



WELLBEING APPS FOR YOUNG PEOPLE


Stop, Breathe, Think offers short mindfulness and meditation strategies.

CORONAVIRUS UPDATES

A message from CEO **Iain Parker** and Chairman **John Martin**, 1 April 2020.

Dear CPSA members,

We are writing to you firstly in the hope that you and your families are all safe and well in these unprecedented and difficult times. In recent days we've been talking with ground owners, clubs, and shooters, and know that Coronavirus has affected friends and family in our shooting community. Our thoughts and wishes are with you all at this difficult time.

We would like to update you on recent developments and decisions we are taking here at the CPSA.

Over the past ten days all of our lives have changed as we face the Coronavirus crisis with restrictions on business, movement, and socialisation. This has meant we have had to take some difficult decisions, such as suspending registered shoots, cancelling England Team selection shoots and our CPSA AGM, and then one-by-one cancelling or postponing our Championships planned for this spring and summer.

This is obviously a huge disappointment in what was going to be one of our busiest years, with two World Championships at two of our Premier shooting grounds: Bywell and E.J. Churchill. We can confirm that we have worked with our fellow associations and

agreed we will host both Championships in 2021 at the same grounds.

Please see cpsa.co.uk/news/coronavirus for full details on each cancellation and postponement.

From an operational and commercial perspective, we can also inform you that we have made the decision to 'furlough' six of the CPSA HQ staff under the government's scheme. The remaining staff will continue to keep the association going day to day, and plan and prepare for when we can start shooting again. We have also cancelled or postponed many areas of our marketing and advertising to save valuable budget and resource.

During these unprecedented times, we ask members to continue to support the association in terms of membership. We are happy to report we are still getting members renewing and joining in the last week knowing they can't shoot right now, but wanting to support the association and sport for when we can all go out and shoot again. The team continue to work on the various aspects of membership that carry on. You will still receive your *Pull!* Magazine, insurance continues in place – including shotgun certificate renewal, refusal or revocation insurance for Full members – and web and social media work continues as a key source of

information in the current circumstances.

Even though the team, like most of the UK, is having to work from home, we are here for the membership and are working to ensure that there are plenty of opportunities to participate in our sport at all levels once shooting resumes.

While shooting may not be possible, the most important focus now for the association is looking to the future when we can work with grounds, clubs, sponsors, and fellow associations from around the world to get back to shooting and happier days.

We'd like us all to take a moment and think of those members, family, and friends who have contracted and are fighting the Coronavirus. We also thank all of our members who are working in any capacity to help manage this crisis. This extends to all, from medical personnel and police officers to workers in the utilities, delivery drivers, and food services and agricultural workers.

We wish for you, your family, and your loved ones to keep safe and well, and look forward to seeing you at a shooting ground before too long.

CPSA HOSTED CHAMPIONSHIPS & EVENTS

ENGLAND TEAM SELECTION SHOOTS CANCELLED AND ICTSC HOME INTERNATIONALS POSTPONED TO 2021

On 17 March, all England Team Selection Shoots were cancelled, due to the inability to host the selections within government guidelines. On 6 April, it was announced that all ICTSC Home Internationals were postponed to 2021. They will be hosted by the same countries and grounds as planned for 2021, on the corresponding weekends.

ICTSF WORLD DOWN THE LINE CHAMPIONSHIPS POSTPONED TO 2021

On 18 March it was announced that the ICTSF World DTL Championships, scheduled to be held at Bywell Shooting Ground from 8-11 July 2020, were postponed to a date to be determined in 2021. This is in agreement with the ICTSF committee. Full refunds of competition entry fees can be requested, or monies held until the event is rescheduled in 2021 by emailing championships@cpsa.co.uk. This does not currently include the English Open DTL, Dougall Memorial, and Sponsored DTL.

CPSA COURSES

On 23 March, it was announced that all CPSA Courses were postponed until the end of April. This was later

extended to the end of May. Pre-booked attendees have the option to move their booking to a later date, or to receive a full refund, by emailing courses@cpsa.co.uk.

CPSA PREMIER LEAGUE

On 23 March all shoots were postponed. The series will provisionally resume on 28 June at Southdown Gun Club (South Division) and 26 July at Doveridge Clay Sports (North Division). Further dates will be announced as the situation develops.

CPSA REGISTERED SHOOTS

As of 23 March, all CPSA Registered shoots were cancelled until further notice. This decision will be reviewed weekly to consider changes to the situation and Government guidance. Fixtures continue to be published in this magazine, as at time of print we do not know if it will be possible to hold them.

We will resume CPSA Registered fixtures when we believe that Government guidelines allow for it, and when we feel it is safe to do so.

This decision will not have any effect on classifications. The current classification period will continue to run and will end on 30 April 2020. These classifications (Issue 59) will go into effect on 1 June. We will postpone further classification periods following

this if Registered shooting does not recommence by the end of April.

CANCELLATION OF THE CPSA ENGLISH OPEN ENGLISH SPORTING AND ENGLISH OPEN ENGLISH SKEET CHAMPIONSHIPS

On 24 March the English Open English Sporting (scheduled for 13-17 May at Highwaymans Shooting Ground) and English Open English Skeet (scheduled for 22-24 May at Eriswell Lodge) were cancelled. Full refunds of all entry fees have already been made.

POSTPONEMENT OF THE CPSA WORLD ENGLISH SPORTING AND SPORTRAP CHAMPIONSHIPS TO 2021

On 31 March the CPSA World English Sporting and Sportrap Championships at E.J. Churchill Shooting Ground were postponed to 5-11 July 2021. We would like to thank the National Sporting Clays Association in America for their support in this decision, they will now host the championships in 2022.

Entrants have the option to keep their booking for next year's event with the guarantee that they will not have to pay the difference should the price increase. If no refund is requested, then the shooter or shooters will retain the equivalent day and time slot in 2021. Alternatively, full refunds of entry fees can be requested by emailing championships@cpsa.co.uk.

NON-CPSA EVENTS

THE GAME FAIR

The Game Fair has been postponed to 18-20 September. The event was originally scheduled for 24-26 July. It will still be held at Ragley Hall in Warwickshire.

The CPSA aims to attend on the rescheduled dates to run our membership stand and Have-a-Go

Clayline, and to organise and run the Champion of Champions and Colts Challenge sporting clays championships.

ALL BICTSF SHOOTS CANCELLED FOR SIX WEEKS

On 18 March, the BICTSF (British International Clay Target Shooting Federation) took the decision to cancel

all shoots that they govern for the next six weeks.

THE NORTHERN SHOOTING SHOW POSTPONED

The Northern Shooting Show has been postponed to 28-29 August. The CPSA aims to attend on the rescheduled dates.

LETTER OF THE MONTH

Dear Sir/Madam,
My certificate is due to expire mid June this year and knowing that my issuing authority, the Met, advises up to 12 weeks in normal times I submitted my renewal in February, having checked with the Met that this was not too early. The earlier the better it seemed to me, and this has paid dividends in view of the present Covid-19 situation.

I have just received a very reassuring message in answer to my latest enquiry as to how the pandemic will affect processing and I have been told that,

because I had applied more than eight weeks in advance of expiry, my certificate has been automatically extended for three months to mid September – by which time we all hope things will have been restored to normal.

Other CPSA members may be interested to learn of this and I think a very early application to renew is key to similar success.

Dear Gordon, Thanks for your letter which is extremely useful in these



unprecedented times. We are closely monitoring the situation with the licencing authorities to ensure we can provide up to date information to our members, who are due to renew over the coming months, and it's great to hear that the Met are providing an efficient service given the difficult circumstances.

We have received guidance from The Met which can be found at cpsa.co.uk/metcv19. We recommend that all shotgun certificate holders read this, even if they are in other licencing authorities.

L2 Common Element (CE) & Coach Training Course (CTC)

These are two three-day courses – the Common Element (£495) and the discipline specific Coach Training Course (£550). The Common Element now includes the three coach development workshops and allows seamless progression to the desired CTC in Trap, ESK or ESP. There are also three stand-alone CDW's * (£175 per CDW) available for those who have previously qualified as a L2 Coach, and wish to continue their coaching qualifications in a second or third discipline. They are designed to give you the technical skills to improve an established shooter.



1 **RESPECT – TREAT ALL GUNS AS THOUGH THEY ARE LOADED – AN ACCIDENT COULD BE FATAL.**

We are all human and errors do occur, if we keep to the above comment we should be a lot safer.

On Instructor duty at a game fair, a person approached my stand with a gun slip over his shoulder. I was a little surprised as we only usually see youngsters and novices. The person wanted ten shots as he had not used his gun for a bit... I asked him to open his slip and remove the gun. He took out



a semi-auto, with the breech closed and the safety catch off. I then asked him if it was loaded. 'Of course not' was the reply. As he pulled back the breech out popped a live cartridge! I took the cartridge off him and asked him to leave the stand.

While I am on the subject of loaded guns, I will mention 'snap caps'. There have been several instances recently where the person thought there were Snap Caps in the gun, but in fact they were live cartridges. We do not need snap caps in modern guns, they are

designed to have the hammer springs left compressed.

Particularly bad are the brass Snap Caps, which can be confused with cartridges. If you have an old gun with a leaf spring you do need snap caps.

We do use snap caps as Instructors/Coaches, but only as a coaching aid. and we use the see through type.

THE CPSA'S TEN KEY POINTS OF SAFETY

CPSA Safety Tutor and Coach **Paul Dancer** breaks down the CPSA Ten Key Points of Safety, using his personal experience to provide examples of how important they are.

As a CPSA Safety Tutor (meaning I'm qualified to teach the CPSA Safety Officer Course), I thought that I would work through the 'Ten Key Points of Safety', so that when we return to the sport we love, we will be more Safety conscious.

3 **OPEN AND EMPTY – CARRY GUNS OPEN AND EMPTY, SEMI-AUTOS BOLT BACK AND FLAGGED. NEVER RELY ON THE SAFETY CATCH.**

The 'T' position to carry break action guns is by far the safest way.

The preferred method for the carrying of semi-autos is in a vertical position, or even dropped into your skeet vest pocket. We prefer the type

of safety flag where the body of the flag goes into the breech – the clip-in style is not the best as it can be clipped in with a round in the chamber.

One instance I know of was when a gentleman and his wife were out looking for vermin. He was carrying his gun one handed, and open with two rounds in. He stumbled and fell, dropping his gun which closed and went off. Unfortunately, his wife was ahead

of him and was shot in the ankle.

Never rely solely on the safety as it only locks the trigger, therefore if the gun is dropped, there is a good chance it will discharge. The sears engaged in the hammer to hold it back are only engaged by less than half a mm.

Remember – finger off the trigger till ready to shoot. 'Wood is good' and 'plastic is fantastic'.

4

CORRECT CARTRIDGES – CARRY THE CORRECT CARTRIDGES FOR THE GAUGE AND CHAMBER OF GUN YOU ARE USING. NEVER MIX GAUGES IN YOUR POCKETS OR BAGS.

As Instructors/Coaches we may be coaching two clients together, one using a 20 gauge gun and the other a 12 gauge gun. The danger is dropping the 20 gauge cartridge into the 12 gauge gun. It will jam forward in the chamber and may not be seen. Then, the 12 gauge cartridge may follow and there is the potential for the gun to explode!

Don't just rely on colour – in the picture you will see the 20 gauge is yellow, as the cartridge industry has standardised. You will see in the same picture a 12 gauge that is also yellow!

This situation can also happen with 20/28 gauge cartridges.

As for the correct cartridge for the chamber, the length on the cartridge



and on your gun must match. The length given is the fired length of the cartridge. You will see the correct cartridge/chamber with the picture of the two green cartridges, but looking at the blue cartridges you can see the unfired cartridge is close to the white line marking the chamber length. The fired one has crossed the white line, and therefore the danger of a chamber blow is present.

BARRELS CLEAR – CHECK THE BARRELS ARE FREE FROM OBSTRUCTIONS BEFORE LOADING.

On a number of occasions, I have been in the situation with clients where the wad has not left the barrel. Fortunately the sound of the shot gave it away that there was something not right.

On a visit to the Proof House in Birmingham I was told of an investigation by them into a barrel blowing.

A game shooter was at the end of a drive and needed to relieve himself – went into the woods and leaned his closed and loaded gun against a tree. After he relieved himself, he picked up his gun and returned for the next drive. Over came the pheasants and he took a shot to find his gun exploding in his hands. His insurance company sent it to the Proof House for investigation. What did they find? The DNA of a tree vole that had found a nice warm place to curl up in... not the right place!

6

POINT DOWN THE RANGE – KEEP BARRELS POINTING DOWN AT ALL TIMES WHEN LOADED. OPEN AND EMPTY IMMEDIATELY AFTER FIRING. ENSURE GUN IS UNLOADED BEFORE TURNING FROM THE SHOOTING STATION.

This is particularly a problem with novices. In the euphoria of hitting a difficult target or the first clay hit, it does happen. CPSA Instructors are trained to take a stance with novices that leaves the correct hand free (we know with right hand shooters they turn clockwise – opposite for left hand) so that if they turn the Instructor can stop that swing.

MISFIRES

In the event of a misfire, keep the gun closed for 20 seconds in your shoulder with the barrels pointing down range. If you are passing the gun or even have it in your hand and it goes off unexpectedly you will lose control. After the 20 seconds open the gun and inspect the cartridge – it may be a firing pin issue.

As for misshapen cartridges – while

all cartridge manufacturers have a stringent inspection process, there will always be a few that creep through. Do not try to force these into the chamber as the wad may be totally misaligned and cause issues further down the barrel.

Above left: Misshapen cartridges - don't use them! **Above right:** If a cartridge misfires and you see a dot in the primer where the firing pin struck, you can be more confident that it was a cartridge problem and not the firing pin's fault.

DO NOT MIX – ALCOHOL, DRUGS AND HORSEPLAY WITH GUNS.

This is a simple statement, but what do we see at some corporate events? Practice in the morning, lunch with alcohol, competition in the afternoon.

As for drugs, it's not as easy to tell. I was asked to take a group out at a ground for a have-a-go session. It was obvious by looking at their eyes that they were as 'high as kites'. I refused to take them out.

Horseplay... any indication that it will happen, then stop it.

REMEMBER – WHEN SHOOTING, YOU ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE SAFE HANDLING OF YOUR GUN AND THE BEHAVIOR AND SAFETY OF YOUR GUESTS, FAMILY, FRIENDS AND ANIMALS.

With the Olympics postponed to 2021, ISSF World Cups and Championships postponed or cancelled and FITASC championships postponed to later in the year, its no surprise there is nothing happening on the international scene for FITASC or ISSF competitors, and obviously nothing happening nationally.

BICTSF

Speaking to the BICTSF Chairman, Nick Woodward, it was good to hear a full refund has been made to competitors booked into postponed/cancelled competitions with no admin fee!

The BICTSF will be monitoring the situation month-by-month, so there should be at least one month's notice of any changes to the calendar – keep an eye on their website.

UPDATE ON OLYMPICS

The proposed new date for the Olympic Games is 23 July - 8 August 2021.

The ISSF have issued a statement that quota places already allocated from the qualifying

competitions will remain valid.

With the very real possibility that there will be no qualification competitions for the remainder of the 2020 season, the ISSF will propose to the IOC:

“...to leave unchanged the provision to allocate 12 quota places according to the World Rankings (one in each individual event) as of 31 May 2020, which was stipulated in the Qualification system approved in 2017.

“The remaining qualification quota (16 quotas allocated to the European Shooting Confederation), which have not been awarded so far, can be won during the 2021 competitions.

“After a new deadline for the Olympic qualification has been agreed with the IOC, a schedule will be approved to determine the procedure of how to exchange and redistribute quota places, including

those which will not be distributed by the IOC Tripartite Commission.”

Let's hope the world becomes healthy in the very near future and everyone can resume their lives.

WINNING CPSA EMERGING SHOOTER OF THE YEAR 2020

Last year, renowned Italian gunmaker Rizzini really impressed us with the RB Sporter, so we were keen to take a look at another model in their ever-expanding range.

RIZZINI BR460 SPORTING

RRP: £5,725 • a-s-i.co.uk
The BR460 derives its name from the diameter of its action (460mm wide) and works on a modified boss type locking system, with a bolt on the lower part of the monoblock. It's important to note that the side lugs are almost identical and are replaceable in the event of wear and tear. The BR460 benefits from a drop-out trigger mechanism, activated by pushing the safety catch forward to release the entire mechanism. I was interested to learn that the cost of a replacement trigger unit is only £899.

At this level and price, the guns are made in the custom shop area of the factory, where two highly experienced and dedicated gunsmiths are involved in the process. One looks after the actions and the other in charge of assembly. This delivers an intricate level of quality control and care, offering a hand finished gun build at a very competitive price. You can tell when you pick up the gun that the attention to detail is everywhere.

DESIGN

The gun is supplied in a smart ABS case, white sleeves for the stock and barrels, and five cased multi chokes. All are branded with the Rizzini name and deliver a quality look and feel. The five year manufacturer's warranty also gives any new owner plenty of peace of mind. The gun itself has a simple black action with the Rizzini name inlaid in gold, I also liked the branding on the top lever.

The test gun was a fixed stock model, and as with the last Rizzini we tested, it had a beautiful natural oil finish. To my eye, the walnut on the stock was not as pleasing as I had hoped for on a gun of this price and was certainly not as good as the RB Sporter we reviewed last year. However, we do know that Rizzini have access to some cracking wood, so a word with the UK importer (ASI) would probably get you

something beautiful to look at. For those looking for a gun of absolute beauty,

Rizzini do offer the EL variant of this model, which has a wonderful acanthus scroll engraving and higher grade woodwork for around £1,700 extra. A silver variant of the black action is also available.



the attention to detail is everywhere..

TESTING THE GUN

The test gun we fired was the 32" sporting model which came with the 1" extended colour coded multi chokes. Flush fit chokes are also available. Rizzini are currently working on a Teague choke option where they are fitted before being returned for proofing, resulting in only one set of proof marks on the barrels. The extra cost for this option is £996, which includes five chokes, a choke key and box.

The 11x11mm ventilated rib is lovely and wide to give a great sighting plane when shooting. The gun weighed in at 8lbs 4oz, and at 33"

long it feels very substantial, but don't be alarmed as it swings effortlessly and is a joy on long crossing birds or high driven, patterning perfectly.

The pistol grip is very comfortable and as with most manufacturers these days, Rizzini have opted for a palm swell which is always pleasing to shoot with. I very much enjoyed shooting the BR460, its crisp trigger pulls, smooth and effortless ejectors and the quality and satisfying closing of the barrels on to the action are all that you would expect from a quality gun manufacturer.

The BR460 comes in three different barrel versions:

Skeet – 29" multichoke with no side rib and 11x8mm tapered top rib.

HOW TO HIT

FITASC SPORTING

THE CHANGE IN TARGET PRESENTATION
BETWEEN STANDS

CPSA Level 3 Senior Coach **Simon Arbuckle** teaches us about the difference seen in targets when moving between hoops in FITASC Sporting.



Welcome to the third article in the fourth CPSA How to Hit series. In this article we continue on the subject of FITASC Sporting, and I'm going to show the difference seen in targets when moving between hoops. The targets are the same exact targets that we discussed in the last article on peg one of the layout – but by moving 20 or so metres to the right from peg one to peg two, the presentation of each of them will change.

I'm going to go through each single target, as if I was the first shooter on the peg, discussing the difference between this presentation and what I saw from the last peg. Please refer to the diagrams on the opposite page, showing the flight paths of the clays on both peg one and peg two.

 Again, a classic CPSA method shot – focused, locked on, pulled ahead and shot, keeping the gun moving. 

As the first shooter on the peg, I'd get to see all the targets before shooting.

First is Target D, the battue. On peg two the battue was more of a quartering R-L, as opposed to a square on R-L target as it was on peg one.

Target B: the midi. The midi didn't change significantly – it remained a long, L-R crossing midi, though I was slightly closer now to my break point, which was the same place it was on the last peg.

Target A: The blaze chandelle. This

was a quartering target on peg one, but became more of a 90-degree target crossing L-R on peg two. This is a reversal of what we saw with the battue, which went from a crosser to a quartering target.

Target E: This was one of the really significant changes. From peg two it was no longer a crosser, but more of a flat, going-away target, which really cut down the amount of gun movement needed to take it.



Target C: This didn't show a lot of change, the shot still needed to be taken before it slowed and curled away.

Having viewed them, I then shot them in order per the menu.

First was Target D, the black battue. I chose my break point to be the highest point before the target drops. The visual pick-up point was before the Browning flag, and the gun hold point slightly further out. I called for the target, mounted the gun, locked on, pulled ahead and shot – a classic CPSA Method shot.

Target B: The midi, had a gun hold point before the Browning flag, eyes further back. Again, a classic CPSA Method shot – focused, locked on, pulled ahead and shot, keeping the gun moving.

Target A: The chandelle, had a break point above the apex, the visual pick-up point was to the right of the tree, with the gun held slightly further out. Again, another CPSA Method shot, taking the shot at the apex.

Target E: This became going way, changing significantly from the first viewing of it on peg one. On peg two it became a very fast, low and going-away standard, and I had to get onto it quickly before it dropped. To do that, I decided to use the swing-to method, so my break point was halfway along the flightline, rather than two-thirds.

My gun was on the back of this sign, eyes further back. As soon as the clay went past the barrel, I swung onto it and shot at it. The difficulty of this shot was,

unlike English Sporting, where I can have my gun up, reducing the movement, I've got a lot of movement in the gun-down position, thus bringing a lot of barrel movement. Again, this is why in FITASC, the mount has to be perfect, and controlled to get to the target.

Target C: The break point was before the apex, gun hold roughly halfway up and visual pick-up point between the gun and the trap. I focused on it, locked on, pulled ahead and shot, just before it started to curl away.

And that's how you shoot those particular targets from peg two, showing you the difference between presentation, angle, and speed that's created by moving from peg to peg.

NO ORDINARY GROUND



One half of the CPSA Course Setter Recognition Award duo, **John Bidwell**, talks about High Lodge, Runner-up CPSA Shooting Ground of the Year 2020.



Q *How did you start shooting, and how did High Lodge come to be?*

A: I'd been interested in shooting from a very early age, but only joined the Somerleyton Gun Club at the age of 17.

I shot for the England Team in the late 60's, shooting my first European in 1974 in France, and making the GB FITASC team in 1978. I also shot in the first European World Cup in Scarborough and after that went on to shoot for Great Britain for the next 30 years. The highlight of my shooting career was winning my first world title in Australia in 1988, and back-to-back world titles in 1995/1996.

Building a world-class shooting facility had always been my dream. I wanted to provide a facility where

shooters can enjoy a similar experience to what I have in the past.

Q *When did you open your ground and what makes it special?*

A: The ground was opened over 30 years ago by myself and my late wife, and is now run by my family. High Lodge nestles among 120 acres of tranquil woodland

on the Suffolk coast. The team are very customer focused and friendly, so provide a real feel-good factor for all levels of shooters.

High Lodge is no ordinary ground – the facilities are second to none. It includes

shelters and paved areas, and a good choice of targets which are changed regularly.

There are also 19 luxury lodges on site, some with private hot tubs. There's fishing lakes, a nine-hole golf course, a footgolf course and five air rifle ranges.

As well as sporting activities, we are also a popular venue for weddings and other celebrations, with a large function suite and self-contained bar/lounge area.

120 acres of tranquil woodland on the Suffolk coast

Q *Which disciplines/facilities do you offer?*

A: High Lodge includes two Skeet ranges, up to 30 Sporting



stands in a woodland setting with many undercover, ABT and DTL Ranges, six Compak/ Sportrap ranges, and FITASC by arrangement. A 60-foot and a 120-foot tower both add to the variety of targets and disciplines available. More of our recent investments include six fully automatic and voice-activated Compak Sporting layouts, offering the perfect undercover option for practice on Sportrap and Compak, with additional multi-button facility.

There is full catering on-site, providing an array of home-cooked foods, freshly prepared by chefs using locally sourced ingredients where possible.

Breakfast and lunch are available from 9am-2.30pm, seven days a week. A selection of homemade pastries and cakes are available from the deli bar which offers snacks and lighter options throughout the day. An assortment of soft drinks, fine wines and local beers are also available to compliment any meal or snack from the licenced bar.

Q What are your current opening times?

A: We currently open six days a week Monday – Saturday 10am till 5pm, including Bank Holidays, (excluding Christmas Day, Boxing Day and New Year's Day). Sunday openings are available during the winter months and a late night Wednesday during the summer. We would always urge you to check their opening times before traveling or booking a stay, in case of a private event or a change in opening times.

Q How has the ground developed over the years?

A: From the very beginning, as just a simple clay shooting ground, High Lodge has made continuous investments into other outdoor sports to run alongside the clay shooting disciplines offered. Constant improvements to on-site facilities have helped to develop the ground into the complex we see today.

Extensions to the buildings have allowed for large space to be used for corporate and hospitality events and conference facilities.

Q What is the clay shooting scene like near you – and has it changed over the years?

A: There is a continuous stream of new shooters coming into the sport, the ground has had to be dynamic and change direction, due to lots of smaller shoots and local clay clubs now in the area. Of course there are currently more clay grounds than ever before, which has meant that we do not tend to run many competitions on a Sunday anymore – there is just too much local competition to warrant running them.

Due to planning consent, we have restricted hours so now attract the customer looking for instructional support, pay and clay customers, and also corporate events – whether for business or leisure. We like to run charity events or fun days out with the family and friends, which is where the direction most of the ground investment continues to go. Despite this, the recent undercover Compak/Sportrap layouts means we are one of the only grounds in the UK with this facility.

Q What are your current aims for the future?

A: To continue to support the sport, encourage new people to have a go, attract more people into the local area for leisure breaks in the lodges, and possibly further invest into the air rifle side of things in the future.

Q Your three tips for shooting well here?

A: Spend time to learn technique, it's no good practicing bad habits. Make use of the helpful staff and instructors around for some free advice, and practice makes perfect!

Q What are your most recent achievements?

A: High Lodge has won two major Lowestoft and Waveney Suffolk Chamber of Commerce Business Awards.

We were up against many top businesses and won the Tourism, Hospitality and Leisure Award, and also the overall Business of the Year award, which was really a great achievement considering the businesses we were up against. These awards show how High Lodge has achieved this by diversifying the business over the years. All of this has resulted in increased visitors and repeat visits over the years. 🌟

Grounds are closed now and so there is no shooting, for competition or enjoyment. I have no results to report with names of winners of trophies, badges or caps.



21 Mar: Skeet selection





UNFORESEEN CIRCUMSTANCES

Director of E.J. Churchill Shooting Ground, **Rob Fenwick**, talks to **Jasper Fellows** in light of the recent postponement of the World English Sporting and Sporttrap Championships.



Q What sort of work had already gone into preparing for the Worlds?

A: We had done a huge amount of work on the course in preparation for the event – from forward planning and working with suppliers like Promatic to ensure that everything ran smoothly. Luckily a lot of this work can be carried forward to next year.

Q More generally what kind of impact will the virus have on your business as a whole?

A: It will have a devastating effect. Currently we do not know how long we will be closed for, or when we can start planning events going forward. So far, we have had to close the grounds and cancel roughly 150 events until the end of June, and we may need to cancel more. Our gun shop is closed for walk-ins, as is the shop. The game season will also be affected, so our sporting agency is also going to have lean times ahead.

Q Are you able to continue operating any aspect of the business during this crisis?

A: Sir Edward (our Chairman) and I have taken the decision to use this opportunity as a positive one. We love the sport and our business was flying before the restrictions came into place, so we're obviously doing something right. Our security and grounds

teams are still

working, as they can work on their own, whilst practicing social distancing. There's always a huge amount of groundwork to do, so it's an excellent opportunity to start those projects that can be tricky to complete when we are open.

We're currently in the middle of building a brand new website, online shop, accounts and CRM system. We are also going to install Promatic Claymate systems across the entire estate.

Q How about gun sales, is this a good time to commission a new gun?

A: It's always a good time to commission a gun! We are also still selling a few guns virtually, through videos and pictures, and putting them aside for when customers can come in with their licenses to collect them.

Q How about once all of this is over? How do you think people take to returning to the sport?

A: Firstly, we just want to get people back here shooting as soon as possible. But I don't believe that everything will bounce back with a bang. People will be hurt in ways we have never seen – both financially and privately.

We need to make sure that we are at the forefront of people's minds and are able to provide their shooting fix in whatever way suits. We will cater for those who want to shoot six days a week, and also to those who can only fit in the occasional evening.
