

DTL WEEKEND CANCELLED

On 1 May the DTL Weekend events (Sponsored DTL, Dougall Memorial, and English Open DTL) that were scheduled for 5-7 July 2020 were cancelled. This follows the 18 March announcement that the ICTSF World DTL Championships (scheduled for 8-11 July at Bywell) were postponed to 2021. We can confirm that the new dates for the combined events will be 6-12 June 2021 (subject to ICTSF ratification).

Full refunds of competition entry fees can be requested or monies held until the next DTL Weekend in 2021. Please email championships@cpsa.co.uk to request a refund, if that is your preference.

DELAYS ON MEMBERSHIP CARDS

Whilst you can still renew your CPSA membership at this time online or over the phone, please understand that we will not be able to issue membership cards and packs until our staff are able to return to work once government restrictions on movement are lifted. This applies to all payments that have been processed since 23 March (including all Direct Debits for March), and including all payments for April and May.

All membership cards and packs will be sent out as soon as we are able to return to normal office work.

You will still receive confirmation of membership renewal by email upon renewing. Any member can log on to cpsa.co.uk/members to manage their account and download or print an electronic copy of their card or members' insurance certificate.

SAVE SARAH GRAY

GB shooter Sarah Wright (nee Gray), who shot Olympic Skeet for England in the 2014 Commonwealth Games, has received permission to travel to the USA for a clinical trial of a cancer treatment (Leronlimab) despite the current Coronavirus-related travel ban – however she has now been taken off of the trail as her oncologists in the UK believe she is too weak to receive further chemotherapy that is necessary before the treatments in San Francisco.

Sarah, 33, was diagnosed with breast cancer in November 2018. On the same day, she and her husband, Adam, discovered that she was pregnant with their first child. Sarah successfully carried their daughter to childbirth in July 2019, all the while taking chemotherapy and undergoing surgery. Unfortunately, the cancer spread, and all possible treatment options were thought to be exhausted.

Sarah and Adam continued to seek options, and Sarah was successfully accepted onto a clinical trial in the USA for this potentially life-saving treatment. However, the travel ban to the USA was preventing their travel to California. They then launched a social media campaign (#savesarahgray), got their story on national television and in articles in major newspapers, and received support from many others. Fortunately, the US Embassy in London soon obtained permission for Sarah to travel for the treatment. Flights were then donated for Sarah, by Delta and by private jet, and money was raised to help cover any potential emergencies as Sarah could not get travel insurance.

However, as mentioned above, Sarah is unable to receive the final chemotherapy treatments needed prior to starting the clinical trials. UPDATE TO CLASSIFICATION SUSPENSION DURING LOCKDOWN

This follows our previous announcement on 23 March 2020, advising our members that the 1 June 2020 classification calculations would go ahead as normal and that we would then suspend future classification issues until further notice. We can now advise you that after further discussion, we will now also be relaxing the rule to reset to 'unclassified' where no registered scores are recorded within a 36 month period. This will allow those that will not have been able to register at least one score by the 30 April to retain their classification(s).

AN UPDATE FROM CEO IAIN PARKER

The following email was sent to all CPSA clubs, grounds, and trade members on 14 May 2020, (and later posted for the public on cpsa.co.uk), stating that the CPSA has now had the necessary assurances to recommend the re-opening of clay-shooting grounds:

Dear Clubs, Grounds, and Trade Members,

Regarding the CPSA's position on the opening of clay shooting grounds following the easing of restrictions from 13 May for outdoor sports activities:

Over the past 48 hours we have been working with the Government,

Police and other bodies to get the confirmation we needed under the latest Government guidance that it is possible to start shooting recreationally again within England.

Therefore, as the National Governing Body for the Sport of Clay Target Shooting in England, we are now satisfied that we can start a phased return to clay shooting with initially pay and play/practice, and a return to competitive registered shoots in time.

Shooting grounds can re-open when they are ready and our members are now able to participate and enjoy the sport of clay



I write asking that you make members aware of a side effect of the current lock down. Since February it has been mandatory to get a signed doctor's report for renewal or new licence applications. I took the form down to my doctors and was advised that this could take up six weeks to get it signed, this makes renewal very tight where our police force, Cambridgeshire request that the renewal paperwork is with them six weeks before expiry, the original renewal advice being sent out three months before expiry. I don't know about other doctors but mine charged £30 for the signed report, with the fee payable in advance. I hope this information is of use to members.

Dear Michael, Thank you for highlighting this to all members. The CPSA advises all shotgun certificate holders to be sure to apply early if your certificate is up for renewal this year. Additionally, if your GP is unable or unwilling to provide the letter, services such as Medcert (medcert.co.uk) are run by qualified doctors and can help. Medcert in particular offers a CPSA discount, log in to cpsa.co.uk/members for details.



VIEWING A TARGET

CPSA Referee and Safety Officer Tutor **Steve Williams** talks about the rules of viewing targets.

Ihit that" comes the cry as you, the referee, called "lost" and you watch the wad go sailing by. The shooter thinks it's a bit of clay.

Ever seen it happen, or even done it yourself? The rules are quite simple – 'a piece must be seen to come off the clay'. Unfortunately it's no good asking other shooters to say otherwise, because the referee was watching and waiting to see if it broke.

Referees are not there to take or give a target, they are simply there to score, and to make sure the rules are applied correctly and fairly.

Here are some rules about viewing targets that may help shooters who are confused about this.

ENGLISH SPORTING

If you are the first shooter of the day, or if the previous shooter has finished before you get to the stand, you will be given the opportunity to see the clays, before taking your shot.

At any other point in time, you will not be allowed to see a target. You should

take every opportunity to study the target as soon as you arrive at the stand, awaiting your turn. Please, do not encroach on the shooter in the stand – you will get a strong warning from the Referee.

If you are, however, entitled to see a target, then what you will be shown depends on what type of target is being presented: an on-report pair, a sim pair, a following pair, or a single target.

ON-REPORT PAIR

The Referee will explain where the targets are coming from and to, then allow them to call for it – the shooter will see one pair only.

SIM PAIR

Again, the referee should tell the shooter where they are coming from, then on the shooter's call show them a sim pair. When they are ready – and if they wish – the referee can show them a second pair of sim targets. In this case two pairs of targets can be seen before shooting. The reason for this is so the shooter can determine which way round they wish to shoot the targets.

Steve Williams has been refereeing for 16 years in all domestic disciplines, and refereed all major sporting events for the last 10 years. He has been Head Referee for the CPSA World English Sporting and the English Sporting Championships. He now tutors all the new Referees in the South East area.

FOLLOWING PAIR

This is the same target, thrown one after the other. As above, the Referee will explain where the targets are coming from, and much like the on-report pair, they can only see one pair.

SINGLE TARGET

That is all you will get to see – a single target. Please do not ask to see it again if you aren't entitled to. That's it for English Sporting.

OTHER DISCIPLINES

For Skeet, one high target and one low target (or vice versa) can be shown when starting the layout, called for by the first shooter.

One regular target can also be called, following two or more sequential irregular targets, or a trap breakdown.

For DTL and ABT, one target is thrown for the squad to see at the beginning of the layout. For Sportrap one target from each trap can be seen, at the start of the layout. No pairs are shown, just the singles.

This covers the CPSA Domestic Disciplines, however there are further rules for the International Disciplines.

To download the complete list of rules, please go to cpsa.co.uk/rules and by the time we are allowed to start shooting again, you will be fully aware of how you can view a target before coming to shoot it. Remember the Referee has the final say. ☺

FITASC SPORTING

MOVEMENT WITHIN THE HOOP



HOW TO HIT



CPSA Level 3 Senior Coach **Simon Arbuckle** teaches us about the difference seen in targets when moving between hoops in FITASC Sporting.

Welcome to the fourth article in the fourth CPSA How to Hit series. In this article, I'm going to continue our introduction to FITASC Sporting by covering movement within the hoop, by first looking at the single targets; we're going to cover pairs, and movement on the pairs, in the next two articles. The key focus of this article concerns movement of the body to the perfect point to shoot the targets in the hoop, and the control of the squad by the referee.


In this article we are using a different layout from the previous two articles. First, see the map of the new layout on the opposite page, where you can see how the targets are set. Here, you can see how much movement there can be on a single stand or hoop in a FITASC layout. As previously stated in past articles, the referee would show all of the singles to the first shooter of the squad on that hoop.

The first target, C, is a standard from the far corner crossing right to left, rising and peaking somewhere above the yellow tower. Next on the menu is E. E is in the opposite far corner, another standard target, but this time it's a chandelle tucked into the treeline. Like I said in previous articles, because I can't see the trap, I can't move my gun and mount it until I see the target. Target D, on the far side of the field, is another standard target, rising left to right,



and peaking above the trees in the far corner of the field. Target B is another trap that I can't see and is an edge-on teal. Then we move to A, another midi from the left and curling away from me. As you can see, there's an awful lot of movement I'm going to have to do as to shoot these targets in sequence. This requires the referee to control the squad and move them around to keep them behind the shooter. That squad's going to have to stay out of the shooter's vision, so not to distract him, and the emphasis is on the referee to do that.

As there are such variety of targets on each stand of a FITASC Sporting layout, you need to be prepared to use a variety of methods to complete the stand. Target C, I shot just at the peak with a classic method shot – locked on, pulled away, and shot. My feet, as always, were facing towards the break point. Next is E, the chandelle. As you can see, I turned around almost 180 degrees from the last target to face my break point, which is above the trees, with the target coming from the left behind the bushes. Again,

I shot it at the peak. I couldn't move the gun until the target appeared, but then locked on, pulled ahead, and shot.

In the first two targets I couldn't see the target immediately after it was thrown. Unlike in English Sporting, FITASC Sporting rules do not allow me to pre-mount my gun exactly where I want it, wind the gun down the flight line and drop it off my shoulder. Instead, I had to set myself up facing towards my break point, with the gun closed and stock below the yellow line on my vest, but the muzzle pointing towards my break point, then bringing the gun down the flight line. I did not actually mount it at that point, again to abide by the rules of FITASC Sporting, but I got my feet and gun set as if the gun was in the shoulder.

Moving on to Target D, I used the line of the target, and shot it above the hedge before the flight line ended and dropped away. I saw the target above the trees, mounted the gun, locked on, pushed ahead, and shot it in one movement. Target B was an edge-on midi, rising and slowing. To shoot it I let

the clay go past the barrel and smoothly took the gun to it shooting it just before the peak. Target A was again another method shot. I set the un-mounted gun towards where I was going to break it, wound my gun back, took my eyes further back, the target came out, I locked on, made minimum movement and shot the target just before it started to curl away. If I'd come back any further there's every chance I would have swung the gun from behind, through the clay, and missed in front because of generating too much movement and speed to catch up to it.

And that's how you hit a series of targets on a FITASC layout, with emphasis being on the movement of the feet to the correct break point before calling pull for each of the targets. In the next article, I'm going to discuss the movement of the feet in pairs, this time you'll see there's a lot more movement needed than in English Sporting.



CORY'S TOP TIPS

TIP 1 If you are young and still growing, get a gun you can adjust. Once you are happy with it and your chosen cartridges – don't change anything!

TIP 2 Pattern your gun regularly – this gives you an idea if anything has changed and confidence on where it is shooting.

TIP 3 Always show respect to other shooters and they will respect you.

TIP 4 Don't be afraid to try different disciplines until you find the one you like.

TIP 5 Promote your Sponsors when possible.



COMBATING CROSS- DOMINANCE

CPSA Senior Coach **Mike Williams** talks us through how cross dominance can affect your shooting, and how a simple device could be the answer.

To paraphrase the Speaker of the House of Commons – ‘the eyes have it’ – and there is nothing more important in our sport than our visual accuracy, and the ability to see the target clearly. Anything that helps in this respect has got to be an asset. This includes things like having your eyes checked regularly, prescription glasses if you require them, tinted glasses to enhance the contrast between the background and the target, and the position of your face on the stock to enable the target to be seen clearly over the barrels.

Allied with clarity is having the correct eye dominance, so that the gun shoots where you point it. There are numerous reasons as to why someone has the wrong eye dominance. I am not an ophthalmologist, however as a coach I have previously dealt with the symptoms of this cross dominance to get a shooter to hit the target. If you have a problem in this area and you are not particularly aware of it – you are going to struggle to hit anything.

PROVISIONAL CHECKS

If you are unsure as to which of your eyes is dominant, you can carry out a provisional check yourself for later confirmation with a coach. Should you be a right-handed shooter, then pick an

object in the distance to focus on, point at the object with your left index finger, and on pointing at it close your left (off-eye).

If the finger stays on the object then you are right eye dominant, and any movement away from the object means that your off-eye is having some influence on where you are pointing. If you are left-handed then the reverse is true – point at the object (with your right index finger), close your right eye, and providing the finger stays on the object you are left-eye dominant.

A shooter that has ‘correct’ eye dominance has a distinct advantage in that they can keep both eyes open when shooting, and benefit from a normal three-dimensional sight picture, with that ever-important perception in depth.

Well intentioned friends, if they are aware of your problem, will tell you to shut the offending eye, which will get the gun pointing to where you think it is. However, you have not only lost the central vision of the off-eye but also the peripheral vision. So with that eye closed, you are not aware of the target until it arrives in the peripheral vision of your ‘shooting’ eye (the eye that is over the rib). That could well be a lot later in the target’s flight, and brings in a whole host of problems, such as having to chase the target, or forcing you to use a shooting

method you didn't intend on using.

You could well be advised to shoot from the other shoulder, but this will only be a perfect solution if you are 100% off or cross-eye dominant, which most shooters are not. There is a great number of people coming into the sport (and some old hands) who exhibit central dominance. The trouble with this is, whichever shoulder you place the gun, you will have to do something with the opposing eye – by either closing it or using a tape or foil to stop the brain from receiving information from that eye.

CENTRAL VISION

The 'central vision' phenomenon has become very prevalent in the last 15-20

years. Looking at events that may have caused this brought me to the conclusion, that with the introduction of computers and an increasing amount of screen time, the eyes are now more used to focusing at very short distances.

I have been searching for a solution to this problem as a coach for several years. Before going out on a lesson with a new client, I will always check their eye dominance as I need to know where (and why) they are pointing the gun. I then confirm what I have observed on the range. For anyone exhibiting an eye dominance problem, in the past I have either used translucent tape or a micro foil product on the shooting glasses, to

remove the central vision of the offending eye, but to leave the peripheral vision.

With either of these, most targets can be dealt with efficiently, with the exception of a driven target. To hit this target the gun has to be moved in front of it and when doing so, visual contact with the target is lost (the tape/foil has removed the central vision) and the barrels now obscure the target. This results in slowing or stopping the gun to see the clay again and ultimately results in a miss behind.

THE SHOOT SP

I have little faith in anything that fits on the top of the rib (although it does work for some people). It is in the shooter's eye-line and a lot of the time grabs the shooter's focus which needs to be on the target, not the gun. So I was intrigued when I read about the Shoot SP paraboloid, especially as it had claimed to help a top Sporting shot, who I knew first hand had eye dominance issues. The SP wasn't in the shooter's eye-line, not on

the rib, but fixed to the side of the barrel, and most importantly the shooter could keep both eyes open with it, retaining the all-important binocular vision.

Being as sceptical as ever, I made a phone call to ask how she got on with it. She explained that it was as good as she had said and that she was very impressed. I then contacted Steve Randle, the inventor of the SP, and asked if I could see it in action. He invited me to a Coach Training course in the New Forest. I jumped at the opportunity and couldn't wait to see the SP in action.

Present on the course were a half a dozen individuals, some left and others right-handed, but all had eye dominance issues of differing degrees. None of them were able to hit a slow incoming target with both eyes open. The SP was fitted to each of their guns in

turn and without exception, all 'smoked' that incomer with both eyes open. They went on to hit a variety of targets, both eyes open, with the SP fitted to their barrels.

I asked Steve how this had come about and he explained that he had been oscillating around B and A class for a while, and couldn't put his finger on it as to why he wasn't able to shoot consistently and upgrade to AA. Whilst looking further into it, he discovered that he had an eye dominance issue and set about resolving it. At this time, Steve was a graphic designer and had partnered up with an optometrist. Together, they came up with the solution that for a shooter with an eye dominance problem, the SP 'super-switched' the shooting eye by making it unnecessary to close the offending eye. Incidentally, Steve is AAA now and is frequently winning class prizes and championships, with the SP on his gun.

I was convinced that the SP worked and signed on the dotted line to become a coach offering the SP, being confident that a

shooter with an eye dominance issue would be able to keep both of their eyes open. This has proved a revelation to my clients that came to me shooting with one eye closed. Probably the most spectacular was an A class shot, who started shooting with me about 25 years ago. They came to me because of a recent loss of form and it became clear after shooting a couple of targets that his off-eye was coming into the equation, and with an instruction from me to close this eye, he smoked the next clay out. I then explained what I had learned about the SP and suggested we try it. He soon regained his old form and was putting in increasingly higher scores. If you have eye dominance problems then

it is worth giving this a try, it has worked with everyone that I have tried it with so far. For more information, or for instructions on how you can 'DIY try before you buy' see the shootsp.co.uk website, click on the 'videos' tab and then select the video titled 'SP Dry Mount Test'.

Regional and England level. There is a wealth of talent and this is tremendous. A more detailed report will appear next month on this subject, but in the meantime if you would like to offer help to a Junior shooter please get in touch with a Cheshire Committee member.

Shotgun License Renewal

The police forces are currently under increased pressure with reduced staffing levels across licensing departments.

Some are suspending new grants of licenses, and certificate holders should expect much longer processing times for renewals. With this in mind, we are advising members to be aware of your local Police Force procedures – they do differ force to force – and apply in plenty of time to avoid your license expiring and having to find suitable and legal storage for your guns. As I write the lockdown has just been extended for a further three weeks and we are no closer to knowing when we will all be able to get out there to shoot again. Social distancing rules mean that our committee cannot physically meet, but refusing to be defeated we conducted a meeting by email to ensure that CPSA business could still progress.

With no shooting on which to report, I wanted to consider how we can promote our sport and encourage more to join us. The county has taken some time over the last few years to encourage more Juniors to shoot, since we struggle to provide a county Junior team for many disciplines. If only we could clone Denzil Grose! However we also have very few Ladies who shoot. How do we encourage more Ladies to take up the sport?

I have taken some time to speak, via the internet, to fellow female shooters to find out about their experiences of the sport and how they started out.

Most had experience of family members shooting, but were unaware of the extent of the sport opportunities available. For example, you can quite easily (in normal circumstances) shoot clays every weekend somewhere in the county, and probably at multiple venues. However unless you know someone who is involved in the sport to point you in the right direction this is not easily discovered. Many were surprised on a first try that they hit the clays, and found they wanted to do more.

What made us try? Well, some wanted to join in with family members who already shot. I on the other hand, was taken to a lesson thinking that I was a spectator and then found out I was taking part! The response was the same – a sense of pleasure and achievement in smashing a few clays and a will to keep doing it.

Traditionally Ladies are given 20-bores to shoot, but my fellow Ladies all shoot 12-bores and quickly ditched the smaller guns if they had started with them. Gun fit can be an issue – even with more manufacturers having guns with adapted stocks aimed at the female market. As

you all know if the gun doesn't fit then you will struggle to consistently hit targets.

There have been experiences of discrimination – comments made that 'ladies should not shoot' – but whilst these were only experienced by half of those I spoke to they were thankfully not frequent experiences. On the whole, the shooting community has welcomed and encouraged us as we attend events throughout the county.

What has come through strongly from my research is that there is a great love of the sport and these weeks of enforced closure have been a low for us all.

So how can we get more ladies to just have a go? Because from what I have found we will then get many more catching the shooting bug!

KEVIN GILL

The International Trap shooting world has been shocked and saddened by the sudden passing of British shooter Kevin Gill.

Kevin was a huge figure within the sport. He was an exceptional shot in all of the trap disciplines, especially Olympic Trap, Universal Trench, and Automatic Ball Trap, and for many years he was a much loved and respected member of GB teams and England teams.

Kevin represented Great Britain at the 1992 and 1996 Olympic Games. He also represented England in the

Commonwealth Games. At the 1990 games in Auckland, New Zealand he won the individual Trap silver, as well as gold in the Trap pairs with

Ian Peel. He won the World UT Championship in 1986 in Vilamoura and again in 2007 in Tangier, and won the British OT Grand Prix – famously known for years as 'The Rolex' – in 1990, 1991, and 1996.

Kevin also shot ABT for England in 1981, 1984, and 1985, and OTR for England in 1980, 1986, 1989, 1993, and 1997.

He was English Open ABT Champion in the years 2000, 2002, 2004-2006, 2009, and



2011. For many years he worked as the official shotgun coach for British Shooting, and during that time he transformed the successes of the GB teams.

Kevin will be sadly missed. His loss leaves a huge void within the International Trap shooting community and he will be remembered fondly by all those who knew him.



MARTIN IDDON

Martin Iddon sadly passed away peacefully at home, on 31 March 2020, after a long battle with cancer. He was aged 77.

Many remember Martin as an amazing shot, and

he shot several disciplines. One of the first competitions that he won was with his son Marcus in the 'The Father & Son Championship' at The English Open in 1979. He was also well known and well liked on the Helice circuit,
