BRITISH OPEN ENGLISH SPORTING PREVIEW

Hosted by the Clay Shooting Company at Garlands Shooting Ground on 2-6 September.



The British Open English Sporting and Sporttrap will be hosted this September by the Clay Shooting Company at Garlands Shooting Ground, for the third time at this ground, with shooters getting another chance to shoot an ever-popular Steve Lovatt course.

Steve last set the British Open course in 2018 at Oakedge, and promised us in last month's issue that this year's course will be "a standard challenging Lovatt course with a few special twists involved."

Musto, Rizzini, Gamebore, and Promatic have returned as sponsors this year.

The English Sporting course will consist of 120 targets and will be shot from Wednesday to Saturday, with the top five shooters from each class and the top three from each category from each day being invited to compete in the Final on Sunday. The scores will be reset to zero for the Final, and a new 75-target course will be shot. The top

which includes an Olympic gold medal, 22 World Championship titles, five English Open titles, and now four British Open titles.

Stuart Clarke was Runner-up, and Josh Bennion took third, an exceptional feat for a Junior. All of last year's finalists are booked on for this year, along with many other top shots, sure to be an exciting battle.

Garlands are confident that they have the space to host the event safely and within current government social-distancing guidelines.

The ground will be running a special sale in their shop

six shooters from the Final will be invited to a six-person Super Final to compete for Overall Champion.

Last year's British Open at High Lodge saw Richard Faulds MBE retain the British Open title, following an exciting shoot-off that featured previous British Open Champions Stuart Clarke, Sam Green, and George Digweed MBE, joined by Paul Thomas and Junior shot Josh Bennion. Faulds' win added yet another accolade to his career,

during the event, with offers on top brands.

An exciting change from previous years, Rizzini is now putting up four BR110 shotguns (pictured) for the winners of the Colt, Junior, Ladies, and Veterans categories, as well as contributing to the prize fund. Filippo Adamati of Rizzini stated:

"Even though Coronavirus has modified our sponsorship plan for 2020, Rizzini are pleased to confirm our sponsorship of the CPSA

British Open and to support the English shooters during such hard times. Last year we had very good feedback from the field, so the British Open, as this year's main event, will be the perfect place to display our new 2020 range.

"We don't know at the moment if we will be present at the event due to problems with flights and bookings, but for sure our official distributor ASI will be there with the complete family of our BR460."

Gamebore are providing 10,000 cartridges to be divided amongst winners, along with contributing to the prize pool.

The British Open Sporttrap will run alongside the Sporting, with 100 targets being shot over four 25 target layouts. Last year this was won by Sam Green, topping off a brilliant year in which he also won FITASC Sporting World Champion. Aaron Harvey took Runner-up, and George Digweed third.

As the sole CPSA major English Sporting Championship this year, the British Open is sure to make up for lost time and be a true celebration of the return to our sport after lockdown. ☀

SECURING YOUR SPONSORSHIP

2019 CPSA British Open Sporttrap Ladies Champion **Hannah Gibson** talks sponsorship, both as a sponsored shooter and as businesswoman in the shooting industry.

The cost of shooting has increased over the last few years and the question on a lot of people's mind is 'how do I obtain sponsorship?' With the shooting industry saturated with requests, what will help you stand out from the crowd or gain support from outside the industry?

In my experience, sponsorship isn't a given – it's something to be earned and worked at, it was ten years of shooting before I bagged my first partnership.

Especially during the last five of those ten years, I couldn't understand what I was doing wrong – at the time I was representing GB at Olympic Skeet, I had won the English Open Olympic Skeet along with Team medals at World & European Championships. Yet the sponsorship deals weren't rolling in.

During my day job working as a

rifle-shooting equipment supplier, I am inundated with sponsorship/brand ambassador requests from shooters all over the globe. Combining that with my own competitive journey, I thought I would share my thoughts on what companies pay attention to and how, as a competitor, you can go about not only seeking sponsorship, but also ensuring that you are promoting shooting sports in a positive way.

BUILDING A REPUTATION

Like any competitive athlete, shooters are no different in the fact that to make it to the top level or even achieve your own personal goals and ambitions, you

have to make sacrifices, work hard, be consistent and driven.

Potential sponsors will be looking at your attitude and how you behave on and off the field.

For me, when working with brands it's important to think about things long term, build a rapport, and understand what the company does and what they offer. I started using Fiocchi and Krieghoff before I was sponsored. I used equipment that I loved, I can actively promote them

because I believe they are the best combination for me. It's not just about tagging a company on social media

(sometimes they employ PR agencies to run their pages, so the decision makers might not see it). Pick up the phone, talk to the people who could potentially support you or already are. Inform them of what competitions you will be shooting throughout the season, and your results good or bad! Communication and brand loyalty goes a long way.

STARTING YOUR SEARCH

Firstly, there are a number of sports scholarship grants or local council schemes which are a great entry into sponsorship – especially for Juniors/Colts. They usually offer one-off monetary grants or free gym membership. Some schemes such as the Talented Athlete Scholarship Scheme (tass.gov.uk) also offer workshops on sports psychology, biomechanics, nutrition, and media training. Any of these are great programmes to have on your CV, and also help provide you with a range of transferable skills.

Naturally, we are all drawn to companies within the industry: cartridge, gun manufacturers, clay companies etc. When I was seeking sponsorship, I already had bought my Krieghoff, and I shot Fiocchi Cartridges, so I was lucky to be supported by both a couple of years after my return to sporting, but the majority of my costs were entry fees and travel. My first big sponsor was a local property company that approached me on a driven game day. I had been loading for the team on a number of days. I learnt a lot about what businesses expected in return for their investment: attending corporate events, coaching clients, and producing quality content for social media that as a business they could also use.

Local companies are always good to approach, they have a keen interest in supporting athletes in the community

KEEPING FOCUSED

Always remember that your worth and accomplishments aren't measured by how many sponsors you have. If a partnership isn't mutually beneficial there is no harm in turning down the opportunity. If the sponsorship deals don't come flooding in keep working hard, focus on your goals, and if

SOCIAL MEDIA

Social media is a huge part of today's society, with news and photos at our fingertips in seconds. Our behaviour as shooters and competitors is under scrutiny more than ever. Social media is a tool we should be using to promote good practices and the positives of the sport. Regardless of what sponsors you are representing, you are an ambassador for shooting. Your online presence is your 'shop window' for any potential sponsors, you have to think professionally. I know from my own experience in the industry that with any requests I have, the first thing I do is look at their page. We try to see if they are acting in a safe and appropriate manner not only in terms of shooting but day-to-day life. Would they represent the company's core values and beliefs? Are they a good role model?



you have the right attitude and ability the opportunities will naturally start appearing – but don't let it knock your confidence if they don't.

As a parting thought, I'd like to say that, as individuals, we all have a responsibility to promote our sport in a positive and professional way. By doing so we may be able to secure sponsorship deals from large non-shooting organisations and help to widen the appeal of our sport across society.

ZOLI Z SPORT

GUN REVIEW

The Zoli family have been making guns in the village of Magno, Italy since 1490. With that kind of heritage we expect something special, so we were keen to test the Z-Sport.

ZOLI Z-SPORT

The Z-Sport is a mid-range gun from this manufacturer with an RRP of £5,000 or £5,300 if you prefer the adjustable comb option. So, what do you get for your money?

As expected at this price point the gun comes with an ABS branded case (in silver with Z-Gun logo in blue) and branded choke case. It also has a branded accessories kit with spare firing pins, firing pin springs, trigger group key etc, and it's just what you'd hope to see when purchasing a quality gun. Looking at the gun my eyes were instantly drawn to the quality of the

woodwork, and on the test gun it was nothing short of exquisite. In fact, it was so good I had to check with Edgar Brothers (the importers) they had not sent me one with exhibition grade wood!

All of the Zoli Z-Gun range is built on a monoblock action with the Boss type locking action, and these do seem to be very popular with Italian manufacturers at the

moment. The finish on the action is plain black, with a very simple Z in gold on both sides and underneath, and some hand-finished engraving most noticeable above the trigger guard. Like most modern competition guns it's a clean and simple



look – yet stylish and impactful.

The Z-Gun also boasts a detachable trigger group with titanium coated components, five extended chokes and the option to interchange stocks.

We tested the gun on a sporting layout and found the 32" barrels a delight on many of the targets. The gun is really well balanced and soaks up recoil nicely. Patterns were consistent and led to some satisfying breaks – even on long range targets. Straight out of the box the Zoli feels special, comfortable and almost performance enhancing when shooting it. It's what we would expect to see in a gun at this level

and we were certainly not disappointed. Barrel length options range from 28" to 34" in 12g, and 28" to 32" if you should look at 20 or 28g.

I do like long barrel guns so the 34" option is on my list to test. The tapered rib (11mm to 7mm) gives a good target picture and was more than comfortable when shooting. At just over 8lbs the Zoli is not the heaviest gun that I've tested, but it soaked up recoil nicely and was certainly a pleasure to shoot. ☺

FITASC SPORTING

180-DEGREE MOVEMENT OF FEET FOR PAIRS

CPSA Level 3 Senior Coach **Simon Arbuckle** discusses extreme movement of the feet between targets on pairs.

Welcome to the final article in the fourth CPSA How to Hit Series. In this article, I'm going to continue discussing the technique of shooting pairs in FITASC Sporting. In the previous article, you will have seen that my feet only moved when I had changed position to shoot each pair. By ensuring correct identification of my break point, gun-hold point, and visual pick-up point, I was able to ensure that I didn't need to move my feet between targets, even if they were fairly wide apart. Those targets were shot on peg 1, which you can see on the map of the layout below.

In this article, I'm going to discuss moderate movement of the feet between each target of the pair from peg 2. Finally, I'm going to cover maximum movement of the feet (that is 180 degrees) between targets from peg 3.

From peg 2, I need to shoot A on-report D. Target A is a long crossing target left to right. Now on peg 2, target D is more like a rising teal, as compared to a steep left to right as it was on peg 1. I decided to shoot target A above the blue tower, took the gun back from there to the hold point, and my eyes back to where I could first see the target clearly. I called 'pull', focused on the target, locked on, pulled ahead and shot. I then turned my left foot 90 degrees to face the break point of target D (see photos above right), then adjusted my right foot to create a stable shooting position. I dropped the gun slightly out of the shoulder,

then using the swing-to method, I let the clay come past the barrel, quickly mounted to it, and shot directly at it.



Next, we look at peg 3, where the targets demonstrate how to shoot pairs with 180 degrees of movement between targets.

The first pair being demonstrated here is E on-report B. I had to shoot the left-to-right rising chandelle, target E, over the trees, then turn 180 degrees to the right to shoot the teal, target B, as it rises behind the yellow tower. The method I used to shoot was to set my gun at the break point at the apex of the chandelle, bring the gun back to my hold point, then take my eyes

back to my visual pick up point. Then when the target was thrown, I locked on, pulled ahead, and shot – a classic CPSA Method shot. I then turned 180 degrees, keeping the gun just off my shoulder. I let the clay rise just past my barrel, and then swung to it and shot it at the apex of its flight path. It is important when moving 180 degrees between targets to agree with the referee which direction you will turn, so that he can keep himself and the squad standing to the opposite side than that which the gun will be moving through.

Next on this peg was A on-report E. Target A was a long left to right crosser. I set myself up to shoot it over the yellow tower, came back to my hold point, and brought my eyes back to the visual pick up point. I called 'pull', focused, locked on, pulled ahead and shot, the classic CPSA Method Shot. I then dropped the gun from my shoulder, turned 180 degrees to my right and brought the gun up to the hold point. I took my eyes

back, focused, locked on, pushed ahead and shot, again another CPSA Method shot, but on a steeply rising target.

It is important to note that although there can be significant movement of the body on on-report targets, there may be more time than you think to shoot the second target. A common fault is to rush the first shot, and then rush the change of position. If you have read the target properly, it may be slower than you might have thought it was, giving you more time to get a proper position to shoot the target.

And that's how to hit FITASC Sporting targets, using movement of the feet between targets on the pairs. This concludes this How to Hit series introducing FITASC Sporting, I hope you enjoyed it, it's now up to you to go out and give it a try. ☺

FITASC SPORTING IN SUMMARY

- 1 There has to be a horizontal line on the vest 25cm below the axis of the shoulder. The colour of the line must contrast the garment.
- 2 In the ready position, the heel of the stock must touch the body, and the rear point of the highest part of the stock must be below the line.
- 3 The gun cannot be mounted until the target is released and visible.
- 4 The gun cannot be pre-mounted for any reason before calling for the target.
- 5 Special targets such as mini, midi, battue, rabbit etc. must be specified on the menu.
- 6 The cartridge shot load must not exceed 28g with a pellet size not more than 2.5mm (6.5).
- 7 Only the first shooter in the squad will be shown the targets in the stand. The rest of the squad will watch from behind the stand.
- 8 The shooting stands are either one metre squares or one meter diameter circles.
- 9 Full use of the gun is allowed on single targets (i.e. two shots if needed).
- 10 Any cartridge case not dropped in the bin must be picked up after shooting, including semi auto shooters.

THREE WORDS TO DESCRIBE YOURSELF?

Strong, determined, and focused.

OBSTACLES AND HOW TO OVERCOME THEM

My biggest obstacle has been trying to figure out my method of shooting fast targets/sim pairs with one arm. I have to do them very different to other people as I can't follow the targets as quickly. I have had to practice hard to overcome this, even now it can still be challenging.

SHOOTING POST-CORONAVIRUS

Its been hard as I don't have anywhere to shoot outside of shooting grounds, so until they reopened I wasn't able to shoot. Now they are open, the waiting lines are long and you have to use hand sanitizer at every stand. This can be a little challenging for me given I can only use one arm, but I manage to do so, and understand why we have to do this.

REUBEN'S TOP TIP

I think the best tip I can give is to never give up, and to carry on practicing as it will come to you eventually and you will enjoy the sport so much more.

My biggest achievement to date is being nominated and coming runner-up as the CPSA's Disabled Shooter of the Year in 2020.

CHOOSING THE RIGHT GUN RIB



CPSA Senior Coach **Mike Williams** explains the different types of gun ribs, and how to choose the right one for you.

Different designs of ribs come into and out of fashion frequently, all intending to aid visibility and therefore target acquisition. The following is a summary of the most common ones:

FLAT RIB

Some shooters have a problem with flat-ribbed sporting shotguns. Specifically the drop at the heel measurement, which causes them to push their head forward and down onto the comb, to get some sort of eye-rib relationship. This movement and head position

reduces the field of vision and impacts on the amount of light hitting the retina, therefore making target acquisition more difficult. Pair this with the distortion of the target by any heat haze that is created in warm weather after shooting a few clays and the barrels warming up. The flat-rib design is preferred by a lot of shooters, but there are many alternatives also available.

HIGH RIB

The popularity of the high-ribbed gun in Trap shooting has seen manufacturers creating guns with progressively higher and higher ribs. This allows for an upright and comfortable head position, a wider field of vision, and allows more light onto the retina. In turn this speeds up target acquisition and is most beneficial in Trap and any driven type of target.

These guns normally print their pattern higher than the flat ribbed guns, which helps with trap targets as they are going

away and rising, and driven targets because a degree of lead is built in.

Seen primarily as a Trap shooting gun, it is gaining popularity in the Sporting and Skeet disciplines.


These types of ribs can be compared to the varied opinions of Marmite – they are either loved or hated. A lot of shooters swear by them, others swear because of them. If you are considering buying one – be sure to try it first, to make sure that you can shoot it well.

HIGH VENTILATED RIB

This provides for a straight-shooting plane, because the rib is displaced by some distance there is no interference from heat haze.

STEPPED RIB

The stepped-rib starts flat, going away from the action as normal and at some distance from the face features a pronounced step in height. Normally this type of gun has a comb that has less 'drop' at the heel than on a flat shooting gun. This step, combined with less drop, again promotes an upright head position

and more importantly a greater amount of light entering the eye than the lower head position allows. Consequently, Trap type targets are acquired earlier, which is beneficial when shooting any type of trap discipline.

WIDE RIB

Supposedly, the more metal on the rib, the quicker the heat generated by the barrels will dissipate and remove any heat haze. The width of the rib comes down to personal choice like a lot of things in shooting. I can see no real benefit in choosing one over the other, the focus should be the target, not the rib.

Each of these ribs has a bead located on them, which can be coloured or just plain brass.

Some manufacturers use attractive fibre-optics. The most important attribute the bead should have is that the shooter is not distracted by it. The bead should not be the centre of attention or focus – it should be the target to the exclusion of



TAPERED (HEIGHT) RIB

This type of rib starts higher at the back (near the action) and ends lower at the muzzle, normally shooting higher than a flat ribbed gun.

everything else. Some shooters appear transfixed by the bead being unable to take their focus from it. In these instances, removing the bead and taking this action can invariably remove the problem, as there is then nothing to take their focus from the target.

MID BEADS

Some barrels have a bead situated between the action and the front bead, called a mid-bead. This helps Trap shooters to align their gun perfectly after they have mounted. Replacing

the front bead with the mid-bead achieves a flat-shooting gun, whereas creating a figure eight with the front bead sitting on top of the mid bead causes the gun to shoot higher, the shooter seeing more rib in this configuration. Sporting

TAPERED (WIDTH) RIB

The tapered rib starts wide and narrows towards the muzzle, which is supposed to help visual contact with the target by bringing the focus into the target.

and Skeet shooters can't make as much use of this shooting aid, as there isn't time to align the beads when shooting. Their focus needs to be on the target – not the vertical orientation of the gun.

ADJUSTABLE COMBS

Many guns currently on the market are supplied with stocks with an adjustable comb, which allows the shooter to adjust the comb height to achieve their normal sight picture, without any of the ribs mentioned. Having done this, the tool that has been used to set the comb up needs to be locked away – otherwise there is a danger of messing about with the comb height whenever a target is missed.

The Monte Carlo stock fits the comb parallel to the rib. The most important attribute of this type of stock is that wherever the head is positioned, either forwards or backward on the stock, the height of the eye above the rib is constant and therefore, the shot placement consistent. ☺





NEED TO IRON OUT ANY BAD HABITS?

Lucy Earl – my story so far

I started shooting when I was around 15. My dad's friend introduced us to sporting through our local ground, which is when we bought a Beretta Silver Pigeon that we shared. I didn't start shooting competitions until I was nearly 17 after having some lessons from Phil Daniels, who taught me the basics. I was introduced to the competitive atmosphere by the Ladies Clay Shooting League. At my first event with them in 2019 I won High Gun and went on to place Runner-up in the league Overall. After starting at the Ladies League, I joined the CPSA and represented Cheshire for English Sporting at the Inter-Counties last year. I currently shoot a Syren Elos N2 sporting gun, which I shoot for both sporting and skeet.

I have since tried English and Olympic Skeet, DTL and Sporttrap. My favourite discipline is English Skeet. I have recently started to shoot some more DTL with a Miroku trap gun and I am really enjoying it. My favourite registered ground is Doveridge Clay Sports, because of the range of disciplines, and for non-registered I love Leek and District Gun Club.

I get pleasure from seeing my scores improve and knowing that my commitment and determination is paying off, but I obviously like breaking clays and winning competitions! I am thrilled to say that this year I joined Team Lyalvale Express. I applied to join the team through Central Guns.

In future, I'm planning on trying more disciplines to decide which one I want to pursue, whilst continuing to shoot Sporting and Skeet at a higher level and at some major competitions. I hadn't had many competitions planned for this year as I was meant to be sitting my A levels, but due to COVID-19 they were cancelled so I have had time to make some improvements before next year. I'm aiming to shoot at National level before I leave Juniors in a few years time, so I will be working towards this.

The advice I would give to someone looking to take up English Sporting is to get a few lessons with a good coach that works with your way of shooting instead of trying to change everything at once, so that you don't get the chance to pick up bad habits or get overwhelmed by so much change. I'd also say to not compare yourself to others too

much, because even though some healthy competition can inspire you to improve, constantly comparing scores with someone can be disheartening.

A good turnout with other Counties on a clear but windy day, resulting in yet another Championship win for Richard King with 89/100, easing out Ian Mulliner with the second best Dorset score of 85/100. Dean Webber took the top Veteran honours just as he did last year. Well done to them. Unfortunately no Dorset Ladies or Juniors took part.

I know that some shooters are rather wary, either by distances needed to travel to various events, or not believing that they can beat the big boys, who always seem to win everything they enter. They can be beaten, and everybody should try to do so. More especially this season when it is very important to support all shooting grounds after such a disastrous start to the season from COVID-19. Too many grounds have closed in our region. Of course shooters may well be affected

economically because of COVID-19 and nobody should put themselves into further financial difficulties, however those that can afford to shoot this year may want to think about doing disciplines that they would not normally take part in. Remember, every type of target is in some way a sporting target – Trap and Skeet disciplines will sharpen your reactions. Juniors in particular should try as many different types of target and discipline, unless directed not to do so by their advisors training them for greatness in a particular field.

Further results will have to wait for the August edition of *Pull!* but if anybody wishes to comment or report on any particular shooting event, please pass on a report to the Dorset Secretary. Perhaps some may wish to air a balanced opinion on how changes in rules caused by COVID-19 have affected, or are affecting, their enjoyment of the sport. Have the new rules worked, or perhaps could they be changed or improved upon? Good quality photos are always welcome. Safety equipment must be evident in any action shots with a gun.

Purbeck Shooting Ground will have re-opened by the time you read this article, as will Pilford G.C.

A new Dorset Secretary will have been appointed also, as Tony Read will be taking time out from shooting for the rest of this season for medical reasons.

Controlled Shooting

Then when you do get out on the layouts its ten or 15 deep at each stand, quite often you spend more time queuing than shooting. Fareham CTC give their members five days priority to phone and book, then invited non-members to fill any vacant time slots. For a £50 a year membership that guarantees you queue free shooting with time slots available from 10.00am until 2.00pm.

Once you've been round the 13 stands you may be lucky and get another late start time once you return to the club house.





ALAN POSKITT

Alan Poskitt passed away on 26 June at the age of 90, leaving behind a sterling legacy in the trap-shooting world. Alan's name was well known amongst clay shooters of the mid-20th century, held in esteem alongside his contemporaries such as Joe Wheater and Bob Browning.

Alan shot on the England DTL Team for 25 years straight, from 1950 to 1975, putting a new turn on the phrase '25-straight'. He was a four-times British Open DTL Champion (1966, 1968, 1970, 1972), and three-times winner of the The Forbes L. Smith Esq Cup (AA High Gun, also known as the Ladies Challenge Cup) at the Dougall Memorial (1953, 1963, 1971).

Alan also represented Great Britain in Olympic Trap in the early 1970's and went on to win Universal Trench Veteran World Champion in 1987 and Universal Trench Super-Veteran World Champion in 1999. Though not particularly known as an English Sporting shot, in 1968 he placed third in the first Shooting Times Sporting Championship, after a shoot-off following a three-way tie for first on 93ex100. He was also celebrated in America for being the first European to shoot a 100-straight in American Trap

Alan was a great advocate of local shooting and gave much of his time to coaching...

(similar to DTL Single Barrel) in the late 1960s.

His father, Gerry Poskitt, was an enthusiastic shooter, who passed his love of the sport down to Alan. He, then passed this on to his own son Trevor, who has 16 England Caps across DTL and English Sporting. Alan and Trevor even represented England together; the CPSA Championships report in the September 1974 issue of Shooting Magazine noted how 'the irrepressible Poskitts once again showed fine form' in the DTL Home International. They led England to victory with Alan shooting a perfect 100/300 and Trevor a 100/298. To this day, the Poskitt Cup is presented for the best parent/child score at the English Open DTL.

Despite his international presence, Alan was a great advocate of local shooting and gave much of his time to coaching and supporting local initiatives in his later years. He was President of East Yorkshire Clay Shooting Ground in the 1990s; a representative of the ground has stated that it was Alan's 'second home'. Many regular shooters remember his kind words of encouragement and advice that will be missed.

STEVE JOHNSON

A keen fast trap shooter since the 1980's, Steve represented his home county, Cheshire, on many occasions. He was a likeable and ebullient character, who would keep the clubhouse amused with his anecdotes and jokes between stages, then become a serious competitor when the time came to shoot. Steve sadly died on 17 May after a long battle with inoperable cancer; sadly, Steve's wife, Ann passed away suddenly and unexpectedly just weeks before Steve's death. They will both be missed.

A qualified electrical engineer, Steve had worked for MK Electricals and then for Honeywell Systems where he rose high in the UK Technical Sales team before retiring in 2018. Though clay shooting was Steve's passion, he was an accomplished golfer and skilful fly fisherman. He leaves behind a daughter, two sons and many friends.



HERE COME THE GIRLS

Imogen Waktare of GMK, the UK's leading shooting sports distributor, discusses her role at the company, and the impact COVID-19 has had on business with **Mark Brown**.

Q What impact did COVID 19 have on your business and also the brands that you import into the UK?

A: We came into 2020 feeling very optimistic and GMK started the year with strong sales of new models like the Beretta 694, and the DT11 Gold among many others. Then boom – COVID-19! We have remained operational throughout, with reduced staffing levels. Most staff were furloughed, myself included, but now some are back as we have become much busier, with grounds and shops reopening. Beretta have adapted their workplace, even posting a video 'Beretta – A New Normal' on YouTube.

Q Retail is beginning to open up again – how do you see the next few months going?

A: I think one of the hardest things is people missing out on what they are passionate about. Now we have the measures in place for grounds to reopen safely, and for shops to do the same. I really hope people seize the opportunity to get back out there. Unfortunately, there has been a loss of trade, but it has picked up and I hope it continues!

Q Are there any forthcoming plans to jump start sales?

A: Beretta are growing their offering for the 694, initially they launched a Sporting version, but this year we will have Trap, DTL, and Vittoria versions too. Benelli have announced the 828U Sport will be available in 32" for the 12 gauge, and a 20 gauge.

Q What opportunities and challenges do you see for clay shooting in the future?

A: The biggest challenge is getting people back out shooting, which could be tough if you are at higher risk. For grounds, it is managing a new way of running clay shooting. Our annual Beretta World Sporting Championship has been postponed to 11-13 September, which may turn out well, as it was very hot last summer. I think there is a real opportunity for 2021 to be a big year for events – people have missed out, and hopefully we can celebrate GMK's 50th in style!

Q How did you get into the industry/shooting?

A: My grandfather, Bjorn, started GMK (Gunmark as it was then) in 1971 with four others, and although my dad followed a career in medicine, his brothers joined the family business – Karl and Oskar who are now directors. We attended the Game Fair

A: I've done a bit of sporting clays, which is enjoyable with the different range of targets. It gives me a real buzz when I manage to take the advice given to break the target. I shot the National Ladies Shooting Day last year at St Clair's which was an amazing experience, a lovely group of people and a fun layout. I went along with Abi from the GMK Sales Department and a friend, Laura, who had never tried it before. It was

wonderful to see how much Laura got out of it, after her initial apprehension subsided. That is part of the fun for me, getting competitive, being outdoors and making memories.

Q How long have you been with GMK?

A: I started in January 2019 as a Marketing Executive, which initially entailed marking up magazines and looking after the social media while I got to grips with learning about our brands, products and the community. 




