



Instructor Development Workshop (IDW)

The Instructor Development Workshop is a one-day course and a prerequisite to attending the four-day Level 1 Instructor Training Course. Candidates will be given an overview of the full four-day course and be assessed for their suitability to progress onto the ITC. Candidates must have attended a Safety Officer Course.

candidate can get a novice to hit a moving target safely using the CPSA Method. Candidates must have attended an IDW within the previous two years.

A successful opener to the season for the FITASC teams and individual competitors.

The Senior and Veteran teams led the field from day one, with the Seniors winning by ten targets and the Veterans by a massive 36 targets.

The Junior team performed well to maintain third position from day two, finishing 21 targets ahead of Sweden.

Not forgetting the Men's team, although not achieving a place on the podium, they made up ground on the last day to overhaul Cyprus

to finish in fourth against strong competition in the 12 team contest.

The Master team was a 'Walk Over' as they were the only team entered in the first year of this team category, a real shame as there were 39 individual shooters.

Now, the individuals was dominated by GBR's Senior, Veteran and Master shooters, taking two of the three podium places in all three categories, plus four of the top five were GBR shooters.

In the Seniors, Kevin Jobling, having dropped down to fourth at the end of day three, made up ground on day four to take gold, just one target ahead of Nigel Hart, Matt Hance and Alain

Gendreau (FRA). The shoot off between the three was won by Alain, with Nigel taking bronze and Matt in fourth, closely followed by George Digweed in fifth.

The Veterans was equally impressive, with no shoot-offs required. Stephen Williams took gold, four targets ahead of Chris (Chip) Smith but it was a close run contest between these two over the four days. Tony Manvell and John Pool fourth and fifth respectively. Tony climbed impressively over the four days, having finished equal 18th on day one!

Rhys Harrison and Ali Turnball shot well in the Juniors to finish fifth and sixth respectively.

In the Open, Sam Green, James Attwood and Mark Winser were in close contention, finishing in fourth, fifth and sixth respectively.

Many congratulations to all.

CLAY HUNT VR MEGAVR DUCK HUNTER

This month we continue our look at training aids to help improve our scores and we are going to be looking at the world of Virtual Reality or better known as VR. It's important to say from the start of this review that Clay Hunt VR is not a teen focussed shoot 'em up but a well thought out and designed clay shooting simulator. On the back of this product Mega VR have developed the Duck Hunter and together they deliver an immersive shooting experience in the comfort of your own home!


EQUIPMENT

In order not to confuse anyone at the outset it's important to breakdown what you need equipment wise for this set up, what the different items are called and why and most importantly how much it all costs. First off you need to have the VR headset itself and this is called Meta-Quest and is made by Meta the people that own Facebook. The current version is the Meta-Quest 3 which has substantially upgraded graphics capability from its predecessor, the Meta-Quest 2, and both have built in hard drives to run the programs (apps) so that you can play completely wirelessly. The entry level Meta-Quest 3

starts at £479.99 for the 128gb memory or you can go up to 512gb for an extra £140. The Meta-Quest 2 has reduced in price to £199.99 and will run Clay Hunt VR but in lower resolution.

The Clay Hunt VR app (the game) costs £22.99 and then you need the gun stock accessory to house the controllers of the Meta-Quest so that you can emulate shotgun shooting properly and cost for this is £269. This is where the

Duck Hunter product comes into the frame. I spoke to Nick Royle (owner of Mega VR Ltd), and he explained that the gun stock he designed for use with the app was named after the infamous Duck Hunter game on the Nintendo NES back in the 1980's and was the first thing that he can remember pointing at and shooting something although proper shooting did enter his life at a later date. With web


and graphic design and data analysis on Nick's CV along with a deep love for the concept of VR it was no surprise that he has designed his own gun stock to make the shooting experience as life like as possible.

SETUP

Once you have bought the VR headset, game and the Duck Hunter you are all set and then begins the fun of adjusting the gun stock to your exact liking. Nick has really worked wonders on a product that can be adjusted, tweaked and set up so as to be as close to your normal sporting shotgun as possible. On the stock there are adjustments for comb, length of pull and cast and you can also adjust the butt angle, length and position left and right. In addition to this there is the option to add weight in two different locations (just in front of the fore-end and just under the pistol grip) without any weight the gunstock weighs 3.7lb and with the fore-end weight added it increases to 5.5lbs. If you add the standard weight kit you can go up to 8.4lbs or even 10lbs with the Super Heavy weight kit. You can also reduce down in 15g increments to get your perfect set up of both balance and weight. You can even choose from a number of different colour combinations. I was amazed to learn that the Duck Hunter is completely 3D printed, it helps to keep the purchase price low and is a real feat of modern engineering and also produced entirely in the UK. Once I had fine-tuned the set up to my exact liking it was time to get stuck into the simulation itself.

PRACTICING

If you have not used VR before then you are in for a very exciting experience – once the headset is on and comfortable

you are completely immersed in the world you have entered and with Clay Hunt VR it is the reception area of a gun club that greets you first and from here you choose what you want to shoot. The clay shooting options are Sporting, Skeet, Double Trap and American and International Trap and there is also an option to design and shoot your own Sporting layout in the Creative mode. Once you start shooting you soon realise that this is no arcade game, you have to really think about the targets and give them plenty of lead in order to break them. There are limitless options to change the type of gun, size of choke

used and point of aim etc, and you can also adjust the challenge of the shooting from Beginner to Professional and trust me you need to be an exceptional shot to thrive in the more difficult modes.

So, the question remains as to whether this set up which will cost you around £770 all in (with the Meta-Quest 3) is a viable training aid or simply a bit of fun? My answer to that would be that it is very useful for gun mount, gun swing and judging lead and I have no doubt that doing this daily at home would show a very positive impact on the clay ground. I also think that it is invaluable when teaching youngsters or novices how to shoot as you can clearly see lead and also where you are missing but without the pressure of live ammunition, recoil and spectators. Once those principles are understood then it has to be easier to put them in to practice for real as you will already have an understanding of sight pictures and good gun mount. A fantastic feature of Clay Hunt VR is Full Analysis in the clay simulation which shows shot pattern and trace of gun swing and practice mode in the Pheasant shooting simulation. These both show where you miss a target very clearly and you can see immediately if you are behind, off line or too far in front which is very helpful indeed for training.

What VR won't ever do is replace the real thing, there is no substitute for that either with clay or game shooting, but I have to say that shooting as many pheasants as I can for £770 is rather appealing when compared to the costs of a driven game day these days.

If you are looking to buy your first new clay gun or hoping to upgrade in order to wring out every drop of your potential, then selecting a shotgun can be a daunting process. We sought guidance from Browning HQ in Belgium for the pick of their range, from budget friendly to the very best on offer.

ENTRY LEVEL

If you are entering the world of competitive clay shooting, you could do far worse than selecting a Browning B525 Composite Adjustable. Whilst a step away from the traditional walnut stock and fore-end, the

composite stock is profoundly solid, perfect for a huge volume of shots at the shooting ground without ever



putting a strain on the gun. For the level of adjustability and features (five Invector+ chokes, adjustable trigger, weights etc.) it offers minimal strain on the wallet for a walnut equivalent, carrying a recommended price tag of just £2,030.

MID-RANGE

In the mid-range bracket comes the B525 Sporter Laminated Adjustable, another addition to the best-selling B525 range. 'Sporty and aggressive' in appearance, this gun offers superior rigidity for a perfectly stable shot and is available for both right- and left-handed use. It also comes with four Midas Invector+ chokes. RRP: £2,540.

TOP LEVEL

The Ultra XS Pro Adjustable has been crowned FITASC World Champion on several occasions thanks to the talent of British shooter Sam Green. Supplied with eight Invector+ chokes, two spacers, three Inflex II butt plates and three trigger cues. The Ultra XS Pro

Adjustable Comb can be balanced on demand thanks to a clever counterweight system. Despite its array of technical innovations and performance focus, it is a highly elegant gun when its new engraving is matched with grade 4 oil finished walnut. This top-level gun carries an equally competitive RRP of £4,240.

HERITAGE SPORter

For those who want to combine their love of clays with something truly special,

Browning offers the Heritage Sporter, which combines the performance of a modern, title-winning shotgun with the elegance of a true deluxe gun, with stunning side plates. The pistol buttstock and tulip fore-end are made from beautiful, oil-finished walnut and each gun is beautifully presented with scroll or game scene

engraving. As the more expensive of the four, this gun retails at £7,610.

2024 CPSA GROUND OF THE YEAR

We speak to **Rob Fenwick** from E.J. Churchill Shooting Ground.



Q When did the ground open and what makes it special?

1989 was the official date and we have a photo on the wall of what it looked like then. I wish I had a digital version as you wouldn't believe the difference. Since then it has grown and grown to the wonderful ground it is today.

I think the team make it very special, the facilities and the fact that it is a complete one stop shop for anyone going clay shooting, be it a novice or expert. We take great pride in what we deliver every day and no matter who you are or what you want to do, we want you to have an amazing experience.

Q How does it feel to win club/ground of the year at the CPSA awards?

We have been lucky enough to win it before and it is the most brilliant feeling. I am just so chuffed for the team as they work so hard and after last year and the massive success of the World English Sporting Championships and many other events, I really think they deserve it!

Q What disciplines/facilities/events do you offer around the grounds?

Loads of English Sporting stands, Sportrap, FITASC sporting, Compak using the proper acoustic system, OT using acoustic, English Skeet and Olympic Skeet. We then have all the simulated game layouts for grouse and high towers. Basically, there is 205 traps on the ground and so plenty for everyone.

Q How has the ground developed over the years?

I don't think we have ever stopped. The main lodge itself has gone through three extensions from the original cabin. We then built the safari lodge as well as the Pavilion that can seat up to 400 people. On the ground itself we have constantly changed things. In Covid we tarmacked all the shooting ground paths and built seven brand new large undercover shooting areas. So no matter what the weather you can shoot from the dry and take shelter. We installed the British Shooting centre of excellence a few years ago and as soon



as it stops raining, we have a new 30 meter crane to go in to throw some even better crossers and high driven birds. Unfortunately, with the terrible winter we have had, we just can't get it into place until the ground hardens up. We have some pretty mega developments for the ground which we have been working on for some time. If this comes off the ground could almost double in size and it will be even more of an amazing facility, so watch this space and fingers crossed!

Q What's the clay shooting like in your area?

Hugely popular. People are here every day training, practicing or just having fun shooting clays. We get circa 50,000 people a year through the shooting ground, so I guess this gives you an idea of how busy the place is. Couple this with over 400 events a year and we have one very exciting ground.

One area I love seeing is the growth of registered

competitions mid week. They are now serious business for so many shooting grounds. We were the first ground in the UK to do this over 15 years ago, we did it for five years before anyone else started! Everyone thought we were mad, but demand slowly grew and today people love it. We average over 150 throughout the year! It used to be more but we use a squadded system which we have used since Covid and have limited numbers a little bit, although I believe this system gives a far better experience to the shooter.



Q What has the ground got planned for 2024?

We host a huge amount of Charity Clay shooting events all over the country, so these take up a lot of time. We also have the British Open Sporting and Sportrap at Swinton which the team from HQ will go help and run, so this is very exciting. We are doing lots of county competitions, from sporting to compak to sportrap as well as selection shoots for FITASC sporting. We are also going to do another Churchill Cup in September, so watch out for this as its going to be a

brilliant event! As well as all of this, our regular sporting competitions, compak and we are going to do a monthly FITASC as well. Couple all of this with regular visitors and people just coming to have fun!

Q Is there anything we have missed, that you feel should be included in an article about your ground?

We have a very active environmental policy and we are conscious of doing all we can. We recycle all our cartridges; our Polaris vehicles are electric and we have electric charging stations for clients. We also use the latest eco clays from

Laporte and our baseball caps are made out of ocean recycled plastic! I think it is important for us all to try as hard as we can to reduce our impact on the environment.

The only other thing to mention is our wonderful in house chef Jenette! She serves the most delicious food and our customers love it! Its all-proper home cooked, locally sourced ingredients and great value! Its the perfect way to finish off a round of clays at any time of the year.

REGISTERED SHOOTS

WHAT TO EXPECT

Richard Worthington explores what to do on your first Registered shoot.

Clay target shooting is what we are all about, whether it's shooting at your local clay club, competing at Registered shoots and championships, shooting for England and indeed, at the pinnacle of our sport in the Olympics!

 Firstly, you need to be a Full (competition) member, so please make sure you have the correct membership level. 

Whenever we go shooting, we all want to do our best, break as many clays as possible and ideally beat our shooting buddies so why not take the next step and take part in a registered shoot?

We have shooting clubs and grounds around the Country who regularly hold Registered shoots in the Sporting, Skeet, and Trap disciplines, so there's normally something going on not too far away. However, there are some things you need to know when you decide to start your journey into registered competitions.

Firstly, you need to be a Full (competition) member, so please make sure you have the correct membership level. If you are a Clubman member, you can upgrade at any time to Full membership so just call the CPSA and we can sort this for you over the phone!

We operate a classification system with our Registered shoots (a bit like a golf handicap) so that when you are shooting, you are effectively shooting against others of a similar ability. Our classes range from C Class up to AAA Class, although typically AAA Class only comes into play in major championships, so at a registered shoot it is normally AA, A, B, or C Class. You can read more about classifications at cpsa.co.uk/classifications/what-are-classifications. We also have categories such as Colts (U16), Juniors (16 – 20), Seniors (21 – 59) Veterans (60+), Ladies and Disabled, but all of these are typically only seen at championships where there is a large entry, and the prize money can be shared across class and category.

When you book on to do your first Registered shoot you will be unclassified, as you need to do three shoots in a discipline in order for us to calculate an average over the three shoots, and then we can use this average against the national averages and apply a temporary classification to your record. For example, if you shot a 69ex100, 74ex100, and 72ex100 in three English Sporting Registered shoots, your average would be 71.66% which would put you in B Class. Now, every three months we re-calculate those national averages (called issue periods) and at the next classification point after you have received your temporary classification, you will automatically be given a formal classification. This all might sound complicated, but don't worry, it all goes on in the background and you can track your scores and ►

progress via our website, and we update the shooting grounds directly with any classification changes every three months.

So, what do you do next? Check our fixtures page on the website or within *Pull!* magazine and look for any Registered shoots coming up within comfortable driving distance. Check whether or not you need to pre-book your place in a squad with a set starting time or whether you can just turn up on the day and pay for your entry. This is important as quite a few clubs operate a strict booking time so that they can manage the entries, and this is typically the most efficient way of completing your round within a sensible time.

When you book on you will be asked whether you are shooting competition or targets only (often referred to as birds only) and there is a difference with the entry fee between the two of around £5. This £5 per competition shooter is called the prize fund and is paid out to the winners in each class and is dependent upon how many enter in each class. Targets only means you are not eligible to win any prize money, but your score is still recorded and sent back to us for classification purposes. Often people starting their registered shoot journey will go targets only to ease themselves into registered shooting gently, however, our software that the grounds use is very clever, and you can enter competition if you wish, as it will simply calculate a classification for you for that day only, based on your scores on certain stands/layouts used that day.

Once you have paid your entry fee, you will either be part of an organised squad or free to go off on your own or with your friends and start



shooting. There will be a person either with your squad or on each stand who will operate the traps and score for you so if you are shooting on your own, don't worry, they will handle everything, just focus on your shooting! Once you have finished your round, it is imperative that you hand in your score card back at the clubhouse so that your score is recorded and then registered with us.

Each discipline has its own unique set of rules so it's worth having a quick read of our technical rulebook which you can download from our website.

That's about it but if you have any questions, don't hesitate to call us, or ask when you check into shoot or just ask another shooter. We are a very friendly bunch and always happy to explain the rules and etiquette when shooting Registered competitions.

I don't know about you, but I am looking forward to the Paris Olympics and Paralympics. There is something simply spectacular about watching competitors from all over the world representing their countries and chasing their dreams. And it can be very powerful and inspirational when you witness those dreams being realised. Just think about Peter Wilson winning gold at London 2012. It sends a shiver down the spine. And as usual Great Britain will have competitors in the shooting events in Paris, because shooters have worked hard and secured those all-important quota places.

But even in the buzz of an Olympic year, we must also think further ahead to build on the existing platform and develop the ongoing strength of British

competitors on the global stage. With that in mind, the group below makes up British Shooting's National Academy announced in October last year.

Clearly this is a group of talented, hard-working and dedicated shooters and each one of them has a fascinating story, and for this feature I was able to catch up with Beth Norton and Ewen Ross.

BETH NORTON

Hertford-based Beth is in her first year studying for A levels at Bishop's Stortford College. Her love of competitive sport was sparked at just six years old when she was inspired by the buzz of the 2012 London Olympics. Through her childhood she relished competing in a number of sports, including netball, equestrian and athletics.

But there was a change in direction and focus in 2018 when her dad suggested she try clay shooting. Almost immediately she got her first taste of success, becoming U11 Ladies Champion (using a borrowed gun) at the IAPS Clay Pigeon Shooting Championships at West London Shooting School. The following year she took the top girls prize (an MG car no less) at The Schools Challenge run by Oxford Gun Company.

Having tried DTL and English skeet and mindful of her Olympic aspirations, she turned to Olympic Skeet (OSK). In 2020 Beth joined British Shooting's Pathway starting in a Development Academy group and was promoted into the Talent Academy the following year.

THE BREAKTHROUGH YEAR

It is fair to say 2022 saw rapid development. Her first GB cap was earned at the Junior World Cup in Suhl, Germany where she and her teammates took home gold in the team event. She went on to achieve top 10 placings in her first European and World Championships. Indeed, she made her first championship final at the World Championships.

Beth's progress continued in 2023, her GCSE year. By the end of the year, she had amassed an impressive haul of medals at home and abroad, including wins at two international grand prix events in Italy.

At her second European Championships in Croatia, she made the

always at hand at Doveridge and World Class Programme coaches Per Moen and Richard Brickell.

Beth said: "Being in the National Academy has given me an insight into the bigger picture of elite sport and the physical, technical and mental work required to be a fully prepared athlete."

She did highlight that she would not have been able to do her sport without the support of her parents and her sponsors; CommsQuest Consulting Ltd, NortonSport Photography, Cens, Zoli, Edgar Brothers, Feathers Motorsport and Laporte.

EWEN ROSS

Ewen hails from just outside Inverness and spent his formative years travelling around shooting grounds as his parents both shot in the Scottish DTL team. Now, aged 24, he is based in Hertfordshire with his girlfriend and fellow OT shooter, Maddie Purser. He works two jobs to help support his shooting, enjoys playing darts, and for the past three years has done some strong man activities.

final despite dislocating her ankle just before the start of the competition. As the season ended she had established new personal bests and set three new British records. Her continued hard work earned her a place in the National Academy for 2024 and she is the youngest to do so.

This year has already seen a major step when she got her first senior cap competing in the World Cup in Cairo in January. This was followed by a bronze medal at the Qatar Open Amir Grand Prix in February.

JUGGLING COMMITMENTS

As with any athlete it's not always easy to strike the right balance between training and the rest of life and Beth said: "It can be a challenge to train for OSK as the limited OSK ranges are in very high demand. This can mean a lot of travel around the country to train. I also work away from the range with gym work almost daily, which is set around my shooting and school commitments."

She works with personal coach Jeremy Bird (who, despite being based nearly 300 miles away has a massive impact on her shooting), Mike Gilligan who is

Ewen's journey in clay shooting really started in 2013. His parents competed at the World DTL Championships and Ewen was struck by the level of competition. His interest in clay shooting was sparked. He had a go and that was it. He shot DTL for six months, and then went on to compete in ABT, achieving his first Scotland cap in the Home International.


But when he tried OT at Glenmoriston he was hooked on the trap disciplines: "My first memory of OT was that the discipline was tough but a LOT of fun." Initially his father helped him but there was no other coaching until he went to the FITAV Summer Camp where he first worked with coach Marco Micheli.

Ewen was a spectator at the 2014 Commonwealth Games in Glasgow. In awe of the whole event, he started to think about going for the Great Britain team. He joined the Scottish Target Shooting Performance Programme and set to work on honing his shooting skills. Initially he worked with Iain MacGregor and then with Marco who became coach to the Scottish squad.

Ewen has now represented Scotland in a number of Home Internationals – in ABT and OT. His first cap was at his local ground, Glenmoriston, and he said: "I felt immensely proud to represent my country. It was such a privilege to be in the team." ▶

THE HARD WORK STARTS TO PAY OFF

His first GB cap (as a junior) came in August 2017 when he went to the Junior World Cup in Porpetto, Italy. This was a great learning experience: "It felt particularly good to be at that competition as I had missed out on a team place the previous year, due to exams." Clearly, all his hard work was starting to pay dividends.

He turned senior in 2020 and started that year with a bronze in his class at his first senior international grand prix event in Malaga. After a couple of years grappling with consistency, he carried on working hard and by 2023 he started to put in some excellent scores, including a new Scottish record (123/125) at the Perazzi 500 Grand Prix at Fauxdeglia International Clay Shooting Centre which earned him a silver medal.

Ewen has been putting his Perazzi High Tech to good use and the 2024 competition season started well with a

bronze at the Amir Grand Prix in Doha and a top 10 finish at the Cyprus Grand Prix. He has his first senior outing for GB coming up in late April, when he competes in the final Olympic qualifier in Doha. It is clear from our conversation that he relishes the challenge of competing overseas: "The level of competition is intense and there is little margin for error. But it's essential to become the best you can be."

LEARNING TO TRAIN PROPERLY

He told me he it took him a while to learn to train properly: "Training is not about numbers of clays hit, but about working on the technicalities so that you are fully prepared for competition. It is where you work on any weaknesses so that in competition they are stronger."

His biggest challenge has been to learn to trust himself. In recent years he has an increased sense of purpose for every

training session, as he has spent time getting to understand what he needs to do. He is a man with a plan – a plan that is based around his competition schedule.

He also loves the inclusivity of the sport: "You can be on a squad with anyone from Olympic medallist to someone new to the discipline."

His favourite shooting memory is starting out with his dad helping him. He treasures the time when they both represented Scotland in a team.

He said: "I want to thank my mum for all her support, my dad for his technical guidance, my girlfriend Maddie for keeping me grounded and coach Marco for the support he has given."

He also sent a big thank you to STS, British Shooting and Nuthampstead Shooting Ground for their support. But other sponsors are welcome.

THE POWER OF INSPIRATION

Beth and Ewen both took up the sport when they were inspired by major competitions, and their stories demonstrate the power of the big events. As they say, if you can see you can be it. Both Beth and Ewen have their focus on what it takes to achieve international success and are fully committed to the hard work and grind that is involved. But through all this their love of their sport shines. It was a pleasure to learn more about their journeys so far and I will be following with interest as they get to compete for their country in the coming months. 🎉




Easter Monday followed with our second championship, again at Brookbank and this time ABT. Once again Richard King achieved county champion, once again scoring two 25-straight with his total score


Hampshire and IOW Sporting Championship

Q What age did you start shooting?

Q How did you start off?

As a result of a car accident and extensive spinal surgery in 2012, which didn't quite go according to plan, my life changed considerably and at that time I was permanently using a wheelchair. I had to give up my career, as well as some pastimes including running and horse riding. Therefore I was desperate to replace and find a new competitive focus, one which I would enjoy and be able to compete in – it took a few years! Towards the end of 2017, aged 48, the late Graham Brown and my husband Rod introduced me to Trap shooting and I won my first County Championship the following year. I loved it and I set myself a goal there and then to shoot for the England Ladies team. As there are no England para DTL teams, I had to qualify for the able bodied team and the support and encouragement I have had from so many shooters has been amazing!

Q What do you enjoy most about clay shooting?

I have always been a very driven, competitive person – in work and play – so naturally wanted to continue in that vein! DTL is you against the clay and enables me to use some of the qualities I thrived on in my previous life! I also love the camaraderie of my DTL fellow shooters; so many have been encouraging, supportive and inspirational!

Q What is your favourite discipline and competition?

I'm a DTL girl and it works for me shooting in my wheelchair, as I only move my wheelchair five times. I still have so much to achieve, but I would love to find the time



to shoot with the DSG more, as I have enjoyed doing some different disciplines with them. Last year I represented England in South Africa in the Worlds, which was a dream come true for me, especially as the Ladies team won a Bronze and I personally did well!

Q Do you have any current sponsors?

Q I was introduced to Eley cartridges by the late Dave Toomer and loved them. They have low recoil which helps me, but also dense patterns which helps dust those clays and I have 100% confidence in them. Dave made it clear to me what I needed to do and win to gain sponsorship by them and I am delighted to be sponsored by them and would like to take this opportunity to thank Carl Weller, Veronic Nugent and the Eley team. I'm not very good at 'asking' for sponsorship, my mindset has always been if I'm worthy, then I would be asked! When I started out Graham Brown took me to Perazzi to have a gun fitted, which was a necessity for me and I have shot my Perazzi since then. One of my goals would be to gain sponsorship from them, so I have lots to aim and compete for.

Q Can you tell us about your most recent successes?

I have been nominated for the last two years for 'Disabled shooter of the Year' and won both times. It is a humbling experience as there are so many people who have achieved great things and it means so much to win – partly because it's voted for by fellow shooters. This experience has helped me as a person and I am truly grateful to everyone who voted for me – thank you.

Q What is your most memorable achievement?

The first time I achieved my England cap was a very emotional moment! Graham Brown who got

me started and helped me so much, and Dave Toomer who helped me in the DTL discipline, both believed in me gaining an England cap and both passed away prior to achieving this. They would have been so proud and I would have loved to share that experience with them! Also representing England at the Worlds in South Africa, shooting with the Ladies and winning a team Bronze, as well as an individual Bronze in a two day Grand Prix!

Q If you could chose three people to shoot with who would they be?

George Digweed, as he is a legend and just awesome, Amber Rutter as she has achieved so much, is so resilient and inspirational, and then my husband Rod as he does so much to make it possible for me to do what I love!

I represented England in South Africa in the Worlds, which was a dream come true

Q If you could time travel, what advice would you give to your younger self?

I used to worry all the time that people wouldn't want to shoot with me because of my wheelchair, as it would take time to get my chair in the correct position and set myself up etc, but that was my 'hang up', not theirs. Although I still have some challenging times at grounds that don't cater for wheelchairs that can bring back the fear of me hindering other shooters. Also, 'don't listen to everyone'... people are so kind and genuinely want to help, but sitting in a wheelchair and shooting has different challenges. When Tony Dore started helping me, the first thing he did was sit in my chair and shoot a round to understand how he could help me with my individual challenges, and how he would align his coaching.

Q What is coming up for you in the next 12 months?

I'm currently going through the England selection for the third year and I've had one great weekend and one disappointing weekend, so I have lots to work on at the last selection weekend to ensure I qualify! I will definitely be shooting the Worlds (hopefully for my country) as it's on 'home ground' at Bywell, which will be amazing.

Q If money was no object what would you be shooting?

I wouldn't change my beloved Perazzi or my Eley Gold DTL cartridges as both do a fantastic job. However, I would love to travel and shoot competitions abroad (warm weather is good for me!). I love the sport, love the people, and would shoot every spare moment I had! 🎣
