to self. And keep notes on your training and what you've worked on. You don't need to write an essay – condensed notes with key points in your own words helps you understand your progress. Capturing notes also gives you something to review. It's one thing to have a plan, but you periodically need to go back and review what you have done, check your progress, and adapt your plan if necessary.

So go on then, get your pen and paper. What's in your plan for 2026 and beyond? Do you have certain competitions you want to do? Remember – enjoy the journey, enjoy the work and the results will come.

FROM TRACK TO TRIGGER

Olympic hero **Derek Redmond** has turned his attention to clay shooting and **Drennan Kenderdine** has the enviable job of guiding him along the path.



Derek Redmond needs no introduction to most sports fans. In 1992, the British 400m sprinter tore his hamstring in the Olympic semi-final in Barcelona. Refusing to quit, he limped the rest of the lap, with his father Jim rushing from the stands to support him across the line. This created one of the most iconic images of resilience in Olympic history. If you've never seen it, look it up now – but get the tissues ready.

At 60, Derek is no longer chasing track records, but he is chasing targets. After a varied post-athletics career that included professional basketball for England, rugby sevens, kickboxing, amateur boxing,

and motorcycle racing ownership, he discovered clay pigeon shooting in late 2025. Since then, he has been training regularly, competing in registered shoots, mostly Sporting and Skeet.

This is his story from the ground level: an Olympian embracing beginner status in a sport full of speed, frustration, small wins, and genuine inclusivity. We will follow his progress as a developing shooter rather than someone starting from scratch. He is a beginner, but not a blank slate, and it will be fascinating to see how a world-renowned athlete applies himself to a new sport with the same determination he showed on the track. ▶

HOW DID YOU GET INTO SHOOTING?

A friend of mine, who I train with on the boxing side, does a lot of field sports. He fishes and he shoots. He kept saying I should try it, that I'd enjoy it. I kept brushing it off with a "Yeah, yeah, one day." In October 2025 he said it again, and I finally went along. I had no idea what I was doing, but it was OK.

He asked me again a month later, in November, and I went. I don't know what it was that day, but something clicked. That evening I came home, went straight into my office, applied for a shotgun certificate, and that was it. Since November 2025 I've been shooting weekly. I just fell in love with it.

There are some comparisons mentally and a little physically to athletics, but one of the things that attracted me is that my obvious assets, being fast and strong, don't come into it the same way. You have to take a completely different approach. That was a challenge for me.

WHAT DOES IT FEEL LIKE ENTERING THE SPORTING CLAYS WORLD AS A BEGINNER?

I love that you can line up next to the likes of Richard Faulds, George Digweed, Amy Easeman, Mark Winser, big names, and shoot the same event. I love rubbing shoulders with these people, shooting at the same event, and almost comparing myself even though I'm a complete beginner.

One of the things I love in sport is seeing professionals doing what they do at the highest level. TV does no sport justice. Until you're on the ground with them, you don't realise how accurate, how fast, how sharp they are. That's a massive attraction to

clay shooting. You can get up close and personal with the best in the sport, and most of them are happy to answer questions.

WHAT DO YOU ENJOY MOST ABOUT CLAY SHOOTING?

I enjoy that it's completely different from all the sports I've been involved in before. I love trying different sports, and this one is very challenging. Even though my natural speed and strength come into play, I can't use them the same way. I can't dig in and push like in athletics or become aggressive like in rugby or boxing. You need a different form of control.

There are times you can attack the clays, but it's in a completely different way. That's one of the things I enjoy, and also the most frustrating, because I can't

just drop the gun and run after the clay. Mentally and in terms of discipline, it's exactly the same as every sport I've been in, especially athletics. You need to control your mind, control your emotions, and repeat a process that works. Easier said than done.

DID YOU HAVE ANY PRECONCEPTIONS ABOUT CLAY SHOOTING?

I thought it would be less athletic, and I'm going to be honest, it is less athletic. That doesn't mean there's no athleticism, but you don't need to be a 10.2 sprinter or squat 500 kilos. A general level of fitness helps, but some of the greats aren't the most athletic and they shoot very well.

I also thought it was more of a niche sport. You don't see much on TV outside the Olympics. But the more I shoot, the more I find places to shoot.

I've passed shooting grounds for years and didn't know they existed. There are far more people shooting than I realised. It's one of those sports anyone can get into at any time, and they should.

TELL US ABOUT YOUR SPONSORS AND YOUR KIT?

I am an ambassador for Caesar Guerini and use the Invictus 1 Multisport 32-inch barrel, along with Lyalvale Express Power Gold cartridges, Evolution glasses, CENS Digital DX5 ear protection and Schoffel clothing. All the equipment I use is top tier, the same kit trusted by world champions.

Having the right equipment makes a difference physically and mentally. If you look good, you feel good, if you feel good, you perform well. It adds a bit of pressure because these companies don't have to support me – there are a plenty of others they could choose. I'm very thankful to Caesar Guerini, Fiocchi, Evolution Eyewear, CENS Digital and Schoffel for supporting my journey.

AS A FORMER OLYMPIAN, WHAT DO YOU THINK IT TAKES TO WIN GOLD IN CLAY SHOOTING?

The fundamentals are the same as in every high-performance sport:



discipline, commitment, and the willingness to put other parts of life second. If you want to be the best, you make sacrifices most people never see. Look at athletes like Richard Faulds, Peter Wilson, Nathan Hales – I bet every one of them has given something up.

The Olympics come around every four years, and out of 16-to-17,000 athletes, only about 350 leave with gold. Winning one is incredibly hard. You need single-mindedness, tunnel vision, mental strength to stay calm under pressure, and above all consistency in training, process, and handling setbacks. Mentally, the process is the same across sports.

REALISTICALLY, WHAT ARE YOUR AMBITIONS AS A BEGINNER?

First of all, to improve. I want to be shooting at least 25 per cent more targets than I am now, consistently. At that point I'll have more understanding, be competent, and we can start working properly.

I'm not chasing Olympic representation, I'm 60, the chances are slim. But never say never. Realistically, good club scores. Maybe county honours down the line. I'd love to get to A class, but first I need to go from C to B. Become the best shooter I can be with realistic goals. I've tried my hand at plenty of sports, and I want people to see that you can step into

anything and give it a go. I'm not bothered about the spotlight or about turning up and missing everything. I'm just a normal bloke learning like everyone else. We all start somewhere. Don't be afraid of that. If you turn up to a 50-target shoot and hit three, that's three more than if you'd stayed at home. Next time aim for five, then seven, then ten. Build it step by step. 🍷

Honouring the past

English Open DTL 1976, five man team winners for the Dewar Shield, with the first ever 500ex500 straight scored by Snydale Gun Club, West Yorkshire.

Snydale Gun Club was situated between Wakefield and Featherstone, in the village of Snydale, behind the Cross Keys public house, on one acre of land, in the 1960s as a recreation facility for the working man. It consisted of one Blair Gowrie hand operated DTL Trap and one English Skeet layout. As it was on one acre of land, it was only possible to shoot one layout at a time, shooting DTL once a month and skeet alternative fortnights.

It was run by its members, Secretary Stuart Limbert, and trap operator and coach Tom Jones. If Tom saw someone with a natural talent, he would spend time correcting and fine tuning their skills, producing 14 international shots out of a small 60 members club.

Four years later in 1980 four of the club's members joined neighbouring club Allerton Bywater, again winning the Dewar Shield with Ken Milner winning High Gun, and the team winning several other major trophies. After which they were known as the super squad: Ken Milner, Peter Collins, Jack Dickenson, Steve Lindsey and Tony Benson.
