CLUBHOUSE NEWS



We are pleased that the government has announced that outdoor sports, including clay target shooting, can re-open on 29 March and that our members can return to the sport they love. We had hoped for an earlier date, given the arguments presented to the Department of Digital, Culture, Media, and Sport over the past year that outdoor sports can operate in a COVID-19 secure manner. However, we are thankful that shooting grounds and our sport can open up in the first phase of lockdown easing.

Squads/groups of up to six shooters will be allowed to shoot together, so long as the Referee can safely distance from the squad. For up-to-date information please see cpsa.co.uk/news.



CPSA TRAINING COURSES

Following the easing of lockdown restrictions, all CPSA training courses will resume from 12 April 2021. Under the circumstances, we have had to reschedule some of the planned course dates advertised in Pull! magazine, so please refer to the Courses section of our website for the most up to date information, at cpsa.co.uk/courses.

MEMBERSHIP CARDS

As a reminder, in 2019 the CPSA Board of Directors decided to reduce costs and plastic waste by discontinuing the yearly re-issue of membership cards. The card that you received in 2020 will be the last one that you will be issued and has no expiry date on it. So long as your membership is valid, so then is the card. If you bought a two-year membership in 2019, then you will receive a final card in 2021 on renewal.

New members will receive a card on joining, but this will not be reissued. All grounds hosting CPSA Registered shoots have the ability to check the status of your membership by using our scorekeeping software (Shoot). Membership insurance certificates as well as a digital version of the card (with expiry date on it) can be downloaded at cpsa.co.uk/members.

GAME FAIR GIVEN GREEN LIGHT

As Prime Minister Boris Johnson outlined his roadmap to recovery, The Game Fair, along with all other events, was given the green light to run on its planned dates of 23-25 July at Ragley Hall. "Having been in continuous talks with the local authority and Public Health England, we were already very confident, but a public statement such as this is incredibly important" said James Gower, Managing Director of The Game Fair. "Exhibitors and visitors have shown their optimism too, as trade stand and tickets sales accelerated immediately following the BBC's live

press briefing which confirmed the news that had been earlier announced in Parliament.

Many events have not survived, and some who are governed by delicate charitable or societal structures simply couldn't take the risk to run this year and took early decisions to close. As a result, The Game Fair will be more important than ever in assisting recovery for many exhibiting companies – some who solely trade on the show circuit.

LE CHAMEAU: THE ART OF BOOT-MAKING

In 1927, in a seaside village in Normandy France, Claude Chamot had a desire to create the most comfortable and best fitting rubber boot. He had listened to farmers, hunters, and fishermen who all wanted a boot that would withstand their daily labours. Now, almost 100 years later, Monsieur Chamot's vision continues. From the first to the last touch, there is history in the making of every pair of the iconic green wellington boots.

The quality is down to a mixture of factors – from the raw materials to the experienced rubber craftsmen

and stringent quality control process.

Like any natural product, the quality of rubber is determined by how it is produced. Le Chameau's rubber is sourced from Vietnam, where they have been working with the same highly-regarded plantation since 2005.

To produce the rubber, each Pará rubber tree is tapped to produce raw latex, every care is taken to

ensure this is properly harvested so as not to harm the trees. The liquid latex is allowed to coagulate and can then be collected and processed into its dry form, which is packed into loaves. The loaves are graded from A to D – grades are determined by colour, purity and stickiness. Le Chameau uses only Grade A rubber, which is light coloured and has low ash and dirt content.

Once the loaves arrive at the Morocco workshop, Le Chameau add a few secret ingredients to produce their famously supple Chamolux rubber. This recipe is still based on Claude Chamot's original mix – producing soft, supple, and durable rubber which forms the basis of all of the Le Chameau boots. The most critical element in the boot-making process are the people. Le Chameau are proud to have several generations of maître bottiers forming part of the Le Chameau family, a highly technical role which requires upwards of nine months of intensive training.

Le Chameau take great pride in setting the standards for the production of rubber boots.

The journey can be summarised into the following points:

- Preparing the rubber – the special recipe is mixed into raw rubber and rolled around rollers until it is the

perfect thickness, the rubber is then cut to shape, and hand trimmed.

- Taking shape – now the rubber is soft, thin, and malleable the maître bottier covers an aluminium boot-shaped mould, enhanced with liquid latex to make it strong and stable. This is where reinforcement occurs for the Chasseur and Saint Hubert.
- Building the sole – the base sole is made by adding the formula of rubber to the bottom of a two-part mould, as the rubber heats and spreads through the mould, it forms the shape of the sole.
- Preparing the lining – from neoprene and jersey to leather, each lining is cut using large pattern pieces and follows a strict quality check.
- Assembly – this is where the maître bottier really demonstrate their art, the lining and rubber are bonded, and the sole and logo badge are added.
- Vulcanisation – the fully assembled boots are then 'cooked' to stabilise the rubber and fuse the many layers.
- Testing every pair – Le Chameau are committed to quality, every single boot is tested to ensure its 100% waterproof
- Final touches – after all the quality checks all that's left to do is give the boots a polish and send them off to their new owners in their iconic boot boxes.

LETTER OF THE MONTH

This is always a difficult one regarding payouts at grounds, as my husband and I have been shooting Registered shoots for 20 or so years now. I don't shoot so much anymore, just monthly now, but he is still going strong with several competitions most weeks.

Years ago when the good old pen and paper were still in action, the scores from the day were always written on a board at the shoot along with the number of entries, so the payout system was always very clearly understood.

Now things have moved on with technology and screens are now used, you get to see the scores throughout the day but there is no payout divide, so it's down to the grounds to be honest with the amount of entries they have and the payout they provide to the shooters.

Recently we have noticed

some grounds seem to be paying very little, while others will pay a good substantial amount of money. Some are also paying through bank transfer and others happy to pay cash, some are paying swiftly while others are not so much!

The cost of the entry fee is the same at every ground give or take a pound – yet some find it necessary not to pay out for a month or sometimes even more.

I know COVID-19 has had a big impact on everything this year, but shooters are definitely out and about again supporting the grounds. Most grounds are fair and upfront, but I would like to ask the grounds holding prize money for whatever reason, to take a leaf out of your fellow grounds' book and please pay shooters in a reasonable amount of time.

GOLDEN MEMORIES

Peter Wilson MBE won Double Trap gold at the London 2012 Olympics – a life-changing event which he explains to **Will Hetherington**.

At the London 2012 Olympics the towering and fresh-faced Peter Wilson, just 25-years-old at the time, retained his composure to surge to Double Trap gold for Great Britain. In the tense final he actually dropped a pair of targets, giving rise to fears of a sensational collapse with the end in sight. However, he dug deep into his training and held his nerve to shoot 188 and hold off Sweden's surging Hakan Dahlby by two targets. As Peter secured the gold – he dropped to his knees and the watching world could almost see the pressure released as he did so.

At the time it was raining Gold medals for the host nation, so the man from Dorset's success at the dazzling Royal Artillery Barracks venue in Woolwich could have been easily lost in the national fervour. But live TV coverage brought the action into households across the nation and clay shooting had the perfect showcase. For a fleeting moment in a golden summer, the wider public had an insight into the drama and tension that clay shooting can provide.

BIG, BEAUTIFUL, SCARY, AND EXCITING

Peter was following in the footsteps of Richard Faulds MBE, who won

Double Trap gold in Sydney 2000 but, unlike Richard who has competed in five different Olympic Games, this was his only visit to the biggest stage. He stepped away from competitive shooting in 2014 (although he is now back and is still only 33), leaving him with a 100% success rate on his visits to the greatest show on earth.

When I asked Peter about 2012 he told me some fascinating things about the whole experience: "It's difficult to put into words actually. You just don't know beforehand

what it's going to be like, because it's so big, beautiful, scary, and exciting. I remember walking into the food hall for the first time and it was like Terminal 5 at Heathrow. It's recognised that teams lose medals in the food hall – and I don't mean by mislaying them in the cutlery tray! We were given a half-day lecture by the British Olympic Association (BOA) about the dangers of over-eating because everything is free. It's the biggest McDonalds concession you have ever seen and all you have to do is wave your accreditation and you can sit there and eat chicken nuggets all day. I didn't really understand what the BOA meant until I walked into that place and then I understood immediately.

"I was in the Olympic Village for at least ten days before my competition started so I had plenty of time to soak up the unique atmosphere. When you arrive you are blown away by the atmosphere, with athletes at the top of their game from all over the world. People say 'village' as if it's like the little place in Dorset where I grew up, but it's actually like a small city with big steel fences all around it. And for us at London 2012 it was even more amazing because it was home, and I was lucky to have peaked for this incredible event."

THE WINNING MENTALITY

Having had time to reflect I wanted to know what it was that Peter thought gave him the edge in that golden summer? "Richard Faulds is quite possibly the most naturally gifted shooter to have graced this planet, with honourable mentions to Kimberly Rhode and George Digweed, and of course this took him to gold at Sydney 2000.

"But I am not as naturally gifted and my gold medal is purely the product of hard work, blood, sweat, and tears. My gift is that I am able to turn my brain off and drive myself until I bleed and bleed some more. And I think this is a very important message – there is more than one route to success. Just because you may not be the most gifted child in the class, on the field or in the music room, it does not mean you cannot succeed on your chosen path. Work ethic will get you there."

LIFE-CHANGING GOLD

Olympic gold is one of the most globally recognised signs of success any human can add to their CV, but what impact

does it have on the winner? "It changes your life. Everything you do to get there is a stepping-stone towards the ultimate goal. There is no doubt that winning Olympic gold changes everything and trumps everything. I didn't even realise how it would change my life."

He can now reflect on how things changed immediately for him: "At that time I was paid by British Shooting and I had my expenses covered, which made it possible for me to train properly. But while I was at the Olympics Ian Coley set up a personal appearance for me with a hedge fund a week or two afterwards. And ultimately I was paid the same for half a day as I was paid for a whole year at the Olympics. I was flown by helicopter to make an appearance in North Yorkshire and they invited me to stay on and shoot grouse with them afterwards. Clearly that would never have happened if I hadn't won. That taught me what it was worth. I had never really thought about that before but it sets you up financially for life."

THRUST INTO THE LIMELIGHT

Not everybody thrives on the instant fame a gold medal can bring: "I didn't really like the attention. I never craved it but I embraced it initially. Then after about a month or two I began to resent it. It wasn't for me. I didn't enjoy being in the limelight so much and I was happy to take a backward step. But that is what is so wonderful about the Olympics – you get a taste of fame and media attention. Some people love it and go on to make it work to their advantage, and others think no that's not for me."

Having put everything he had into London Peter realised fairly swiftly afterwards that the motivation wasn't there. "I retired from competitive shooting in 2014, because even though I was still winning I just knew I wouldn't be able to carry on. I was just not

giving it 100%. I spoke to the British Performance Director on the way back to the airport after winning an event in the UAE and said I needed a break. I didn't want to keep doing it any more."

BACK ON THE OLYMPIC TRAIL

So where does Peter find himself now? "I'm back now shooting Olympic Trap and I am aiming to compete in Paris 2024. "We also have a small family farm in Dorset which I run with my dad, and in the last few years I have spent more and more time electronically trading equities in a boutique hedge fund, for want of a better description. We have two children; the oldest is two and a half and the other has just turned one. They are amazing and they give you a new perspective and I consider myself very fortunate."

Finally I had to ask Peter what was it like to stand on that podium with the gold medal around his neck, the Union flag flying, and the National Anthem playing: "Amazing. I'm a patriot so I was very proud. To have won gold and see the flag being flown at home was just incredible and the cheering, and support from everybody just made it even better. I'm pretty sure I shed a tear. It raises the hairs on the back of my neck thinking about it, and I suppose that is why we compete."

TWO'S COMPANY

We spoke to General Manager of the National Clay Shooting Centre and Bisley Shooting Ground **Richie Vallance**, about the grounds under management of the **National Rifle Association** at Bisley Camp.



Q Can you give us some background information on the ownership of these two clubs, and how they came to be owned by the NRA?

A: Bisley Camp nestles in the heart of ancient Surrey heathland, just minutes from Brookwood Train Station and a short drive from both the A3 and M3. It has been the home of the National Rifle Association (NRA) and numerous other rifle and clay shooting clubs for over 128 years.

Its rich and intriguing history has evolved over time, with Queen Victoria opening the first annual rifle meeting at Wimbledon back in 1860. She fired the inaugural shot at the first rifle meeting on 2 July that year and the event is still very much alive in the form of the annual prize meeting (the Imperial) which

includes the Queen's Prize.

Bisley Camp itself is a historic location with many fine examples of colonial style architecture and traditional lodge buildings, taking visitors back to a long-gone era. The estate has over 3,000 acres with lots of natural woodland, which is home to many protected species on a site of special scientific interest.

Both the National Clay Shooting Centre (NCSC) and Bisley Shooting Ground are now run by the National Shooting Centre (NSC) which is a subsidiary of the National Rifle Association. NCSC has always come under the NRA umbrella, however Bisley Shooting Ground was previously run by a private company until 6 August 2020.

The agreement came out of mediation, resulting

in the NSC taking over the business of Council Club and Cottesloe Heath shooting ground.

Q How do the grounds work together at Bisley Camp?

A: Now that Bisley Shooting Ground has entered the fold, the two clay grounds are fundamentally linked, enjoying economies of scale and sharing best practice across all shooting disciplines. The result is a joint facility that caters for all of the clay-shooting disciplines and provides fantastic facilities and levels of coaching.

The two grounds work closely together, utilising the same instructors and sharing facilities, but also tailor their instruction to the specific requirements of the client, because we have

every discipline available to us. Being able to match the client with the right discipline and the most appropriate instructor is a real benefit. Once we come out of what we hope is the last lockdown, we will begin to see the other benefits, such as sharing marketing ideas and mutual support for large events.

Q What disciplines/facilities does the National Clay Shooting Centre have to offer?

A: NCSC was built for the Commonwealth Games in 2002 and is a world-class shooting complex. The instantly recognisable skyline of white canopies cover a line of superb shooting layouts, equipped with over 90 clay release machines catering for shooters of all abilities. They include computer controlled scoring, trap sequencing, acoustic release, and two training layouts. Regular

competitions such as CPSA Registered shoots, BICTSF Selection shoots, and NCSC club competitions are held throughout the year. Practice is also available on the

layouts subject to availability and shooting lessons can be booked for all disciplines.

Over the last year we have made a number of significant improvements to modernise the NCSC. The reception area was given a substantial face lift, opening it up

to a more inviting environment where our staff can engage appropriately with our customers. We also created a lounge area where our customers can relax in comfort. The Café has been elevated to offer quality food at a sensible cost. The overall finished article has transformed the clubhouse into a welcoming and professional sports setting

where clients can relax whilst waiting for a lesson, or passers-by can enjoy our breath-taking views and catch up on a bit of work.

Out on the ranges, years of fallen clay debris, accompanied by continuous sweeping had left the layouts quite bleak, perhaps more akin to a lunar landscape. We have now completely replanted the grass and the place is looking fantastic.

Q What disciplines/facilities does Bisley Shooting Ground have to offer?

A: Bisley Shooting Ground consists of Cottesloe Heath (the ground itself) and a Victorian Clubhouse 'The Council Club'. The Council Club has been modernised and upgraded many times over the years, whilst retaining its heritage and preserving of all its historic features, including a Victorian club room where guests can enjoy complimentary refreshments before and after shooting. At the back of the clubhouse is a luxury dining room which is used to host corporate events and other functions.

Cottesloe Heath Ground won the 2020 Shooting Awards for the best Clay Shooting Ground in the country. The ground has over 80 electronic traps, features over 30 stands and is home to our famous grouse butts, high tower, and crane. The tower and crane provide the ultimate challenge and Simulated Game facility for any game or clay shooter. The crane is fully equipped with automatic traps, able to deliver multiple target presentations through 360 degrees and up to 250 feet. We normally run a 100-target Sporting competition every month and occasionally a Registered Shoot.

Our core business is shooting lessons, clay shooting practice, Ladies days, young shots days, game shooting instruction,

simulated game days, gun fitting services, and corporate events. We also sell gift vouchers in classy presentation boxes. We only employ the top instructors available and the shoot manager is the legendary John Heagren. We have approximately 30 freelance instructors who are available for individual lessons or large corporate events.

Q What are the key differences between the National Clay Shooting Centre and Bisley Shooting Ground?

A: The main differences are the type of shooting available and the overall experience required by our customers. The feel of NCSC is much more of a professional sports setting for athletes and shooters who strive for technical excellence in their chosen discipline with a relaxed club house environment, whereas Bisley shooting ground has a very different feel – more comparable to a shooting lodge on the edge of a beautiful country setting. High levels of instruction are guaranteed with an emphasis on quality and comfort.

Q How has each ground developed over the years?

A: NCSC remained unchanged until about 18 months ago. Aside from the reception and café updates, we have also



invested in the shooting facilities on the ground. For years NCSC has only used black clays for the skeet disciplines as the targets ended up falling in front of the DTL range and orange targets distracted the shooter, but now we have introduced nets so that we can use orange targets for Olympic Skeet and remove the debris. Consequently we now have a world-class Olympic Skeet layout, which is attracting much interest from the elite shooting community, particularly British Shooting.

Coin tokens are no longer used as all of the main layouts have now moved onto a brand new chip card system. Customer's cards are now uploaded with virtual tokens for each discipline which they can use at their leisure. This has improved efficiency giving shooters greater flexibility and target reliability.

Our second training range is now complete which has expanded the capacity of the shooting lesson diary.

Bisley Shooting Ground has developed a lot in the last six months after taking over the business. We demolished and rebuilt the medium pheasant tower as the old tower

was condemned as unsafe. The new tower is 15m high with a 5m square platform on the top. We now operate five automatic ball traps from the top, feeding high oscillating targets to a number of key shooting stands. The tower has been a real hit with both the game and clay community.

We have also installed a new high-target crane which is being used to throw a series of 'high pheasant' targets, which was missing from the previous shooting portfolio.

One of the big changes we have made is to our membership offer, making sure our clients get value for money. Our members can now enjoy 15% off all shooting, free gun storage for one gun per member, with access seven days a week, monthly club shoot competitions with prizes awarded, free lesson for new and renewing members, one free entry to a monthly club shoot of your choice, two guest offering members discount for a day, members

discount for the whole shooting party on group shoots of seven or more people, complimentary tea and coffee in the Clubroom, complimentary membership of the NCSC, and

caddied rounds for members with no caddy fees.

The result is a joint facility that caters for all the clay-shooting disciplines.

Q Where do you see each venue in 5-10 years?

A: I see the two grounds working closer together at Bisley – we are recruiting the best instructors and raising our game at every opportunity. We are about to launch a new six lesson shooting program called the Bisley Approach which will tailor our lessons to our client's specific needs. I am confident the corporate side of the business will recover well after Coronavirus and when it does we will create more opportunities

to better the experience for our clients. One thing we will not do is sit on our hands.

Q Is there anything you would like to include?

A: I mentioned earlier that we will be rolling out the Bisley Approach to our clients for beginner clay shooting lessons. This is a methodology derived from the wealth of training and experience across both Bisley Shooting Ground and the NCSC. Its purpose is to capture best practice taken from all shooting disciplines to arrive at a consistent approach to shooting instruction. The progressive six-lesson program will introduce a novice to the sport of shotgun shooting and each lesson is designed to build on previous lessons, arriving at a clear objective at the end. On completion of the package clients will have been trained in a range of skills preparing them for their chosen discipline. 🍀

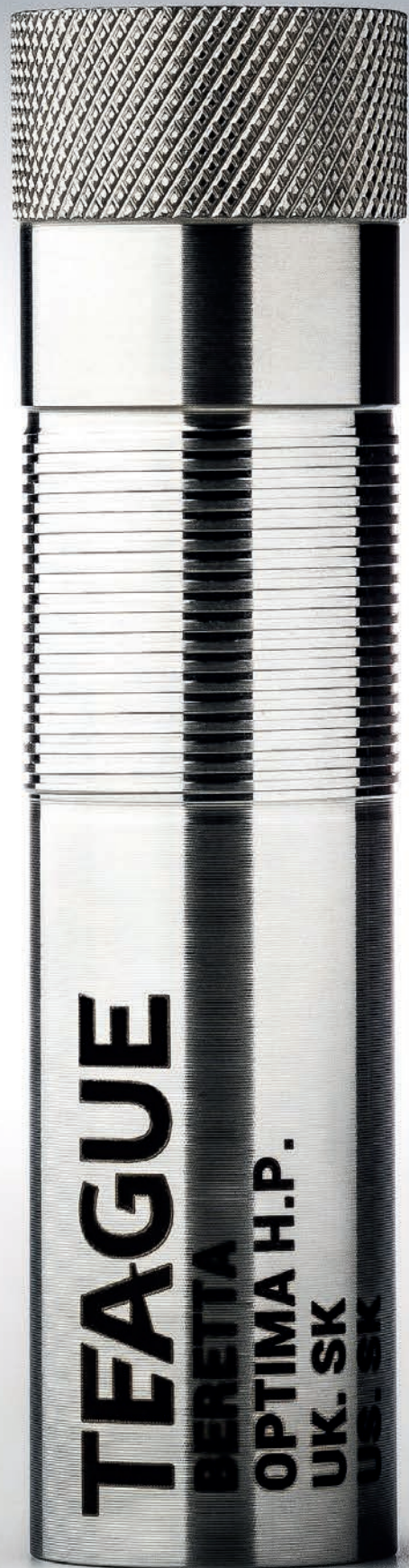

YOUNG SHOTS

By Isabel Cartlidge.



I started to shoot at our local Sunday shoots with my Dad and Uncle Dave where I had the job of marking their scores, but it wasn't until we visited Premier Guns at Doveridge that we heard about Young Guns. It is a fantastic way to introduce children to shooting, and that is how I got into it. We got all the information and Dad booked me on for the following Saturday. I was handed a .410 and a box of 25 cartridges before heading off to the stands. Steve Owen was the first person to help me and give me lots of encouragement, and still does to this day.

After a few months of shooting at Young Guns, we purchased my first gun from Premier Guns, a Yildiz 28 gauge. Once I had my own, I was able to participate in the local Sunday Sporting Shoots. I did this for almost a year and in 2018 purchased a new Browning 525 20 gauge and started having some Sporting tuition at Mickley Hall.

THE NEXT STEP: GETTING COACHING

Although I enjoyed Sporting, I found that I really enjoyed shooting English Skeet, so in the summer of 2018 I started to be

coached by David Beardsmore as I wanted to reach my full potential.

Things progressed quite slowly as David is very particular on gun fit/mount, eye dominance, and most importantly technique. Some lessons I didn't move from peg 1, but none-the-less I was hooked. By the end of 2018 I had come a long way and with the help of Premier Guns and their expert advice – so we purchased a Beretta 690 black 12 gauge.

My lessons carried on throughout 2019, preparing for the start of 2020, and a possibility of England selection. On 21 January 2020 I shot my first Registered English Skeet competition at Doveridge. I wasn't overly pleased with my score, but I was happy that I'd held my nerve and completed the competition at the age of 13.

Over the course of the next few weeks I shot six more registered shoots at Doveridge, Nottingham, The Priory, and East Yorkshire before COVID-19.

Based on my scores, I managed to qualify for England Selection Shoots.

In March 2020 lockdown commenced and I didn't shoot for almost three months! I couldn't wait to get back on the shooting range with David. I had my first lesson post lockdown, and it was like I'd not been away, all those months when I started with David and him installing the techniques certainly paid off.

All of this is possible because of the support I get

HARD WORK PAYS OFF!

I shot the Welsh Open at Fauxdegla and finished third in Colts, the British Open Skeet at Bisley and then onto the West Midlands Area ESK Championship, where I shot 89/100 to win the Ladies and second in Juniors. My year ended when I was approached by Cheshire CPSA to shoot the National Inter-Counties ESK. I shot in the Junior team event with Lucy Earl and came second. Individually I shot 97/100, finishing joint first Ladies High Gun and endured my first ever shoot-off. I shot 24/25 and my opponent shot 22/25, therefore I was placed first Ladies High Gun, and first in Colts.

All of this is possible because of the support I get, not only from my Mum and Dad, but from my sponsors Premier Guns, Mercury Custom Plugs, Eley Hawk, GMK Ltd, Timberwolf, Spectrum Plant, and I can't thank my amazing coach David Beardsmore enough – he has a lot to put up with but always picks up the phone when I need to talk. I would encourage any young girl or boy wanting to give it a go, to go and do it.

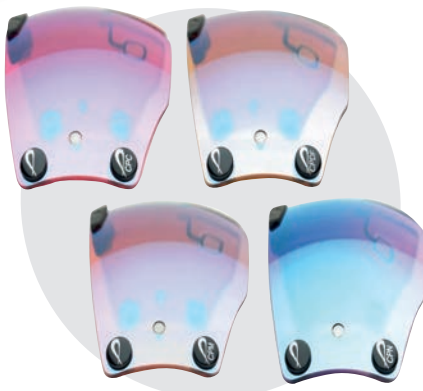

OBITUARIES

MICHAEL BRUNTON BEM

Michael Brunton BEM died of a stroke on 3 March at 73 years of age. Mike was well known in the clay-shooting community – particularly as the former owner of *Clay Shooting* magazine and founder of the Clay Shooting Classic.

After completing a short service commission in the Army, Mike joined his wife's family publishing business. He was a keen clay shooter, and so purchased *Clay Shooting* magazine in 1994 and set about raising the game. He had a vision and through his enthusiasm, drive, and energy, launched the first Classic on the Apsley Estate in 1998. The competition toured the country many times on a new greenfield site – he didn't believe in a 'home advantage' and wanted the shooters to compete on lots of different targets and terrains.

Mike demanded the best and when inspecting the courses would only accept targets 'worthy of the Classic.' He produced prizes to match including cash and brand name products – more than anyone had ever seen before.

The Classic was a family affair and he ran it along with his wife Fiona and his boys Dan, Ben, and their wives Gemma and Beth. The pinnacle came in 2005

with The Triple Classic. Mike organised and co-ordinated championships in the USA, Russia, and at Highclere Castle.

Mike sponsored schools, universities, colleges, the armed forces, emergency services, disabled competitions, and championships. He also sponsored charity events and brought in celebrities, such as Bernard Cribbins and Elaine Paige, and got our Sporting greats like George Digweed and Richard Faulds to act as squad hosts.

Every competition, and more, was reported in the magazine under the Editor of Richard Rawlinson, Deputy Editor and Business Manager Keith Fisher, and Advertising Manager Stuart Crane. For Mike, black and white photos on thin paper and stapled pages were not good enough – glossy print, high quality paper and perfect-bound magazines became the benchmark.

Mike didn't do things by half and what he did do was done with military precision, panache, and always of the highest standard. He had tremendous energy, a prodigious memory, exceptional power of concentration, and he paid meticulous attention to detail. Above all he enjoyed it and revelled in the challenge. His greatest

reward was when someone would say – 'thanks Mike, I enjoyed that'.

But the biggest accolade he could ever wish for was when his youngest son, Ben, won the World FITASC in 1999. All the years of carrying the cartridge bag and driving up and down the country as Ben's chauffeur paid off.

He will be remembered for setting the standard still being aspired to today. And over a cup of tea and bacon butty some 15 years on, shooters still reminisce on The Classics – not a bad legacy! Thanks Mike.

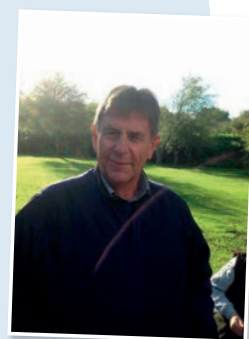

SHOOTING SUPPLIES

FEELS LIKE YESTERDAY!

We spoke to **Huw Stephens**, Manager of Barbury Shooting School, about the reopening of grounds after lockdown and hosting the English Open English Sporting.

Q How did you first become involved in clay shooting and what is your preferred discipline?

A: I come from a farming background, so got into clay shooting on the side of rough shooting. I would say this is probably the more traditional way of getting into the sport, however most of our clients now get involved through corporate events, have-a-go days, stag do's, etc. I shoot Sporting, FITASC, and Compak, and have been lucky enough to shoot for both Wales and Great Britain.

Q How did you come to run Barbury Shooting School?

A: Barbury was a private shooting tuition facility, more focused on game shooting before I took over the business 14 years ago. I had a couple of lessons here as a teenager and bought the lease 15-years ago, which feels like yesterday! We have just signed another 15-year lease, which has led to further investment at the grounds.

Q What changes have been implemented to adhere to the 'new normal' when shooting has been able to go ahead this past year?

A: The key in my opinion has been to be flexible. We have had to get used to, and adjust to, a new set of rules and be ready to

adapt quickly. The hardest week for us was when we got put into Tier 4, with the rest of Wiltshire remaining in Tier 3! A big part of the challenge has been making shooting accessible and keeping everyone safe, as when we are open there has been quite high demand.

Q How have you been preparing for the English Open Sporting, which Barbury will be holding from 19-23 May?

A: The last year has seen our largest investment in the ground yet, we have built a new clubhouse, which now incorporates a gun shop, café etc. We have also invested in the grounds, opening new stands

meaning we will have plenty of options when designing the course.

Q How do you feel about hosting the first major championship this year, especially coming back after the third lockdown?

A: We always put a lot of pressure on ourselves in general and with major shoots to keep our standards high, so most of the pressure will be coming from within the team. We are excited and grateful to have the opportunity to host the first Championship of the year, and hopefully we can put on a great event that will give the sport a great boost after a tough 12 months.
