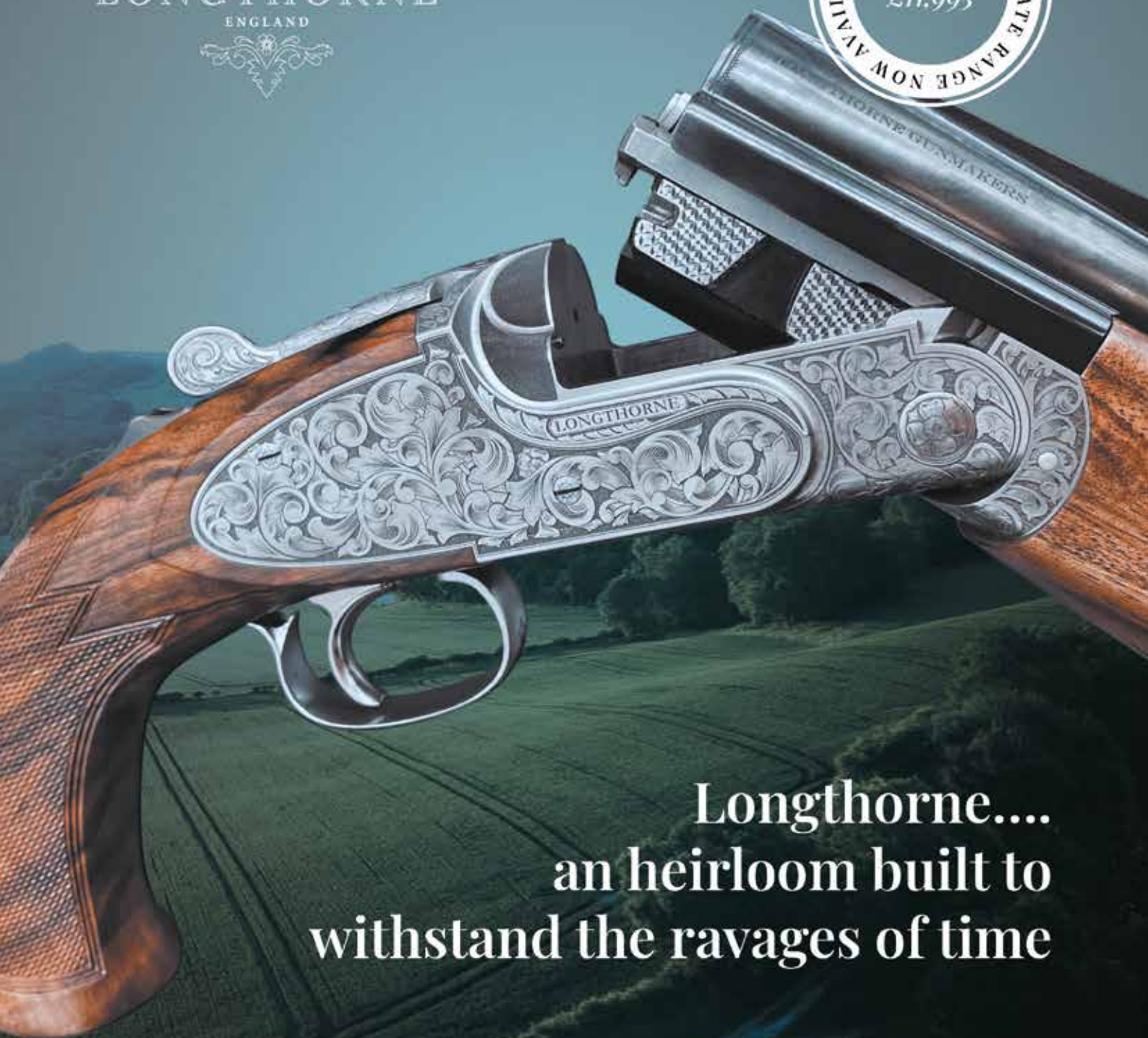

SAVE THE DATE: WORLD GUNMAKERS' EVENING

The World Gunmakers' Evening is set to take place on Wednesday 9 November 2022 in a new, larger venue – The Armoury House in the heart of the City of London.

Originally founded in 2015, the repeatedly sold-out indoor tabletop event brings together the very best gunmakers and shooting brands from around the globe together with 500 guests for an evening of canapés and Champagne. The Armoury House is a listed 18th century manor house that's home to The Honourable Artillery Company. The World Gunmakers' Evening will be held in The Prince Consort Rooms, an impressive vaulted-ceiling former drill hall.

Event director James Gower commented: "This hugely popular event always sells out in record time so we have doubled capacity this year so that more guests can attend. Our new venue certainly strikes the right note and will be a real draw. This year's event will showcase even more gunmakers than ever from all four corners of the globe."

AMBER HILL WINS GOLD AFTER 'GOLDEN SHOT' IN FINAL

A Amber, who was competing in her first international event of the season following the disappointment of missing out on Tokyo 2020 due to COVID last year, won gold on her return at the ISSF World Cup in Cyprus.

In Cyprus, Skeet shooter Amber finished qualification in third place with a score of 116ex125 in some very tough weather conditions, before facing USA's Austen Jewell Smith and Caitlin Connor, as well as Czech Republic's

Barbora Sumova in the semi-final.

Amber's score of 26 ensured she proceeded through to the final alongside Smith.

In the final, Hill and Smith were joined by Slovakia's Danka Bartekova and Italy's Chiara Cainero, who came top of the other semi-final.

Amber held her nerve

right the way through the final as the wind blew strong across the layout. Her final score of 34ex40 meant she comfortably finished as Golden Shot and at the top of the podium.

The nearest to her was silver medalist Bartekova, who finished with a score of 28. Smith completed the podium in third place.

After finishing top of the podium, 24-year-old Amber said: "I'm really pleased that I've come away with a gold medal at my first competition of the year – it was really unexpected."

"I have been training hard, but to actually see the hard work pay off, especially after everything that didn't happen last year with the Olympics, I'm just really pleased."

"The feeling of coming home with a medal for my country never gets old, and I'd like to thank UK Sport and the National Lottery as well as all my sponsors for supporting my journey."

Elsewhere in Olympic Skeet, Jess Burgess was competing in her first international and showed real promise as she finished in 11th place in qualification having missed out on a spot in the semi-final after a shoot-off for eighth place.

LETTER OF THE MONTH



A letter from Dave Tilden, an old Senior Citizen Yank who spent four great years shooting clays in England from 1969-1973. This year I am celebrating my 50th anniversary of winning the British Open Skeet Championships in 1972.

These were great years of Skeet shooting in England. The American bases all had active shooting programmes – Croughton, Alconbury,

Lakenheath, and Bentwaters were the most popular and British shooters were always welcomed on the bases for Skeet and DTL. Many times the locals outnumbered the Yanks as shooting was cheaper on the base – a round of clays and a box of Winchester Skeet 100s was not much more than a pound.

I spent four years at RAF Upper Heyford, the ranges were at RAF Croughton which were just south of Brackley.

We had two Skeet and two DTL ranges. It was a very active place at the weekend with the parking lots full of locals. The club had lots of NSSA Skeet shoots and CPSA DTL shoots, the Brits loved the NSSA Skeet shoots as it was a chance to shoot a variety of small-bore guns. Browning, Miroku, Winchester, and Remington shotguns were all available in 4.10, 28, and 20 gauge. As expected there was always a lot of bartering of goods between the Brits and the Yanks. Reloading components were always popular as we had access to a great variety of products. I didn't smoke but I always traded my six cartons a month for some rough shooting down near Whitney.

There were many notables from that era who came to the club. Phil Beasley was a regular on weekends and Ian Coley, a young shooter from the Cotswolds. Ray Ward came for the DTL shoots and Chris Craddock from Bath. Someone must remember Fred Melville, the mad dentist from Northampton. For years they had a Skeet shoot in his honour at Northampton Gun Club. The best at English Skeet was David Seabrook. He was always a threat to take top gun in the 12 bore event and would always show up at the Croughton shoots. I would really have to be on my best to have any chance of beating him! Last but certainly

not least is Mike Brazzell up at Lakenheath – a popular American shooter up in that area, Mike went on to a great Skeet career and played an important role in creating the NSSA Skeet museum in San Antonio, Texas.

Back then the British Open Skeet was held at the Bedford Gun Club. The shoot ran over three days and was run by Peter Page, the head of the CPSA, shooting 100 targets was a daily affair. Everyone shot one round and then started over until all shooters had shot the four rounds. Eley was the sponsor and entry came with ammo, everyone had to shoot Eley SuperSkeet 32gm. They were brutal on both ends, and after a couple of near misses I was lucky to win in 1972, which at the time won me a prize of £50.

As for myself, I spent a career working and shooting for Ruger Firearms in America, making countless trips back to England to compete and visit friends. My last serious shoot was the year 2000 shoot at Southern Counties. Now, at 75 years old, I have retired from competition and focus more on game shooting in Scotland. Our game group are all ex-clay shooters so we have shot at most of the Scottish clubs.

ENGLISH OPEN OLYMPIC TRAP

A superb weekend of competition saw Junior **Tom Betts** take the honours, as **Anita North** reports.

The Olympic Trap English Open was held at Nuthampstead Shooting Ground on 9-10 April. Blustery weather promised for interesting conditions over the weekend for the 84 competitors to test their mettle over 200 targets. Day one saw a biting northerly wind combined with a mixture of sunny spells and rolling clouds add to the challenge that is Olympic Trap. But day two saw kinder conditions provide excellent conditions for some good shooting.

At the end of day one, with 100 targets shot, eight competitors were on a score of 90 or above. Top of the

scoreboard was Junior shooter Tom Betts who put in a superb 98. Closely following Tom were Nathan Hales, David Kirk and Steve Scott on 95, 94 and 93 respectively. Top woman was Lucy Hall with a 90, with Maddie Purser on 89 and Charlotte Holland on 88. In Juniors Tom led from Will Gilbert on 90 and Lucas Hyde on 87.

On day two 18 competitors finished on a score of 90 or above, with the highest score on the day being a superb 98 from Lucy Hall.

AND THE WINNERS WERE

Lucy's overall score of 188 meant that she retained the Ladies title for another year. Charlotte put in a solid 93 to take silver. Maddie took bronze after a shoot off against Ellie Seward. Mike Wensley took the Veterans title on a score of 172 with Michael Cooper taking silver and Richard Fox bronze.

The Colts title went to Mathew Paley with a total score of 176. Finley Bowles took silver and Will Taylor bronze. In Juniors a strong weekend of shooting saw Tom Betts taking gold on 191, Lucy Hall silver and Lucas Hyde bronze. Class wins went to Finley Bowles, Holly Lumsden, Charlotte Holland and David Kirk.

This leaves us with our overall medallists and High Gun. David Kirk and Steve Scott put in excellent scores of 96 on Day 2 to take silver and bronze on scores of 190 and 189 respectively. But the star of the weekend was Tom Betts whose final score of 191 not only gave him the Junior win, but also won him the High Gun Trophy. It was a truly superb performance from this young, yet experienced trap shooter.

Congratulations to all the prize winners and thanks to CPSA CEO Iain Parker and National Director Nicola Heron for running the presentations ceremony. There were some great performances at an early stage of the competition season, which bodes well for the 2022 competition season. 🍌

ENGLISH OPEN COMPAK

A testing but fair course ensured all competitors had to work hard for their rewards, as **Richard Faulks** reports.

The English Open Compak Sporting was staged at John Bidwell's famous High Lodge shooting ground on the 9th April in Suffolk, which is now in its 30th year on the current site. The weather was very kind on the day, with a light breeze and generally sunny weather. This followed a week blighted by strong winds, which had given course designers Andy Coppen and Oliver Wilde a challenge with constant adjustments needed to the targets. In the end though, all four stands were well received by the shooters. And it was the

combinations of the sim-pairs that were technically challenging and allowed the cream to rise to the top.

Phil Moody was the leader in the clubhouse when the first scores were posted just before lunch, with a very creditable 97. It

was the score to beat for the next hour or two until both Nathan Skinner and Phil Gray matched him. It looked increasingly likely the three of them might face a shoot-off for first place, but there were still some strong contenders in the field. Chris Childerhouse,

recently back from a month shooting in competitions in the USA, was just about to start his round and Nick Moss was half way around the course.

Past ladies champion Hannah Gibson had posted a score of 94 by mid-

afternoon to put herself in pole position from Amy Easman's 91, but again Georgia Moule, who is being mentored by John Bidwell was still shooting.

WINNING BY A WHISKER

As it turned out there was to be an outright winner though. Alex Lytwynchuk, a head gamekeeper who only took up clay shooting a couple of years ago, went one better with a 98 which proved to be the winning score for High Gun. The trio on 97 would have a shoot-off for second and third place as Chris Childerhouse's and Nick Moss's challenge fell away. But Chris was very complementary about the targets and thought Alex's 98 was about the right score to win the day: "It wasn't a fill-in Compac, there were a few to miss there and a good variety of targets," he told me. In the end Hannah's 94 proved to be unbeatable to take the ladies title with Georgia matching Amy's score of 91.

The shoot off for second and third place was a close run contest which went to a sudden death between Phil and Nathan after the first round of 25 clays. Phil finally secured second place after Nathan dropped a clay on the fourth station and Phil held his nerve and hit the two targets of the sim-pair.

CHALLENGING BUT FAIR

Some of stand four's sim-pairs and a sim-pair on stand three were causing the biggest problems for the shooters. On stand three, the long crossing rabbit, which was shot from the raised platform and a going away orange target proved to be possibly the toughest and most technical pair on the whole course. The rabbit crossing from left to right at around 30 yards had to be dealt with quickly if there was to be any chance of hitting the going away target that was launched from below the platform from the right, and heading to the left. On stand four, any of the sim-pairs involving the DTL style pink clay were proving technically challenging too, and again, the first target had to be attacked to allow for the maximum amount of time for the second target to be shot. None of the targets were in any way extreme taken on their own, but clever course setting

and combinations from Andy and Oliver ensured it was a well thought out and fair but challenging layout.

There has been a great deal of investment in High Lodge over the years and their computerised Promatic scoring system is a real plus along with the covered stands which help protect shooters from the weather. John Bidwell explained he had invested in Compak layouts because it is a discipline he enjoyed shooting. It's not as difficult as FITASC in terms of the targets, but you need good concentration and technique: "It's all about speed and angle in this game" he told me.

Meanwhile when I asked overall High Gun Alex Lytwynchuk how it had gone he said: "Very well, very well, I'm really pleased! There was something for everybody and there were certainly a couple of targets you could drop, but it was fair for all abilities of shooting and there was a good variety of targets."

INTERNATIONAL

Sarah Daly reports on events around the world.



WORLD CUP, NICOSIA, CYPRUS

Amber Hill won GBR's first World Cup (WC) medal of the season with a Golden Hit in the Skeet Women.

Finishing the qualification in third place behind USA shooters Caitlin Connor and Dania Vizzi, Amber went on to the semi-finals in windy conditions. Amber did not have it all her own way in the first ten targets in the semi-final, but by the 30 target mark she had done enough to go into the Medal Match ranked one. In the Medal Match she really laid down the marker, rounding it off with a Golden Hit on the last stand, beating her nearest rival, Danka Bartekova (SVK). As always, the finals are worth watching on YouTube.

Worth a mention is the performance of Jess Burgess, making her debut on the international stage. Jess was a successful member of her school's shooting team in Sporting and is now showing real promise on the Skeet scene. Jess shot

enough to be involved in the shoot-off for the semi-finals, and although she was not successful in this instance it was a great result, finishing 11th overall. Jess commented: “The experience gave the saying ‘every target counts’ a whole new meaning!”

As often happens in Cyprus at this time of year, there was a gambit of weather conditions with snow, hail, bit of rain, cold, sun... But Jess had been training in the UK previously, and our weather had certainly given her the wind and rain, to the extent that one day at Dartford the wind was so strong it blew over a portalo – “it’s important to train in all weathers but also to know when to call it a day!”

Scores start from zero in the Semi-Finals and the Finals.

Qualification

125 targets followed by shoot-offs for any tied scores to decide the rankings. The top eight shooters qualifying for the semi-finals.

Semi-Finals

The top eight competitors are split into:

Semi-final one, ranked competitors 1, 3, 5, 7

Semi-final two, ranked competitors 2, 4, 6, 8

Skeet 30 targets/Trap 25 targets. The lowest score ruled out at the 20 Skeet target/15 target Trap mark.

The top two competitors from each semi-final qualify for the Medal Match.

Medal Match

Skeet 40 targets/Trap 35 targets.

The fourth competitor ruled out at the 20 target Skeet/15 target Trap mark.

The third (bronze medal) decided at the 30 target Skeet/25 target Trap mark.

Golden Hit

If, at any stage in the Medal Match, before the total number of targets of the match are completed, the winner can be clearly established mathematically from the total number of targets shot by the last two competitors then the match will be stopped and ‘Golden Hit’ will be declared.

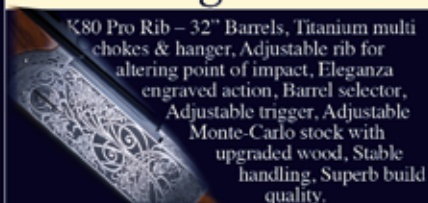

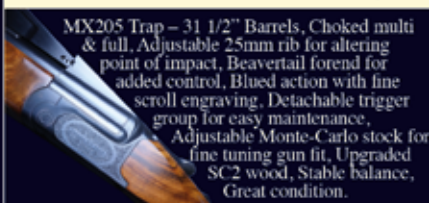

STRAIGHT SHOOTING SECRETS

Having nearly completed a double century of 100-straights, **Gary Cooke** knows a thing or two about focus, and he tells **Martin Puddifer** how he does it.

One hundred and ninety four is a special figure for England Skeet International Gary Cooke, it being the number of times he's achieved 100-straight in Registered competitions.

The 54-year-old self-employed motor mechanic, who is originally from Bawtry near Doncaster, got his first taste of pulling the trigger alongside his father in his early teens when the pair would go rough shooting together. After a few seasons on a syndicated game shoot Gary segwayed into motocross in his early 20s, but his ambitions to take things further were curtailed by an energy sapping illness.

Gary eventually found an outlet for his competitive spirit at a gun club in Ancholme Valley, near Kirton Lindsey in Lincolnshire. He tried numerous disciplines at the club, then owned by David and Leslie Noar, eventually settling on Skeet. He enjoyed it so much that what started as a hobby soon became an all consuming passion. Gary worked on the lorries at his father's haulage firm at the time his clay shooting began to blossom, and found that the early starts and early finishes meant that during the summer there were plenty of opportunities to practise.

BORDERING ON OBSESSION

"My illness was such that I couldn't compete at the high end of motocross, but I found clay shooting was ok," he explained. "During the summer I used to practise on a Wednesday, Saturday, and Sunday, and more often if I had time and could afford it. Shooting was all I did. It was a passion that bordered on an obsession."

While naturally competitive and comfortable at county competitions, it took a while for Gary to become convinced he could hold his own in the larger events, such as the British Open, which he's since won twice. That must have puzzled those against whom he was competing, given that he was returning plenty of scores in the high 90s, achieving his first 100-straight at Nottingham District Gun Club in 1997.

"I'd shot a few 99s in competition and had always harboured ambitions of shooting a ton," explains Gary, adding that he often had people in his ear afterwards saying that it was only a matter of time until things fell into place. "The 100 in Nottinghamshire was a really

good 100 because I was 'on it'. I was absolutely over the moon. It was a special moment."

One might expect the 100-straight to start coming thick and fast, but that wasn't the case. While he shot plenty in practice rounds, Gary would have to wait another two years before he saw those three magic numbers next to his name again.

"It puts expectation in your mind," he says. "You do it once and you expect to do it as soon as you go out again. But 100-strights don't just happen, you've got to work at them. Every target is a single target, even when they come in pairs. I've seen countless people miss because they're thinking about the second target before they've shot the first one. It's a fatal mistake. You have to try and forget the misses too, so that your round doesn't fall apart."

IT'S ALL ABOUT CONCENTRATION

While Gary jokes that luck was what 100-strights come down to, he is quite clear about what budding century makers need. "Practice aside, it comes down to two things – good technique and concentration," he explains. "Not appreciating concentration has cost me in the past. Even though I took my shooting seriously, I used to have a laugh and a joke with people between stands all the time. I even did it when I was preparing to shoot and when I missed a clay I would say to myself "well, it's your own fault". It used to annoy me.

"I am a social person and enjoy the social side of Skeet shooting, but not everybody does. Most of the best shooters keep themselves to themselves. Nowadays, if it's a major competition I will stand back from everyone else and not engage in conversation or watch others shooting. I just empty my mind."

As a keen student of sports psychology, I wondered if there were any 99s which still haunt Gary, and what mindset he has to plug into to make sure that his round finishes as high as possible. "Most of the near misses have come at the Open Championships I've entered! Just a little more concentration and effort and I'd have done it. I can tell afterwards I've let myself down, and you only have to lose it for a split second. The art is to concentrate on what you're doing at the time, not what's to come. You've got to trust your eyes and not predict what the clay is going to do. Look for the target and don't spend too long waiting before you call. I can't wait, I have to call, otherwise I start overthinking.

And what happens when Gary is breaking clays but not as clinically as he would like – does he feel any pressure? "I feel under pressure usually when I'm not concentrating and go into autopilot. If I just concentrate on the target I'll be alright. If I hit a clay but it's not in the way I want I will talk to myself, remind myself of what I need to do. The ones that don't break properly are warnings and you have to heed them."

While Gary suggests that keeping physically fit helped him in those early years, he admits he might have achieved more if he had been coached. If his memory serves him correctly, he has probably only had a handful of lessons and "could have saved a lot of time and wasted fewer cartridges" if he had not gone down the self-taught route.

You do it once and you expect to do it as soon as you go out again. But 100-strights don't just happen, you've got to work at them.



THE HIGHEST LEVEL

Gary won his first England cap in the mid 2000s just after winning the British Open Championship, and while he was part of an England team which once achieved six 100-strights, one after the other, in 2017, it was his 100 at the British Open in 2013 which means the most to him.

"It was at Southern Counties Shooting Ground," he recalls. "It was one of the best, most consistent 100s I've ever shot. In the shoot-off I was with Paul Dodd and Henry Arnold. I beat Paul for first place with more choke in my barrels than you need for Skeet. I was destroying the targets and after we'd finished, Paul came up to me and said "you demoralised me!" He was shooting well, too."

Gary has plenty more shooting to get through before he retires, aided and abetted by his partner Sarah, a fellow clay shooter, who is a great motivator as well as someone who can take his mind away from the "what-might-have-been" moments that come just as regularly as his 100-strights. He cites Peter Chester as a shooter who could eclipse his impressive tally but still has plenty of ambitions of his own, not least to win the English Open, which he has lost in the shoot-off on more than one occasion, most notably to his great friend Steve Leppington on a sunny day at Dartford. "It was a hard one to swallow and I totally expected to win," he admits. I can only imagine what it would feel like for Gary to win the event with a perfect score, and that would surely be the pinnacle of what has already been a stellar career. 🏆



HOW TO HIT

DOUBLES OR PAIRS: ENGLISH SKEET

CPSA Level 3 Senior
Coach **Simon Arbuckle**
shows us how
to hit the
doubles or pairs
in a round

Welcome to the third article of the sixth How to Hit series sponsored by Browning and focussing on the disciples of English and Olympic Skeet.

In this article, I'm going to show you how to hit the doubles or pairs in a round of English Skeet (ESK).

STATION ONE

Pairs shot High House first. On the pairs, the first of the targets is shot exactly the same way as when shooting the singles. I'm going to shoot it by the white post in the centre of the range. That will then give me the time to focus on the low house incoming target, lock on with the gun, pull ahead and shoot it using the CPSA method.

STATION TWO

Pairs shot High House first. Again, I'm going to shoot the first target by the white post in the centre of the range. Providing I get it by then, I should be able to focus on the crossing right to left low target, lock on and pull away using the CPSA method. If I shoot the high target later than the centre, that will mean the low target is now heading towards the high house side of the range, therefore I will have to use swing through as the method to shoot the low target. Just beware, the longer you leave it to shoot the first target, the more effort it will take to come back to shoot the second target.

STATION THREE

Single targets only on this station, no pairs. Shot High then Low.

STATION FOUR

The pair can be shot either way but must be nominated to the Referee first. We have come to station four as there are no pairs on station three. On station four you must nominate which target you want to shoot first of the pair, the high or the low house. This could be because



the wind is slowing one down and speeding the other up, or because you are a left or right handed shooter and favour one target over the other. You must nominate to the Referee which one you are going to shoot first!

STATION FIVE

Single targets only on this station, no pairs. Shot High then Low.

STATION SIX

Pairs shot Low House first. We have come here from station four as there are no pairs shot on station five. We are now going to shoot the pairs in the opposite way to the singles on this station, shooting low house then high house. I'm going to shoot the low target using the swing to method, and providing I hit it by the white post in the centre, I should comfortably be able to lock onto the high target, pull away and shoot it using the CPSA method.

STATION SEVEN

Pairs shot Low House first. This is shot in exactly the same way as the singles, low target, then high target. I'm going to shoot the low target just before the

white post in the centre, enabling me to pick up the incoming high target and shoot it a third to half way between the white post and the Low House.

FOOTWORK

There are two things to reiterate when shooting the pairs at English Skeet. The first is the importance of your footwork. I'm a right handed shooter and on stations six and seven, I'm shooting a left to right target as the second target of the pair, which means if I move my feet more round to the right I am able to shoot that target comfortably. Had my feet been set to shoot the single target, I would have been pushing the gun off my face, locking up and rolling of the line.

So, footwork is essential when shooting the pairs.

Secondly, with the pairs, the quicker you can shoot the first target, the more time you will have to shoot the second. Try to shoot the first target on or before the white post and this will increase your success rate on the second target.

Finally, ESK can be shot gun up or gun down. My preference is just out of my shoulder, but you can shoot it however

you wish as long as the gun is in the shoulder when the shot is taken.

ESK SEQUENCE

- Station 1: High Single then Low Single followed by Pairs shot high first.
- Station 2: High Single then Low Single followed by Pairs shot high first.
- Station 3: High Single then Low Single.
- Station 4: High Single then Low Single. Pairs with first target nominated.
- Station 5: High Single then Low Single.
- Station 6: High Single then Low Single followed by Pairs shot low first.
- Station 7: Low Single then High Single followed by Pairs shot low first.

There is a sub-discipline of ESK called Skeet Doubles which is also popular and as the name suggests, comprises only doubles on each station and no single targets. A competition is shot over a round of fifty targets and the sequence for this is as follows:

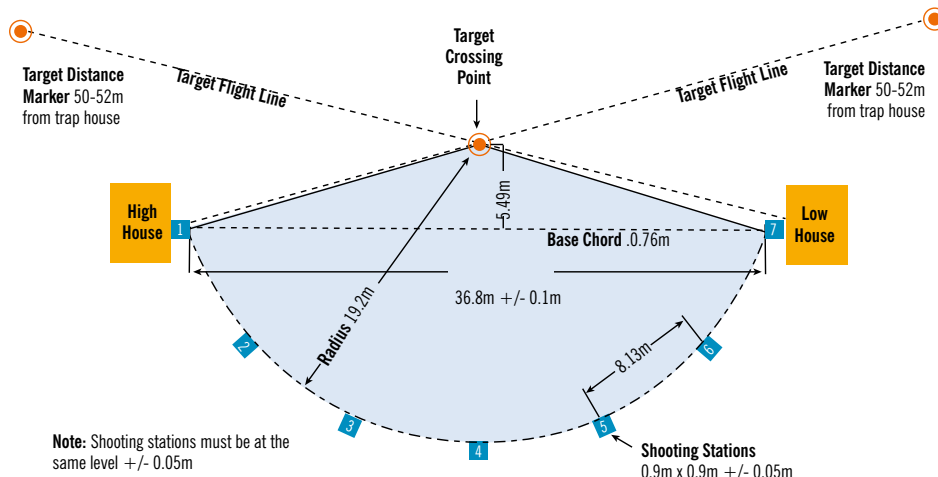

- Station 3: One (1) double high house first
- Station 4: One (1) double high house first
- Station 5: One (1) double low house first
- Station 6: One (1) double low house first
- Station 7: One (1) double low house first
- Station 6: One (1) double low house first
- Station 5: One (1) double low house first
- Station 4: One (1) double low house first
- Station 3: One (1) double high house first
- Station 2: One (1) double high house first

Second part of the round (26 targets)

- Station 1: One (1) double high house first
- Station 2: One (1) double high house first
- Station 3: One (1) double high house first
- Station 4: One (1) double high house first
- Station 5: One (1) double low house first
- Station 6: One (1) double low house first
- Station 7: One (1) double low house first
- Station 6: One (1) double low house first
- Station 5: One (1) double low house first
- Station 4: One (1) double low house first
- Station 3: One (1) double high house first
- Station 2: One (1) double high house first
- Station 1: One (1) double high house first

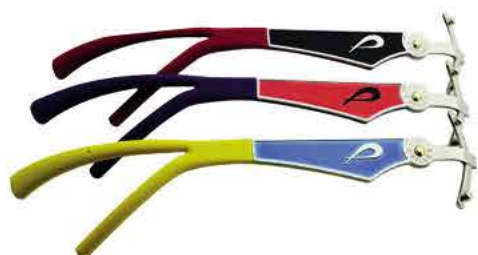

HOW TO GET AN AUTOMATIC EXTENSION OF YOUR SHOTGUN CERTIFICATE ON RENEWAL

In a welcome return to our regular series of legal articles from the CPSA honorary solicitor, **Laura Saunsbury** begins with this guide to taking the stress out of your certificate renewal.

As I embark on my 14th year of advising and assisting members, there are few signs of delays with certificate renewals improving. If anything, the delays seem to be getting longer in many police force areas. For this reason, it's wise to ensure that you definitely submit your renewal application at least eight weeks before the expiry date shown on your certificate. You will then have the legal right to an automatic extension of your certificate by up to eight weeks if the police cannot process your renewal application in time. To qualify for the extension, make sure you have provided the medical certificate from your doctor and also paid the renewal fee early enough, otherwise your application may be rejected as incomplete or invalid.

Shortly after you submit your application, the police should confirm they have received it and that your certificate will be automatically extended by up to eight weeks. The police may initially send you an email or text to confirm this. However, some police forces are not following this up with a formal letter to confirm the extension of your certificate, despite the fact the Home Office Guidance to the Police on Firearms Licensing indicates this should be done and that changes have been made to the National Firearms Licensing Management System to enable police forces to generate a standard letter for applicants confirming the extension of their certificate (paragraph 11.13).

If your local licensing department seem reluctant to provide such a letter or state they don't have the facility to do it, you may wish to draw their attention to this paragraph of the guidance when repeating this request. You can politely point out that as the guidance provides for such letters to be issued, many firearms dealers may refuse to sell you cartridges or another shotgun after your certificate expiry date if you cannot produce a police letter to prove your certificate has been extended.

Once you have the police letter confirming the extension, this will enable you to continue purchasing ammunition and exercising all the other rights of a certificate holder for eight weeks after the expiry date

shown on your certificate. It will also mean you do not need to lodge your guns with a firearms dealer or on another person's certificate prior to yours expiring, and you can safely continue to keep your guns at home.

If your certificate is not renewed before the expiry date, whenever leaving the house with your guns you should carry a copy of this letter with your certificate as evidence that it is still valid. If the police still haven't been able to process the renewal by the time the extension is coming to an end, ask them to issue you with a temporary permit, which they should do if the delays with your renewal have been caused by them rather than you.

TOP TIPS FOR A HASSLE FREE RENEWAL

Diarise these dates to remind you to take the following steps in the countdown to your certificate expiring –

- 1** 16 weeks ahead – deliver or post to your GP surgery the medical pro forma for completion plus the police explanatory standard letter for your doctor. This is downloadable online from your local police website
- 2** While you are waiting for your GP to supply the signed and stamped medical form, organise your character referee
- 3** 13 weeks before – chase your GP surgery if you haven't received the medical form back
- 4** Ten weeks ahead – plan on submitting your renewal at this point so you still have a couple of weeks to spare in case of any last minute problems
- 5** Five weeks ahead – by now police should have had your renewal application at least three weeks. If they haven't sent you an extension letter yet, email them to request one
- 6** Five weeks after expiry – if police still haven't renewed your certificate yet, email and ask them to confirm they will give you a temporary permit if they are not able to complete your renewal before the eight weeks extension runs out.

BERETTA A400

This month **Mark Brown** takes a look at the Beretta A400 Xcel Sporting ATS.

BERETTA A400 XCEL SPORTING ATS

gmk.co.uk

I'll admit it – the Beretta AL391 was one of my favourite semi-autos and one of those guns that I will never understand why I actually sold on! So, could this re-vamped version of the A400 from this renowned manufacturer replace my memories of yesteryear of my old and faithful Beretta semi-auto?

First up the Xcel A400 looks incredibly modern, from the Kick-Off recoil reducing system to the almost Apple Mac looking grey coloured receiver with laser engraving and AquaTechShield coating (corrosion/abrasion/scratch protection) this really is a gun for the 21st century. Beretta have certainly worked hard to make this new gun stand out from the crowd – but design alone never makes a gun sell so we were keen to see if the A400 offered something extra to the clay target shooter.

We tested the 30" barrel version which comes with three Optima High Performance 20mm extended chokes which makes it just under 31" in length in total. There is a 28" option too and 32" version as a special order in the UK. Upon first handling the gun is very well balanced and comes up to the shoulder nicely. Unusually for a semi-auto there is a palm swell on the stock which always makes a gun just that bit more comfortable to shoot. The blue bolt offers a lovely contrast to the grey

action and the oversized bolt handle and release button are clever designs which really do make operation of the gun effortless. The shell carrier and loading port has also been updated and it really does make a huge difference to how quickly and easily you can load the A400 and I also really liked how simply pressing in the button on the carrier engages the bolt to

stay open – it's a very clever design. The

top rib has also been given a new design and the tapered 10x8mm is what you would want to see on a gun aimed at the clay market.

As with all Beretta semi-autos the mechanism works on a gas fed system rather than inertia and on test it worked faultlessly even down to 21g loads. The screw cap at the end of the magazine tube also has the option to add weights which I have not seen on a semi-auto before and would be useful for those that like to make this kind of adjustment. However, I did find that the A400 felt perfectly balanced straight out of the box and was steady even on very long

crossing and driven targets, the 31" barrels adding a bit more steadiness than you would expect to feel on an auto. The test gun had both the Kick-Off and Xtra Grain stock features. Xtra Grain is a unique to Beretta laser process that enhances and improves the natural figuring in the walnut. The Kick-Off stock system utilises hydraulic shock absorbers and Beretta claim that it can reduce felt recoil by up to 50%. I can certainly say that using this gun with 24g loads was easy and enjoyable. You can opt for a version without the Kick-Off feature if preferred and there is also a Vittoria stock option for female shooters.

It's great to see how Beretta have taken the successful A400 model and tailored it completely to the needs of the clay target shooter. It's a great gun and well priced, but I was a little surprised that it only ships in a cardboard box so if you do like to transport in an ABS case you will need to purchase that separately. The semi-auto has clearly evolved and although it pains me a little to say my old AL391 does now look a little archaic when compared with this wonderful new model from Beretta. 🦅

You May Win' prize.

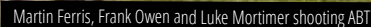
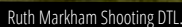
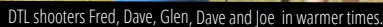
The draw can contain any number from one to 100. That may mean that the person with the lowest score in the competition may win the prize, as in a similar way the person with the highest score may win. It may favour the C Class shooters. It is not based on the range of scores shot in the competition. For example – if the lowest score in Skeet is 42 and the random number chosen by the computer is five then the shooter with the score of 42 wins. The county CPSA committee is looking to convert more of the 'just for fun' shooters and the 'I'm not good enough' shooters into competitors this year.

We've also been asked for clarification about this. Northants Colts and Juniors entering the county competitions of

Skeet, Sporting, All Round, and Sportrap will get their entry paid for. The young shooter turns up with their gun and cartridges and the county will pay to enter the competition 'targets only' so all they have to pay for is the £2 levy. cloth badge problem made for a difficult time. The county's balance at 1 Feb 2022 stood at £2,102.

The biggest problem for Peter was having badges made as nobody had any in-depth knowledge of what was needed, as Sandie did a good job previously, but left without any handover.

Peter asked any members who want to assist in the badge programme to make contact with him.

On health grounds it was agreed it was not 'safe' to hold committee meetings at someone's home. Instead, it was accepted some Zoom meetings in the year be done and in the Autumn and Early New Year a room be booked for a face to face meetings prior to the 2023 AGM. Any Ideas for a venue let the secretary have details, anywhere in a line from Kingston to Bromley would be suitable.

It had been decided in advance there would not be a raffle or trophies at the AGM as there was not a Supreme Champion winner this year.

OBITUARIES

ERIC DAVIS 1943-2022

We are very sad to announce the loss of Berkshire shooter Eric Davis who sadly passed away on 14 March 2022 after a long battle with cancer. Our sincere condolences go out to his wife Joan and the family.

Berkshire stalwart Andrew Halfacre remembers fondly how "Eric was a huge figure on the Berkshire shooting scene and could rightly be described as one of the county's founding fathers. Eric won over 30 county titles and represented Berkshire many times at Inter-County events. A fine all-round shot, his title wins would have come in a variety of disciplines, but English Skeet was his passion in the early days. I understand he won that county title eight times in a row.

My earliest memories of Eric are from the 1970's when Berkshire was in the South West region, and as a small boy, I used to travel with my father John to Inter-County events all over the South West. Eric, along with his friends Barry Woolford and George Hedges, were often in the Berkshire teams too. An early recollection is of an Inter-County DTL event in Liskeard, Cornwall where Eric was probably in his late 20's and shooting well. His enthusiasm and passion for the sport was very evident even then. Many years later, I had the pleasure of shooting with Eric for Berkshire in a National Inter-Counties English Skeet event at Bisley. Eric started with a 22 and looked at me as if to say, 'I can do better than that'. He was right, and he finished with a 75-straight for 97/100. He had great determination to win."


Close friend and Berkshire shot Phil Seurre remembers that "Eric was at the heart of shooting in Berkshire. He was well known by game shooters and competitive clay shooters alike, and local farmers relied on him to

organise their annual clay shoots.

He was an early member of the CPSA and he competed against the like of John and Mick Halfacre, who were in his own words 'the ones to beat'. His name appears on most, if not all of the Berkshire Trophies and often more than once. Eric was the first Berkshire Shooter to win the sash for the inaugural 1997 Supreme Championship. Then in true style he won it again in 1998, after taking the High Gun in a National Event organised by Beretta and won a new shotgun. Eric was Chair of the Flowerpot Clay Pigeon Club until 1995 when it was dissolved and later Chair of Berkshire CPSA Committee. He moved on to form Flightline Targets in 1995, operating from Maidenhead. He ran this company until he moved down to Wales with his wife Joan in 2016. At Flightline Targets he welcomed all shooters often without payment and receiving free tuition, his enthusiasm and encouragement caused many to take up the sport seriously and go on to enter county and even international competitions".

Eric was a great ambassador. He will be missed by Berkshire shooters and many others in the sport. 🕊



CREATING THE CLAY CART

We Spoke to **Daryl Pugh**, co-inventor of the Clay Cart.



Q Can you tell us a little about yourself and your shooting background?

Claycart was designed by David Curtis and Daryl Pugh – both Electrical Engineers and long time colleagues and collaborators! David was primarily a game shooter from when he was in short trousers and I only took up clays in 2019 as a bit of respite from normal living! We are local to Cambridge and Eriswell Lodge so it's really easy to just load up and go to suit. We also get around other grounds, David loves the competition too, me less so!

Q Please can you introduce us to your new product

Claycart was conceived from our own necessity in 2020 following a serious horse related accident David sustained. He had just started to walk again, and begin a long road back to recovery and fitness after a few weeks of me shouldering two bags full of cartridges and guns we both had the same question – why isn't there a shooting equivalent of the golf caddy? Two weeks on from that and David had designed and built a prototype in his workshop that he named the Claycart. It looked great, simply designed for one purpose and built to stand the test of time and use. For a few months David used it, tested it and we then

decided to tweak a few of the design features and manufacture some units with the aim of retailing them. We have received great feedback on the Claycart since bringing it into the market and most recently we exhibited at The British Shooting Show where it was well received.

The challenge with any new innovative product is gaining acceptance within the community – we see many shooters who physically struggle with their gear yet still say they prefer to carry the old way! Once a product is out there, being seen by others as a useful tool then the target market is anyone and everyone who want a sensible way of getting around the ground, shoot, etc without the physical effort involved in carrying gear over both shoulders. That is the fundamental principle – the result of this being that you are better organised, your gun and gear is on hand, everything is in place and you're fresh to shoot, possibly with an improved score, all without laying your expensive equipment in the mud.

Our oldest customer so far is a sprightly 91-year-old shooter! We have

ladies, men of a certain age, and shooters that simply don't want to risk damage to their pride and joy.

We have sold across the UK, NI, Switzerland and we have enquiries from the US.

Q Talk us through the design, how much can it hold and how heavy is it?

Claycart is designed to be simple – it is powder coated, has jig set steel chassis, stainless components and fittings, solid bearing type wheels, a strap made by a local Saddler, a drinks holder for a hot or cold flask, and a front basket that easily holds up to 300 cartridges. The empty cart weighs just 8.5kg and it will easily carry 300 cartridges and two guns. The standard design is for one gun (in slip) but we do also offer an extended strap option for customers that require two gun carrying capacity.

Q What's your favourite feature of the product?

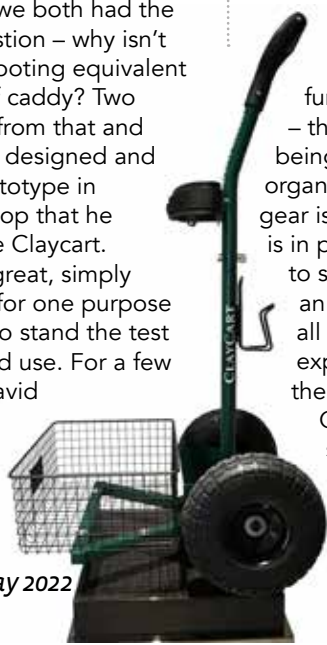
Our favourite feature would be just that we have created something new to market that previously didn't exist! We are both 4x4 fans anyway so it would have to be the styling generally – it just looks right for the job it is intended for.

Q Where do you see the ClayCart in the future?

As a product we aim for it to gain universal acceptance within the shooting community – the sport is trying to attract new people of all ages and genders so our aspiration is that, in a similar way to a new golfer when they purchase their kit, a new shooter would be advised to purchase a Claycart alongside the big ticket item and associated gear – to us that just makes sense, less chore, more enjoyment, keeps people coming back and the wheels of the sport turning.

Q This could be a great gift for shooters, are there or will there be any personalisation or colour options available now or in the future?

Claycart is of course a brilliant gift – there are not that many different products to choose from that are affordable. Currently we offer a small range of base colours – green, black, burnt orange and royal blue. We can make to order in club colours or any other RAL colour and we have numerous ideas on where the Claycart could be developed to in terms of accessories and personalisation – that will be some way into the future. 🍀
