I'd also like to thank the grounds that have supported our return to championships, whilst still maintaining the appropriate COVID-19 safety measures: Orston Shooting Ground, East Yorkshire Clay Shooting Ground, and the National Clay Shooting Centre.

CPSA AGM UPDATE

As you will be aware the March 2020 CPSA AGM was postponed due to the Covid-19 pandemic and is now being held on 24 October at 14:00 at the Chesford Grange Hotel, Kenilworth. All members are eligible to attend. We have once again appointed Civica (previously The Electoral Reform Services Ltd) to manage the voting process on our behalf.

On 21 September you will receive an email from support@cesvotes.com containing instructions on how to cast your proxy votes online. If you have previously submitted your proxy votes back in March 2020 you will not be able to resubmit your votes again. If the CPSA does not hold an email address for you on file, a letter will be sent to your address containing the necessary instructions. The letter should arrive by 1 October.

PREMIER LEAGUE FINAL

Sporting Shooters will be able to look forward to the CPSA Premier League Final at West London Shooting School on 26 September. This is open to all CPSA members – even if they have not participated in the League. This is a great opportunity to shoot one of the few Registered Shoots held at the beautiful grounds of West London, so we encourage all sporting shooters to attend. We will be opening bookings for this soon at championships.cpsa.co.uk, keep an eye on our website for more information.

SHOOT THE DIGITAL FUTURE OF OUR SPORT...

Live scores are coming as we get back to better than normal. Over the last few years, our IT department has been continuously working behind the scenes to modernise our systems and processes. This includes replacing core equipment (hardware and phones), implementing new software solutions (customer relationship management systems, cloud services, and websites), training users, refining new processes, and continuously improving our capabilities.

Thanks to the capabilities we now have, we were able to seamlessly transition as a team from the office at Bisley to all securely working remotely during lockdown, while continuing to provide normal operations and prepare for the safe return of clay shooting.

Part of our ongoing digital evolution to support the future of our sport, is to replace our current Shoot08 program, which allows the administration of competitions.

It is exciting that this much anticipated element of our digital road map is now in the final stage of internal testing, and we expect to be able to make it generally available following trials with a few grounds, who have kindly volunteered to help. We will begin to roll it out in a controlled manner, along with support and training, later in the year



and during next year.

Our new software, known as simply 'Shoot', is fully integrated with our core systems and will allow clubs and grounds to manage their fixtures, check member classifications, administer competitions, display leaderboard scores, and run live digital scoring. This will all be synchronised automatically in near real time (dependant on local connectivity).

'Shoot' will be available as apps for laptop, desktop, or tablet, on all common operating systems, with the ability to sync live scores to leaderboards. It will be able to run either on the internet or on a ground's local area network (Wi-Fi). Eventually, it will be possible for referees to use mobile devices to upload real-time scores as they happen, with scores appearing on our website that can be viewed from anywhere.

This will be a positive step forward for us and we are sure we will get lots of feedback and ideas over the coming years as it rolls out. We will keep adding new features over time, and keep continuously improving 'Shoot' into the future.

As a sneak preview we have included a few screenshots for you to have a look at and we very much look forward to you seeing our new solution in action at our clubs and grounds when you are shooting later this year. Until then, please continue to take care of each other, enjoy your shooting, stay safe and stay well.

PREMIER LEAGUE UPDATE

The third leg in the Northern Division of the Premier League series took place at Highwaymans Shooting Ground on Sunday 26 July. Many thanks to Simon Smith and all at Highwaymans for stepping in and hosting the Doveridge leg of the series.

Warm and sunny conditions prevailed to ensure a great turnout, with 192 shooters attending.

Many congratulations to Sam Green who was High Gun, with a superb 98ex100. Aaron Harvey was Runner-Up on 95ex100.

From a Premier League perspective, B Class shooter Callum Jarvis from Team Sporting Targets put in a cracking 84 to tie (with his B Class handicap applied) with multiple Sporting Champion Martin Myers on 94, so very well done Callum.

With no home advantage this time for any of the teams, Team Sporting Targets took the honours with their best top-ten score of 883ex1,000. Team Cambridge were Runners-up on 866ex1,000.

The penultimate leg in the Southern Division of the Premier League series took place on Saturday 8 August at Owls Lodge on one of the warmest days of the year, so thanks to all of the team and referees at Owls Lodge for coping with the heat. The searing temperatures didn't affect the shooters though, with

some 'scorching' scores. Particularly from Luke Elliott who was Overall High Gun with 97ex100. Steve Scott and Team E.J. Churchill's Phil Easeman tied on 96ex100 as Runners-up. Once again, great shooting!

Individually, Colt shooter Dan King from Team Southdown returned to the top spot

In respect of the Premier League, many congratulations to Team Owls Lodge shooter Colin Ferguson in B Class who scored a superb 89, uplifted to 99 with his handicap applied, helping his team to take full advantage of home conditions to put in a big score of 920ex1,000 – 46 ahead of Team Southdown on 874ex1,000.

So after three fixtures in each division we can take a look at the overall positions going into the last leg in each division with updated classifications.

Team Owls Lodge's big score on their home fixture edged them into pole position in their division, with their three scores combined totalling 2,650 – twenty points above Team Southdown on 2,630.

In the North Division, Team Sporting Targets top their table with 2,552, with Team Cambridge in second place on 2,480. It is the best three top-ten scores from each division and the final which count overall, but the standing in each

division from one to four after the divisional fixtures adds bonus points (up to max ten points for first place) going into the final at West London on 26 September. Each shoot is vital to gaining the maximum team points available.

Individually, Colt shooter Dan King from Team Southdown returned to the top spot with his 88ex100 in A Class, giving him a 93 with his handicap applied, and a best three so far of 277ex300. This places him four ahead of AA shot Ivan Spencer from Team Atkin Grant & Lang on 273ex300.

As with the teams, it is the best three scores which count, including the final where an additional bonus point is also available for shooting this fixture.

We now look forward to the next leg in the South Division at Atkin Grant & Lang on Saturday 29 August, and at Sporting Targets in the North Division on the Bank Holiday Monday 31 August. Reports will follow on those in the next issue.

Level 1 Instructor Training Course (ITC)

£695

This four-day course teaches you how to check eye dominance and gun fit. It shows you how to teach the CPSA Method, how to recognise shooting errors and how to correct them. It consists of classroom time, off-and on-range workshops and a final day of assessments. It covers crossing, rising and dropping targets and equips instructors with the knowledge to tackle a huge variety of targets. For this course, the criteria for qualification is that the candidate can get a novice to hit a moving target safely using the CPSA Method. Candidates must have attended an IDW within the previous two years.

Shotgun Skills Course (SGS)

ENGLISH OPEN SPORTRAP 2020

Richard Faulks reports back on the English Open at Orston Shooting Ground on 17-19 July.

This year's English Open Sportrap was hosted by Orston Shooting Ground in Nottinghamshire, on 17-19 July, and saw Sam Green (Current World FITASC Sporting Champion) crowned champion by default on the final day. He managed to match Junior William Fenner's impressive 147ex150 score, shot on 18 July. Sadly William was unable to return for the shoot-off due to living four hours away from the ground. There was some consolation for him though, as well as being equal High Gun, he also won the Junior High Gun prize.

The weather could not have been more perfect on the Sunday – 20 degrees with blue sky and a light breeze. Sam Green was shooting in the penultimate squad and had dropped two targets on the first layout, so with little room for error left, and knowing that a 147 score had been set the previous day, you could feel the tension rising. Layout five was where things really became interesting! Sam was on his third stand when one of the traps for the target he was about to shoot started spitting out broken clays, but the ground staff were swiftly on the



as well as being equal High Gun, he also won the Junior High Gun prize.



Orston's Dan Martin set a course of six, 25-bird Sportrap layouts with something for everyone, set in the open and beautifully manicured lawns of the shooting ground. Both Sam Green and Richard Faulks MBE told me they thought it was a fair layout and very much came down to concentration – especially as there were no breaks between layouts. There were two targets in particular though that seemed to be challenging most of the shooters – a long right-to-left curling crosser on the second layout and a tricky to read teal,

which appeared from behind a high hedgerow on layout five. This was the one that levelled Sam and Willam's score at 147.

This is the first titled CPSA competition to take place at Orston and it was very impressively run. Coronavirus did mean that the safety of staff and shooters alike was of paramount concern and social distancing was observed, with one-way systems at the stands and cafe, and sanitising stations easily available for all. Shooters were also encouraged to arrive just before their allotted squad time and then leave when reasonably possible.

Dan and Emily Martin bought Orston Shooting Ground

four years ago and have invested heavily in new equipment, including changing all of the traps. They're also running different competitions every Sunday at Orston and have expanded the on-site shop. They'll be hosting the Clay Shooting Classic for the next two years and also the British Schools & Young Shots Championships next year. They are also trying to expand this side of the business. The ground covers all the popular clay disciplines including DTL, ABT, SKT, ESP, Sprotrap and they have a game arena. They had a 100-bird ESP competition on the Sunday of this event too, for anybody keen enough to try their hand at both. 🦉

ENGLISH OPEN SKEET DOUBLES CHAMPIONSHIP

CPSA South East Region Director, **Peter Saich**, recounts the event at The National Clay Shooting Centre on 25 & 26 July.



This event was held over two days at the NCSC in Surrey, following the Government and CPSA safe distancing guidelines.

The NCSC staff had implemented a well-signed, one-way system through the clubhouse, including marked routes to the Café, loos, booking-in etc. They also spaced the start times for squads to allow a 'shoot-and-go' policy to avoid unnecessary contact in the Café, car park etc.

The shooting started in good weather conditions at lunchtime on Saturday, but this unfortunately changed into persistent rain and dark clouds for the

last squad out at 3pm. Despite the changeable light conditions, there were some good scores recorded. The best scores of the day in the Seniors were Iain Parkinson and Peter Chester, both scoring 99/100. In the Ladies category, Hannah Gibson scored 96 and Emma Parkinson scored 95.

Sunday saw a full day's shooting in alternating sun and cloud, with very little rain. The targets set up by the NCSC team were good for the whole event.

There were no 100s scored but a few people came close. Peter Stanton-Hope scored 98, Junior Harry Willis scored 97 and Colt Sonny Bowman scored 95. Natalie Bales had travelled from Wales and shot 97 to lead the Ladies category, then on the last squad, local

shooter Martin Brister recorded 99 to tie for first place.

The club had decided before the start of the competition that they would stick to the original CPSA guidelines and published that they would only have a shoot-off for Overall High Gun. Iain Parkinson elected not to return, but

Peter Chester did, which made for a thrilling 'sudden death' shoot-off over alternate pairs on peg 4. Peter shot first, hitting his first 12 targets perfectly, only to be matched by Martin at every stage. On the fourth rotation, Peter hit the first two, then the next two slipped away. Martin stepped up and hit all four to take the title.

Myself and John Martin (and Kenji) from the CPSA

were in attendance for the whole event, and I held the final presentation to Martin Brister, and also thanked the few people who had stayed for the shoot-off and presentation. I would like to thank the NCSC staff for a smoothly run event with good attention to social distancing. This was a very good practice for the new NCSC management team who are hosting the three-day British Open English Skeet at the end of August.

Well done to the NCSC team and to all the competitors, and we hope to see you all back at the NCSC for the British Open English Skeet. 🍌

THE PEOPLE EFFECT

CEO and High-Performance Expert for SportExcel, **Bob Palmer**, discusses training your brain to be competition-ready.



BOB PALMER

CEO and High-Performance Expert for SportExcel, has been training clay target shooters to podium for 20 years, at the competitive recreational and Olympic levels, all around the world. He has published two books (*Mind vs Target* and *A Mind to Win*), hundreds of articles and many videos dedicated to shooting excellence – and winning. The moment you step out of your vehicle at a competition, 'the People Effect' takes hold and your friends, opponents, family members, and competition officials become either your downfall, your savior or both. They are your friends in a social context and distractions to your game, and although controlling people is impossible, taking steps to counter the People Effect can make the difference between winning and losing.

I know that this sounds hard-edged,

but I've met very few shooters whose sole reason for attending competitions is social. Social shooting is a different animal. You shoot with a loose sense of shooting etiquette, and advice is often dispensed quite liberally.

"What is your lead?"

"You're shooting above, below, ahead, behind, etc."

"Keep your head on the stock."

Serious shooters tend to avoid and/or tolerate this type of environment, as they know that there is a line to be



drawn between socializing well and shooting well. Sometimes, however, we need better tools with which to draw the social/competitive line in shooting, before others draw it for us.

PROBLEMATIC SQUAD MATES

Even when you are cautious with whom you socialize, the round itself can throw you for a loop. What if you are squaddied with very slow shooters? The kind where you want to pull the trigger for them? Or you are shooting with fast shooters and you feel compelled to increase your speed beyond your comfort zone? Are you shooting with champions and feel completely out of your league?

UNDERSTANDING THE PEOPLE EFFECT

By understanding that your shooting partners will affect your game, whether at the higher-end (solid skills and routines), lower-end (weak skills and routines), or anywhere in between, you need to keep your own game on a steady course, and unaffected by all

the different kinds of behaviors people throw at you. In order to win, you can challenge the People Effect in three different ways:

A Leadership Approach,

A Buffer-Zone Approach, or the 'Tony Soprano' Approach. (There is a fourth approach and it involves being a grumpy old man or woman where everyone leaves you alone. I'll skip that one, and you might too, as we are talking about balance here!)

Please see a breakdown of these three approaches in the column to the right.

MOVING FORWARD

People are fun to socialize and shoot with, but they may also get in the way of performing well and winning. With a balanced approach, you needn't

lose friends. Instead, take leadership, apply a buffer-zone and use appropriate strategies to make distracting individuals disappear. By identifying and taking action regarding the People Effect, the podium will likely await you. 🍀

CHALLENGING THE PEOPLE EFFECT

1 THE LEADERSHIP APPROACH

The leadership approach is one of the best ways to deal with the People Effect, and it involves using copious amounts of adrenaline with frequent mental rehearsals of crushed targets leading to the podium. In a game like clays, it wires your brain for winning, and gives you a powerful feeling that is hard for anyone to penetrate. You also get a very interesting side effect – you become the leader of your squad where everyone has a better overall performance.

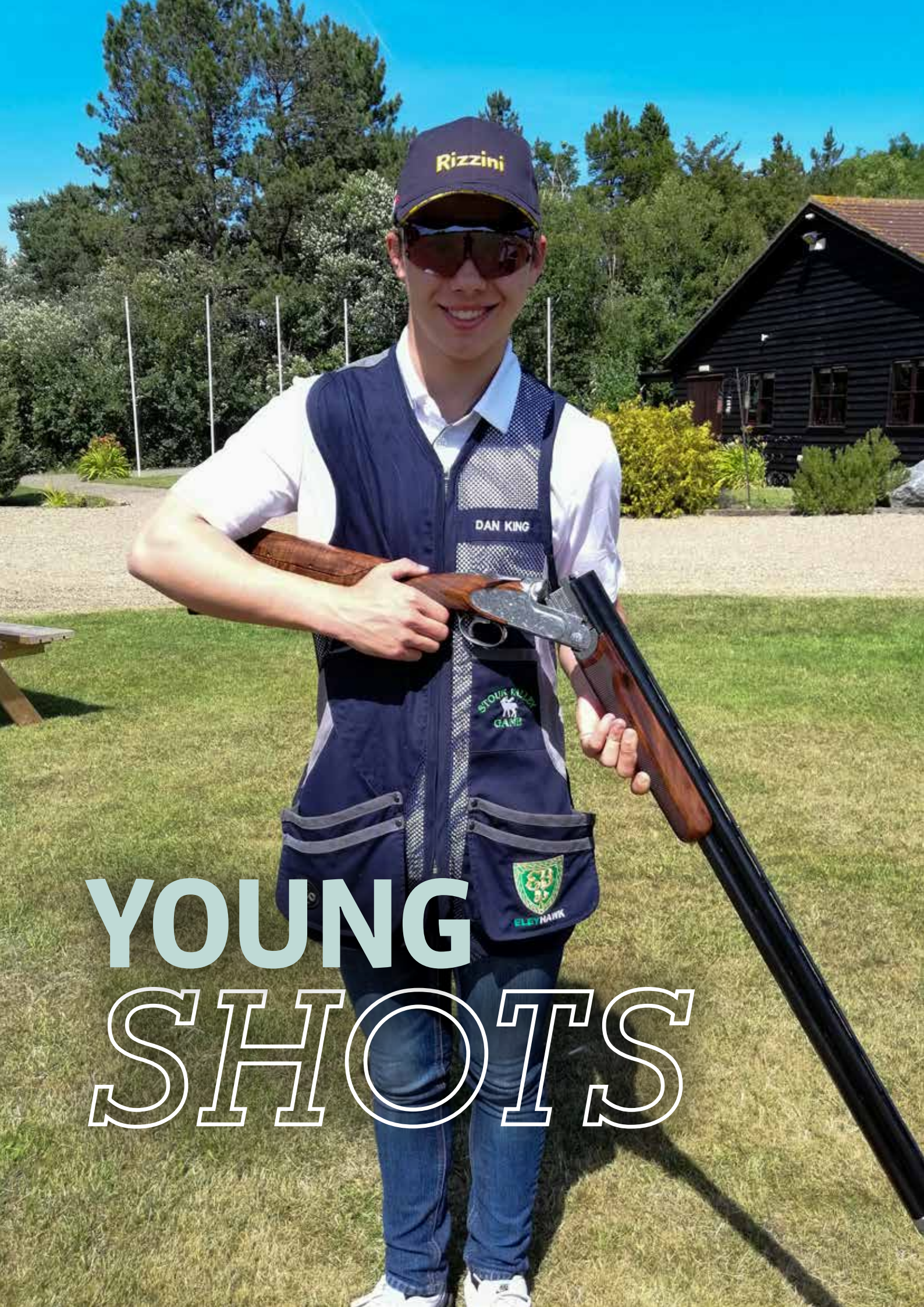
2 A BUFFER-ZONE APPROACH

The Buffer-Zone Approach is an avoidance approach. It may be anti-social, but only slightly. In a 30-minute time period before you shoot, you keep a buffer zone between you and all others as you initiate your pre-game strategies. Partly, it keeps you focused by allowing you to visualize and prepare, but mostly it lets people know you are serious so they leave you alone. Most people will respect this. (For younger shooters, I suggest they enlist a parent or coach to shield them from opponents and opponents' coaches.)

3 THE 'TONY SOPRANO' APPROACH

The Tony Soprano approach works to completely 'disappear' other shooters, officials and distractions, as it trains your brain to ignore them and their behaviors – not quite as Mr. Soprano might, but as effectively. It comes with one of my rules: if you can see your opponent, he or she has beaten you. As unbelievable as it might sound, it is a very neat visualization where you project you and your opponent on an imaginary stage and perceive yourself growing head and shoulders over them until they disappear in the visualization. As you are dealing with perception here, you are simply training your brain to only see the range and the targets. It can be very effective when done well. However, I suggest you allow them to reappear after the day of shooting so that you can enjoy the social part of being at a shoot.

- TIP 1** Remember to always focus on the target
- TIP 2** Don't let your head drop if you're missing a target, it will come
- TIP 3** Practice regularly, but don't over shoot – little and often is better
- TIP 4** Try different guns to get the right fit, if you're still growing this will change! (An adjustable comb would be better)
- TIP 5** Above all else – enjoy your shooting.

GUN UP, GUN DOWN WHAT'S IT TO BE?

Mike Williams CPSA Academy Senior L3 Coach talks about the benefits of both gun-up and gun-down shooting techniques.

It's all a matter of personal choice really, major sporting and skeet championships have been won by both gun-up and gun-down competitors, so it looks as if there is no advantage using one method over the other. There are pros and cons for either, the gun-up shooter can ensure that they have a 'perfect' mount, a constant sight picture, the barrels not too high (as to obscure the target) but the initial inertia of the 'dead-gun' effect has to be overcome by a bit of practice. The gun-down shooter, on the other hand, uses core body movement to generate a smooth, fluid swing to the target, has a clear view of the target (as the gun is out of his or her eye line) but to

achieve a constant sight picture every time the gun mount has to be perfect to ensure the correct movement of the gun, from rest to the shoulder socket and cheek, whilst bringing the gun to the target simultaneously. This is going to take a lot more time to overcome.

Both English Sporting and English Skeet give you the option to shoot with the gun in or out of your shoulder (gun up or down) when calling for your target. FITASC Sporting, on the other hand, gives you no option and you must start with the gun out of your shoulder, the heel of the gun under the FITASC line on the shooter's vest.

It must stay there until the target comes into

view. If the gun is moved above the line before the emergence of the target, a warning is given, should it happen again, then the target is lost as it is with any further occurrence of the same

fault. The line is embroidered on the vest and located 25cm from the central axis of the shoulder.

Olympic Skeet is another discipline where the gun must be out of the shoulder and complying with the ready position when calling for the target.

The gun-up shooter has all the time in the world (within reason and a patient referee) to get the gun mounted perfectly, whereas the gun-down shooter doesn't have that luxury, their gun mount has to be as near perfect as possible. We have ►

an exercise that will achieve that, should you want to give FITASC Sporting a go, which utilises the 'parallel mount'. You will need a decent size mirror for this exercise.

As the position of the eye on the rib determines where the shot is placed, we are going to mount the gun to our shooting eye (the one that is over the rib). Stand three or four metres from the mirror. Adopt your normal shooting stance facing the mirror with the gun

becomes very easy to mount the gun to the target simultaneously with it coming into your face and shoulder socket.

out of your shoulder situated comfortably at your waist and the barrels parallel to the ground. Start with the gun from this position and with both hands working in unison with one another, raise the gun to your shoulder socket and cheek simultaneously, ensuring that the barrels and stock are lifted as one, the barrels neither leading nor lagging the stock. Mount the gun to your iris (coloured part of the eye) so that it is sitting centrally on the rib.

On the range when shooting a target, starting at the hold position, the gun is held parallel to the target and just under its flight path. It then

Repeat this movement five times then close your eyes, mount the gun again and check where the gun is pointing with relation to your eye. The day that you open your eyes and the rib is smack under your eye, your hard work will have been rewarded and you will have achieved a perfect parallel mount, which will give you the advantage of only having to focus on the target, not the mount nor the whereabouts of the rib.

Do this practice for five-ten minutes a day and you will achieve the necessary muscle memory in two and a half to three months. Olympic athletes say that installing muscle memory takes approximately 10,000 repetitions of the exact movement to become permanent. Don't rush it, take your time and get it perfect, the speed will come.

Only perfect practice makes perfect, practice without direction makes permanent! You need to input the correct action right from the start.

THE PIVOT MOUNT

The pivot mount is used for Olympic Skeet. We need a fast, accurate mount for Olympic Skeet because of the target's speed, the timing of the release (which is variable) and the gun being out of the shoulder until the target is in view. Unlike English Skeet, the target

DRY MOUNT PRACTICE

Dry mount practice can be achieved in the lounge by facing a wall and mounting the gun to various spots on the wall, either in the wallpaper or spots that you have placed on it.

Just adopt your stance with the gun in the ready position and then mount to each of the spots in succession for about five-ten minutes a day. Again, take your time and don't rush, you are creating that muscle memory which over time will improve the consistency of the mount, and your scores.

GUN PLACEMENT

The gun needs to be mounted in the shoulder socket with the heel of the gun just under the top of the shoulder, at the same location each time.

CHEEK PLACEMENT

The bottom of the cheekbone needs to be on the top of the comb (providing the gun fits). This ensures that the eye is placed centrally over the rib and at the same height every time the gun is mounted achieving a constant sight picture and consistency in shot placement.

FINGER PLACEMENT

The part of your finger that should be in the middle of the trigger blade is the first section (under the nail) of your index finger, not the crease of that first section. If the edge of the trigger blade is on this crease, you may be unable to place any pressure onto the blade which will result in the gun not firing.

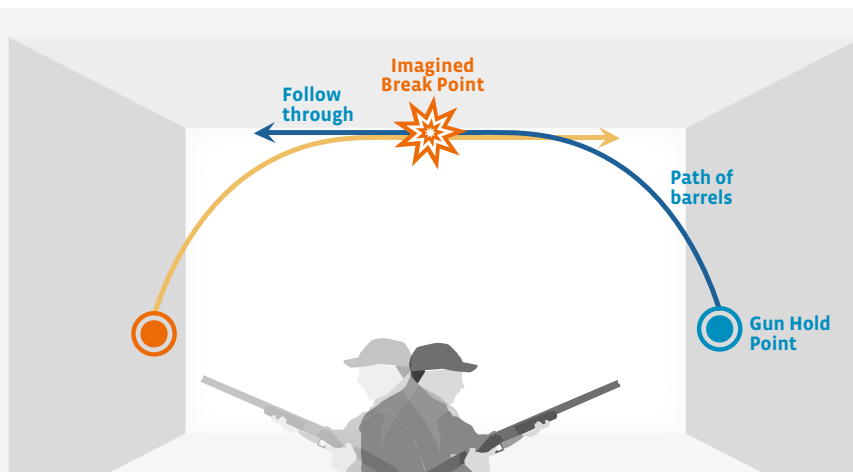

is not (necessarily) released on your call. It may be released immediately, or anything up to three seconds later, and if the gun is moved before the emergence of the target a penalty is invoked. The gun's stock must be below the line on the shooter's vest which corresponds to the lowest point of the elbow (of the shooting shoulder). The stock is relatively low to the barrels in the ready position, the barrels will need to be moved forward at the same time as it is pivoted around the forehead bringing the stock to the shoulder socket and cheek. Without this movement, a see-sawing action could be induced, the gun oscillating high and low on the target. The gun is driven smoothly and fluidly to the target using the body's core (not the arms in isolation), with the feet pointing to the break zone.

There is no time like the present to improve your mount, providing you need to. You will never get another opportunity like it so go on, install that muscle memory, you'll never regret it! These exercises may seem a bit of a pain, as there's no quick fix in this game, but it's the only way you will eventually be able to perfect your mount. 🏹



SWING PRACTICE

The aim here is to achieve a smooth fluid swing, coupled with the ability to follow the line of the target and overcome stopping the gun as soon as the trigger is pulled. You will need a Snap Cap for this exercise – start by standing in the middle of the room facing a wall in the lounge (close the curtains so you don't frighten the neighbours) and the gun halfway up the wall in the corner to your right (if right-handed) because a right to left movement is your natural direction of swing (halfway up the wall on the left-hand corner if left-handed). Start the mount by moving the gun from the ready position

(at your waist) on a tangent to the line where the wall meets the ceiling, the same time that you are bringing the gun to your shoulder socket and face. Follow the line of this join to the centre of the wall, pull the trigger and keep the gun moving to the far corner. Bring the gun down and open, replace the Snap Cap and this time, start with the gun half-way up the wall on the left-hand side and repeat the exercise. Do this for about five-ten minutes a day and your mount will become smoother, unrushed and the whole movement more fluid than before and you will have mastered moving and mounting at the same time.

Don't forget that if you use snap caps for this exercise, the place to leave them when you are done is at home, and separate from your live cartridges to avoid any confusion.

After seeing the prototype of the Zenith at the British Shooting Show back in February, we were more than a little excited to finally get our hands on it to test and review. We met up with Andy Norris from UK importers,

Viking Arms, to learn more about the new model and put it through its paces.

First impressions are very good indeed, opening up the branded ABS case gives the first glance of a test gun with beautifully figured wood on both stock and fore-end, a modern and stylish simple black action with the Breda logo in gold. Handling the gun, it is perfectly balanced, coming up to the shoulder perfectly and the tapered rib

(11mm down to 7mm) gives a wonderful sighting picture. It's worth noting here that the Zenith ships with a 15" stock as standard which I found very refreshing, as it was the perfect length for me and fitted perfectly straight out of the box. The chequering was crisp and clean, and the palm swell on the stock was a very welcome feature too.

The test gun was the 30" version, although a 32" version is available too. There is also the option for a silver action and custom stocks.

The Zenith had a very solid and satisfying feel when loading and unloading, it certainly gives you the feel of a quality gun when in use.

Another interesting feature from Breda is the use of titanium on the barrel block and fore-end action – quite simply if it wears, out you just replace.

On to shooting and the Zenith continued to impress, patterns were tight and consistent and delivered solid breaks, even at the most testing of ranges. The gun is very well balance and at just over 7.5lbs it was effortless to move and surprisingly handled recoil very well. We were using 1/4 and 1/2 chokes for the test, which

worked well in conjunction with the 75mm forcing cones. The Zenith ships with five Maxi 90mm extended chokes, ventilated barrels and top rib, and a seven position adjustable trigger as standard. It was a

pleasure shooting the Zenith and I have to admit that I was impressed by both its performance and features.

I did not know the cost of the gun before the test and on finding out the price afterwards I was sure that there was a mistake. What Breda have managed to achieve and deliver here is a high-quality product aimed squarely at the mid-level market but bring it in at a very competitive price.

Yes, the gun has all of the features that you would expect in a gun costing at least £1,000-£2,000 or more, but there is absolutely no compromise in quality anywhere in order to deliver this. When testing the Zenith, we had a number of guns from other manufacturers costing substantially more in use at the same, and there was no discernible difference between them and that is

remarkable. Quite how Breda have managed to deliver this gun at this price is a real mystery to me!

The Zenith offers a serious alternative to those willing to look outside of the box a little, quality Italian engineering and craftsmanship at a very competitive price, backed with a strong heritage of gun making. I would urge you to test out the Zenith at the earliest opportunity. 🦉

OBITUARIES

ROGER COLLINGHAM

Roger Collingham, one of the great characters of the shooting world, passed away on 16 July.

Following a routine hip operation last year, Roger became ill and spent several weeks in hospital, from which he never fully recovered. Earlier this year he was diagnosed with cancer and was recently admitted to hospital again with an unrelated infection.

Roger did manage to get home from hospital but died shortly afterwards.

Roger was well known in Nottinghamshire and the Midlands as the owner of Cockett Farm Shooting Ground, but was known more widely in clay shooting circles as the main referee for, and one of those responsible for pioneering, the White Gold Cup.

In association with Gamebore and Matchroom Promotions, the White Gold Cup was developed to be easy for both grounds to stage and TV to film. The competition was based around a standard skeet range and is reputedly acknowledged as the format that inspired the Sportrap discipline. At its peak, shooting grounds around the UK held qualifying events, with the finals held at a prestigious venue for the Sky TV cameras – usually Weston Park in Shropshire, with a prize fund of £25,000.

Roger shot as a regular member of the Nottinghamshire Skeet team in the 80s and 90s, however game shooting,

particularly partridge, was Roger's main passion.

Recognising that there was very little in the way of practice facilities for this, he developed a new discipline – High Skeet. This was based around two 30ft towers built on a skeet range, this gave the ideal height and speed to replicate the local partridge shoots and is a popular discipline at the ground even to this day.

Although the ground does not hold any competitions, Roger was always keen to support the competitive development of shooters, and was happy to offer the ground's facilities to the Lincolnshire and Nottinghamshire

Juniors. These programs have delivered some of our brightest talent that have gone on to become real world-class contenders, including Aaron Heading, Carl Exton, and Emma Wheeldon. Roger also went out of his way to open out of hours to give some of the GB Olympic Skeet team (Roger Ford and Richard Marshall) somewhere to practice.

Roger leaves behind a huge pair of shoes to fill and will be missed by his many friends. The shooting world will be a lesser place without him, and I feel privileged to have known him, both as a friend and Father in Law.

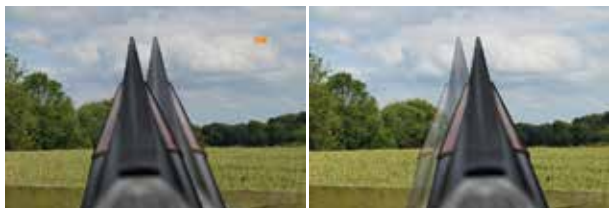

WE ARE **GREEN** WITH ENVY

We spoke to **Sam Green** about the past, present, and future of his shooting journey.



shooting. Keeping cool, calm, and relaxed is definitely key. It also helps to set realistic goals and aim to achieve them one step or goal at a time.

Q It's been a difficult year for the sport – how do you see the future of clay shooting looking?

A: The future of our sport is definitely heading in the right

direction at the moment, it's been a very difficult year for a lot of people. Now that many people are back out shooting, practice shoots and competitions are slowly making their return. I think people are enjoying the squadded systems and most competitions are running smoothly. A lot of us shooters should use this time to prepare for next year's shooting season if possible – it's a great time to put all those little things that might be going wrong to bed.

Q What's coming up in the next year for Sam Green?

A: This year I had a big year planned and set out, but sadly it was put back due to Coronavirus. I will now be looking to make the most of the remaining fixtures, focusing on a high standard of shooting and working on my average scores for the end of the year. 🍀

Q It's been an amazing 12 months for you – what has been your proudest or most special moment and why?

A: I am most proud to have won the FITASC World Championships at E.J. Churchill last year. There is nothing that will compare to the feeling of being on top of the world after a win, and the drive that it gives you to work even harder in this sport.

Q Did you feel there was any added nerves/pressure to win the English Open Sportrap win at Orston on 17-19 July, after having such a long break from competitions?

A: So far this year I've been very happy with my shooting and have had some very good scores on return from lockdown. That being said, we all have bad days at some point, and it's just knowing how to move on from that score or day.

Heading in to the English Open Sportrap, I didn't feel any additional nerves or fear of the course prior to

the competition. Of course everybody wants to win a major and this year it's harder than ever, as there are not so many running. There is more pressure there to perform on the right days as everybody is aiming for that same title.

Q What are the most important elements that help you win?

A: The equipment I use definitely helps to boost my performance.

I shoot a Browning XS, and there is no other cartridge for me apart from the Hull Cartridge Parcours 7.5. Having confidence in your equipment is key, and I believe in keeping your equipment simple.

Having the right people around you is very important also – most people know I tend to shoot with my good friend Darran Stanford, as he

knows when I need a few words of encouragement, or equally when to just say nothing!

Obviously the drive and ambition to win plays a big part in success, whether it be a straw bale shoot or the World Championships, there is only one first place winner.

Q Can you give us some tips and advice for young shooters trying to get ahead in the sport?

A: There really are no shortcuts in this sport. Hard work and dedication are important, and taking every shoot as an experience and a learning curve. One thing we see a lot from youngsters at a shooting ground is bad temper when things aren't going right – unfortunately this will never help their

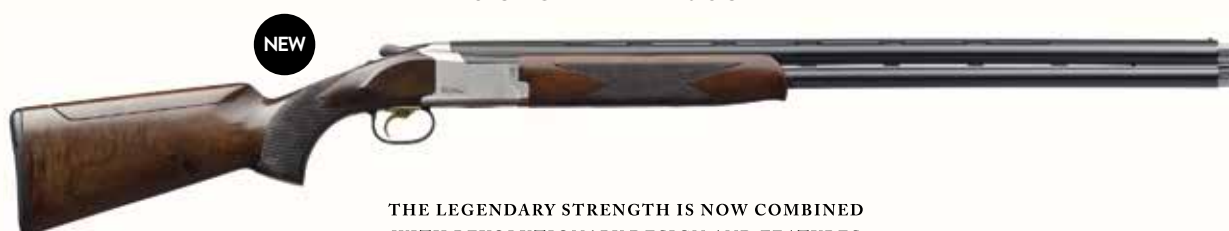

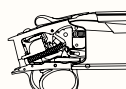

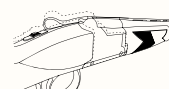
