

CLUBHOUSE NEWS

DIRECTOR NOMINATIONS

Vacancies have arisen for the three positions of East Midlands Region Director, South West Region Director and one National Director to join the Association's Board, following the current three-year terms for each of these posts expiring. All of these positions will run from immediately after the Association's AGM in March 2025. Nominations will open on 1 October 2024.

To continue with the development of the Association, the Board needs members with the appropriate skills, board experience and knowledge to operate successfully at strategic level. Members who can bring significant relevant business and governance capability to the boardroom to complement the skills and knowledge of the existing directors, along with a good knowledge and understanding of clay target shooting, are particularly welcome. There is an expectation to attend board meetings, AGM's and Championships throughout the year to represent the CPSA Nationally and Regionally.

Eligible members may apply for one position only by using either the

online nomination process or the official nomination and pen portrait forms which can be downloaded from the CPSA website. If using the forms, once completed, they must be emailed to nominations@cesvotes.com and also copied to Ben.Halton@civica.co.uk or posted and marked FAO Ben Halton, Civica election Services, 33 Clarendon Road, London N8 0NW by 4pm on Friday 8th November 2024. Faxed copies will not be accepted. Nominees should ask for a written confirmation of receipt if required and provide either their email address or a stamped addressed envelope.

The nomination forms must carry the following information:

- Candidate's name and CPSA number
- The position applied for
- The names, CPSA numbers and original signatures of at least 10 individual members, all of whom must be aged 18 or above and current members of the CPSA.
- A current passport approved photo of the candidate
- A completed 'pen portrait' form of no more than 300 words, outlining the candidate's qualifications, experience and suitability for the strategic post

of legal director of the Association, which is also a company limited by guarantee. Please note that any written submission containing more than 300 words will be cut at 300 words, regardless of what follows.

A brief summary of the duties and responsibilities of a director and the code of conduct are available to download below.

- A daytime contact telephone number. Civica election Services must receive all original applications by the date specified. Any nominations received after this date will be discarded without exception. The following conditions apply:
 - There is no limit to the number of nominations for each position
 - All candidates must be over 18 years of age
 - All regional nominees must be resident in the region for which they are being nominated
 - Any nominations that are incomplete, do not comply with the above rules, or that, in the opinion of Civica Election Services following consultation with CPSA management, contain false or misleading information will be discarded
 - No extra publicity for any candidate will be permitted outside of his or her own 'pen portrait' in PULL! magazine or posted on the CPSA website.

CPSA AWARDS 2025 CHARITY

HEAD ON FOUNDATION CHARITY SHOOT

Friday 21 June saw the inaugural Head On Foundation Charity shoot and dinner with talks from experts on whisky and cigars and of course the all-important sampling. Bisley Shooting Ground was the venue, and it certainly didn't disappoint!

The Head on Foundation was recently started by 2003 rugby world cup winner Steve Thompson MBE. After Steve's diagnosis of early onset dementia and CTE in 2020, he saw there was a need to help people and their carers come to terms with this terrible diagnosis as getting help and financial support is not an easy path to navigate.

Ten teams roamed the stunning Cottesloe Heath course and had a Bisley instructor dispensing expert tuition, helping all levels of abilities through the 80-clay part of the competition before finishing on a competitive team flush. The first glimpses of our English summer proved thirsty work, so it was back to the Bisley shooting lodge for some cold beverages and to talk about how everyone had got on.

Before dinner Steve said a few words about the charity and its goals in supporting those living with and caring for people with brain injury, early-onset dementia, mental health conditions, and other neurological concerns. A sobering reminder of an often-invisible brain injury.



The dinner was fantastic and after dessert we were treated to talks from Joe Van Name, a Level 4 whisky sommelier and Sarah Saunders, the founder of International Women in Cigars. Ample free samples of the various Whiskies and cigars were enjoyed late into the night.

The Foundation would like to thank its very kind sponsors, Powder Monkey Brewery, Accuracy International, Bisley Shooting group, Hull Cartridges, Mcloys, Trident Cigars, Chateau Meaume Wines, Greenfields Gunmakers, IFX Currency Exchange, Engage Sporting Management, Inchcape Jaguar Land Rover and the CPSA for all their support.

The items donated for the silent auction were varied and some truly one of a kind. Our generous guests battled it out to raise in excess of £15,000 for the foundation.



The Instructor Development Workshop is a one-day course and a prerequisite to attending the four-day Level 1 Instructor Training Course. Candidates will be given an overview of the full

four-day course and be assessed for their suitability to progress onto the ITC. Candidates must have attended a Safety Officer Course.

This four-day course teaches you how to check eye dominance and gun fit. It shows you how to teach the CPSA Method, how to recognise shooting errors and how to correct them. It consists of classroom time, off-and on-range workshops and a final day

of assessments. For this course, the criteria for qualification is that the candidate can get a novice to hit a moving target safely using the CPSA Method. Candidates must have attended an IDW within the previous two years.

L2 Common Element & L2 CTC

£175/£495/£550

These are two three-day courses – the Common Element (£495) and the discipline specific Coach Training Course (£550). The Common Element now includes the three coach development workshops and allows seamless progression to the desired CTC in Trap, ESK or ESP. There are also three stand-alone CDW's (£175 per

CDW) available for those who have previously qualified as a L2 Coach, and wish to continue their coaching qualifications in a second or third discipline. They are designed to give you the technical skills to improve an established shooter. Candidates must be L1 Instructor qualified to attend L2 Courses.

ENGLISH OPEN AND BRITISH OPEN SINGLE BARREL

CPSA Chairman, **Dr John Martin**, reports from the North of England CTC.

The 2024 English Open and British Open Single Barrel Championships were held on 3-4 of August, respectively and hosted by North of England CTC.

The weather was fairly kind on both days, especially given the less than tropical climate we've been experiencing this year during, what's supposed to class as the summer months.

Saturday 3 August saw 54 competitors line up to contest the English Open Single Barrel title. By mid-afternoon the

scores were coming in thick and fast and it became obvious that they were going to be several shoot-offs for some of the positions.

Overall High Gun and the English Open title went to Richard Ryan with a score of 98. After a pause in Shooting for all the competitors to watch the women's Olympic Skeet final in which Amber Rutter won the Silver medal without, in many peoples opinion, actually losing the gold, Steve Janes and Lee Wilcoxson went into a shoot off for second and third place. Both Steve and Lee went clear in the first full round requiring them to shoot a second full round with the prospect of a sudden death final beginning to appear likely. The Lab and I settled in for the long haul with memories of the 2020 British Open, also held at the north of England CTC. At that championship, Jan Powell and Paul Turner shot two full rounds in a tiebreak and then went on to sudden death which felt as though it lasted for days, but was probably only about an hour and a half.

In the event, however, Steve dropped one target of the second full round to Lee's two, making Steve the runner-up overall and Lee Wilcoxson third.

Ladies, High Gun went to Caroline Whitehead on a score of 92 with granddaughter Ellie managing to keep it in the family by taking second place overall after a shoot off with Joanna Fairclough.

Edward Armett took the Junior High Gun title for the second year in succession with Ellie Whitehead being awarded the runner-up position.

With Opie looking on, (although you can never be quite sure exactly which direction Opie is looking in), Paul Chaplow shot 96 to take the Veterans High Gun and title with Ian Biggins coming runner-up and Caroline Whitehead adding another trophy to the families bag for the day by taking third place.

Lorriane Greening, having recovered from her wheelchair malfunctions during the Worlds, earlier in the year, took the Disabled Sitting High Gun title.

After overnight rain, strong sunlight heralded in Sunday the 4th of August and the commencement of the British

Open Single Barrel, again hosted by North of England CTC.

51 competitors contested the British Open Single Barrel with Paul Turner, of 2020 shoot off fame, brushing aside any question of a shoot off for this championship by taking overall High Gun on a perfect score of 100. Steve Janes although increasing his

English Open score by two points, had to settle for second place two days in a row with a score of 99 with Peter Ralph pulling out all the stops to add nine points to his previous days score and taking the British Open third place title.

Also adding nine points

to her previous Saturday score, Joanna Fairclough took the ladies High Gun on a score of 97 with Georgina Chamberlain scoring one point less, to secure the runner-up position. Following a shoot off with granddaughter Ellie, Caroline Whitehead took third place overall in the ladies championship.

As in the English the day before, Edward Armett took the Junior High Gun with an improved score of 94 with Ellie Whitehead also holding onto her second place position from Saturday again, with an improved score of 92.

Peter Ralph's third overall place score of 97 was sufficient to secure the Veteran High Gun title, by one point, from Ian Douglas who took the runner up title after a two full round shoot off with Nigel Chapman.

Lorriane Greening again secured the Disabled Sitting High Gun title.

Our thanks to everyone who took part and who stayed to support the shoot offs and prize-giving's and a special thanks to Brad and his team for hosting the event. 

BRITISH OPEN ENGLISH SPORTING

For Sporting clay shooters, 'The British' is the highlight of the year. The CPSA British Open English Sporting Championship, to use its full name, is the culmination of the Sporting clay season, held as summer turns to autumn each year, rotating around some of the finest grounds in the country. The prestigious title is always hotly contested, attracting around 1,000 entries that include the top shots in the sport – all of whom would love to collect the historic Daily Telegraph Cup, engraved with the names of legendary shooters going back to 1926, along with the sponsored prize of a Browning shotgun.

This year the event returned to the EJ Churchill ground at Swinton in North Yorkshire, a long trek for shooters in the south, but a refreshing change for those who live in the north of the country. Nearby pubs, hotels and B&Bs were packed with shooters, no doubt providing a welcome boost to the local economy.

The 'British' has its own unique format, making it more a marathon than a sprint. This can sometimes throw up an unexpected result: last time it was held at Swinton, in 2021, the title was won by Brody Woppard, a 20-year-old junior at the time.


The first stage is a 120-target qualifying course, run over four days to accommodate the large entry. This year the event began on Tuesday 27th August. The course was set by Jamie Peckham, assisted by the EJ Churchill team, with stands set out along the wooded valley uphill from the Swinton clubhouse – on the left of the track on the way out, then returning back down the other side. The stands made full use of the terrain and scenic setting, and offered a variety of interesting and challenging targets from high crossers and loopers to going-away teal and crossing rabbits.

As last time at Swinton, the field on the hill above the clubhouse was transformed into the hub of the shoot, with ample space for parking and a host of trade stands, food and drink, a marquee and bar, and the essential CPSA registration marquee where the office staff were kept busy throughout, checking shooters in, answering queries and updating scores which were simultaneously displayed on the large TV screens and posted by internet link to the CPSA website.

The area had a real festival atmosphere, as shooters relaxed and chatted before and after shooting. This was in no small way thanks to the event's sponsors: Browning, Eley, Swatcom, Le Chameau, Schöffel and Teague Precision Chokes, along with the support of Laporte.

There was even space to land a helicopter, and indeed a couple did arrive during the week, causing much speculation about who the passengers might be. I was assured, however, that neither was the personal transport of the CPSA Chief Executive, despite what EJ Churchill's Rob Fenwick claimed with a mischievous grin.

Day one started breezy, although the valley offered some protection. George Digweed set the pace, shooting an early 110 ex-120, which held





the lead for most of the day until Martin Myers, shooting in one of the later squads, overtook him with a 113. Leslie Rushford and Matt Bodfish tied in 3rd, both with 108 ex-120.

The structure of the competition means that each day the top five from each class (AAA – C) and top three from the categories of Senior, Veterans, Super Veterans, Ladies, Juniors and Colts are invited back for the 75-target final on Saturday. In the Disabled category, it is the top standing score and top sitting score plus the next best score regardless of standing or sitting per day to qualify. This system helps to even out any variation in the weather from one day to the next, so shooting in poor conditions doesn't make it any harder to qualify for the final.

Sure enough the next day, Wednesday 28th August, brought rain, although that didn't stop Phil Gray and John Lee topping the leaderboard with an impressive 112 ex-120, with Sam Usher close behind on 110, ensuring their places in Saturday's final. Thursday brought a welcome change in the weather, and the rest of the event was blessed with warm, dry and sunny conditions. You can never please everyone of course, and some shooters found targets towards the sun troublesome.

Nick Hendrick made his mark on the Thursday, leading the field for most of the day with 108 ex-120, along with Kevin Jobling on the same score. It was only at the end of the day that Billy Greenwood and Mark Winser posted last-minute scores of 110 ex-120 to take the lead. Nick also shot the highest score of 95 ex-100 on the British Open Sportrap which was running alongside the Sporting event; a score that would eventually see him win the Sportrap title after a shoot-off (see box). ▶



Day 4, the Friday, was the last day of qualification, and saw some impressive scores shot in the warm, sunny weather. High score of the day was 112 ex-120, shot by Henry Collins, closely followed by John Porter, Billy Baughan, and Stuart Emms, level on 111ex120. Billy Baughan also shot the Sporttrap on Friday, equalling Nick Hendrick's score from the previous day and forcing a shoot-off for that title.

With qualification over, the EJ Churchill team made busy and reset the targets for Saturday's final – a 75-target course following the same path up the valley, but with different stands and targets. The field had been whittled down to 157 shooters, and it was on these 75 targets that the classes and categories would be decided. Only the top six shooters would go through to the big showpiece super-final in the afternoon.

With all the razzmatazz of the super-final it is easy to overlook the achievements in classes and categories, but of course these are all notable in their own right. Full credit, then, to shooters such as Colts champion John Porter, Junior Joshua Poyser, Ladies Becky McKenzie, Veteran George Digweed, Super Veteran Martin Doughty, Disabled Sitting John Harrison and Disabled Standing Mark Delf. All these and more are listed in the full results (see box).

And so attention focused on the final six who would ▶

compete head-to-head for the grand title of British Open Sporting champion. First, however, we needed to separate the contenders for the sixth place. Richard Faulds, Martin Myers, Nick Hendrick, James Bradley-Day and Martin Doughty had all secured their places in the super-final, but there were no fewer than six shooters tied in sixth place on 66 ex-75. A shoot-off ensued, and Mark Winser joined the others in front of an eager crowd at the top of the hill behind the trade village – with a terrific view across the valley to the countryside beyond.

The six tackled three stands in all, in reverse order of their scores. Richard Faulds led the field with 69 ex-75, so shot last. He couldn't allow his concentration to falter though, with Martin Doughty hot on his heels with 68, and the remainder only a target or two behind.

For a moment it looked as if Richard might have given it away, missing two in the last two pairs of stand one. Stand two and he clawed his way back, and stepped on to the final stand still in the lead. The pressure was immense but Richard held his cool and held his lead. The final target was a distant crossing single, with full use of the gun. No-one else had hit it, Richard gave it his best shot, but the clay sailed on.

It didn't matter. Richard had done enough, and was the British Open Sporting Champion for the fifth time in his career, the first in 1998. Naturally he was over the moon. "It's the one everybody wants to win, it's the last major of the year, everyone was here to try and win it. To be honest, I didn't expect to come here and win it, and I'm absolutely delighted," he said.

Asked about shooting under the pressure of a super-final in front of a big crowd, he said: "I enjoy it, but you've got to try and switch off from that and just focus on what's in front of you, not what's behind you, and just try and keep your concentration on the targets, rather than everything else."

And what about that extreme last single target on stand three, how much lead did it actually need? "I've no idea because nobody broke it," Richard laughs. "Apparently Rob Fenwick was to blame for

that one, so we all wanted him to shoot at it but he flatly refused. I think it was on the limits of being breakable to be honest." Still, it had provided a talking point, given the spectators a heartstopping moment as they watched the top shots try their best, and in the end made no difference to the result.

And so with the setting sun bathing the ground in golden light,

we moved on to the prizegiving ceremony. A good number of spectators stayed behind to support and acknowledge the long list of class and category winners, providing a fitting end to proceedings before, with the last photograph taken and the last interview done, everyone headed off leaving the ground feeling strangely empty. It had been a splendid week, with all the challenge, drama and excitement you would expect from the last major

championship of the season – a credit to everyone who played a part in setting up the event, running it and participating.

It is of course important to acknowledge the contribution of the sponsors, without whom this sort of event simply couldn't happen. The referees, too, deserve special mention for their commitment and dedication to keeping the competition fair and running smoothly. One referee in particular was singled out for his outstanding service: Charlie Botham. This year's British Open marks the 30th year where Charlie has brought his dedication and skill as a referee to a major championship, and he received a special award to mark the occasion.





BRITISH OPEN SPORTRAP

The British Open Sporttrap was run alongside the British Open Sporting competition, with many competitors choosing to shoot both events on one day. This championship provided its own drama, with a gripping shoot-off to decide the title.

The Sporttrap layouts were set in the fields either side of the entrance to Swinton, in particularly picturesque countryside. Billy Cook led on the first day with an excellent 93 ex-100, with James Bradley-Day and Richard Bunning close behind on 92.

On day two, Scott Barnett, Jack Lovick, and Phil Gray all matched Billy Cook's 93, then on Thursday Nick Hendrick shot a superb 95 to take the lead. For a while that looked like giving him a clear win, but then on Friday Billy Baughan equalled his score, forcing a shoot-off for the top spot.

A crowd gathered to watch the battle, as Nick and Billy matched each other target-for target, until it went to sudden death. The toss of a coin decided that Nick would shoot first, and he hit both targets of the final pair. Under the pressure, Billy missed one and that was it – Nick was the champion. "It was a good shoot-off," commented Nick, who was delighted with his win. "Sudden death is never a good way to win, but it's the only way to do it." 🎣

GAUGING SUPPORT

FOR A NEW COMPETITION FORMAT AT BISLEY

Report from the event held on 14 August at Bisley Shooting Ground.

BISLEY
SHOOTING GROUND

The 12 gauge has long been the gold standard in clay shooting competitions, dominating the scene as the international gauge of choice. However Bisley Shooting Ground hosted a Sub-Gauge Sporting Competition, celebrating the often-overlooked smaller gauges and offering a fresh twist to traditional clay shooting – proving that smaller calibres have a lot to offer.

Recognizing the untapped potential of smaller gauges, this was a chance for shooters to try their hand with lightweight .410, 28 gauge, and 20 gauge shotguns. Traditionally seen as tools for the game shooting field or for newcomers seeking a gentler recoil, these smaller gauges were given their time to shine in a competitive format, challenging the notion that bigger is always better.

THE WINNERS

The competition was fierce across all categories, with shooters pushing their skills to the limit on a course designed to test the capabilities of each gauge. Congratulations to the winners:

- Three Gun Overall Champion: Tom Pargetter, who shot an impressive 130 across all three gauges, taking home the £150 cash prize.

- High Gun .410: Pat Bolton, demonstrating remarkable accuracy with a score of 45, securing £50 cash and a free CPSA membership.
- High Gun 28 Gauge: Gary Bevan, narrowly claiming victory with a score of 49, also winning £50 cash and a CPSA membership.
- High Gun 20 Gauge: Tim King, winning on countback with a score of 42, earning the same rewards.

Sponsored by Rizzini, the competition provided not only an exciting day of shooting but also valuable prizes, encouraging more shooters to explore the potential of these smaller gauges.



A NEW ERA FOR SUB-GAUGE SHOOTING

This competition is more than just a one-off event; it represents a shift towards inclusivity in clay shooting. Smaller gauges offer a less intimidating entry point for younger, female, and lighter-framed shooters while providing seasoned veterans with a new challenge. In fact, many game shooters prefer the 28 or 20 bore for their fieldwork and welcomed the opportunity to compete with their guns of choice.

In the U.S., sub-gauge events are already an integral part of major competitions, offering a range of challenges that appeal to a broad



spectrum of shooters. The format is popular not only because it's physically less demanding, but also because it brings new strategic elements to the sport. The .410 is often regarded as a more challenging gauge for its precision requirements. American shooters have embraced the flexibility of using a single gun with drop-in tubes to switch between gauges, a trend that could soon catch on in the UK.

The success of Bisley's event, along with other competitions in this format which are starting to take place around the country, suggests that there's a growing appetite for sub-gauge competitions in the UK. These events offer shooting grounds an additional source of income while encouraging shooters to spend more time at the grounds, benefitting the local economy and sponsors alike.

LOOKING AHEAD

With such a positive response to this competition, there's hope that sub-gauge events will become a regular feature in the UK's competitive shooting calendar. For now, though, we can reflect on a fantastic day of shooting at Bisley, where the small but mighty .410 and its siblings proved they're more than capable of holding their own on the clay circuit.

As the dust settles and the final scores are posted, one thing is clear: the future of clay shooting in the UK might just be a little bit smaller – and that's a good thing.

REVIEW

THE REAL STOCK PRO V2 ULTIMATE

With the continued interest in VR shooting for training and practice **Mark Brown** looks at another VR gunstock on the market from Texture VR.

REAL STOCK PRO V2 ULTIMATE

The Real Stock Pro V2 is a very interesting design as it gets even closer to a standard sporting shotgun by utilising real wood for both the stock and fore-end so it looks and feels incredibly comfortable. The product was first launched in its first iteration back in 2021 and developed in conjunction with Clay Hunt VR with further enhancements and features added for the Version 2 which launched last year. It's interesting to note that this product was created with several worldwide competitive shooters who were beta testers of both the Real Stock Pro and the Clay Hunt VR simulator. Essentially this has been developed by clay shooters for clay shooters.

The Real Stock Pro arrives partially assembled with only a few extra parts needing to be added to it before you are up and running. The instructions that it ships with are very clear and concise and it's worth reading through all of them in detail to make sure that you get the very best from it. As the Real Stock Pro uses both controllers of the Meta Quest it is important to make sure that you get the left and right controllers into the right part of the gun. This took me a few moments to get right!

We tested the Ultimate variation which includes the adjustable comb, butt pad and weight kit as well as the other standard parts for adjustment which I will come on to shortly but there is a lot to tinker with on this model but spending time doing this

leads to a far better shooting experience. After some initial adjustments we were underway shooting, and the Real Stock Pro really does bring the Clay Hunt VR simulation to life.

The real walnut wood stock feels both comfortable and natural to hold and mount and it's easy to forget when you have the headset on that you don't have your shotgun in your hand. The real wood fore-end is a lovely touch too. There is the option to adjust the comb length via spacers in the butt pad, length of pull via two thumb screws on the bottom

rail and an adjustable comb too – effectively you can have a completely bespoke gun fitting option here.

There is also a micro weight kit included that allows you to add weights wherever you need them on the gun stock to both match the weight of your shotgun and also give you the correct balance. The Real Stock Pro weighs in at 5.9lbs including the two controllers and with all weights added can take it up to just over 10lbs but you can fine tune between these two with 1oz increments. I started out with a weight and balance that mirrored almost exactly my favourite clay shooting shotgun but must admit that I did end up reducing the weight quite substantially. The reason being that using the gun stock and Clay Hunt simulation is so addictive that you end up using it for hours and shooting far more clays than you ever would do in real life. The net result is

terrible fatigue and aching arms! But, with a slightly lighter weight set up (around 7lbs) I was able to shoot comfortably for as long as I wanted to.

The base level Real Stock Pro V2 retails at £194 with the Ultimate kit it adds an additional £62. You can purchase the weights, adjustable comb or adjustable butt pad separately if you feel you only need some of the elements to the Ultimate kit rather than all of it, all options are clearly explained on the website. As Texture VR are based in the USA you may find that you have to pay import duty and VAT on these prices so be aware of that when purchasing.

If you are considering a VR solution for your practice/training at home, then it is worth checking out the Real Stock Pro V2.



PASSION FOR OUR SPORT



Eight times Helice world champion, **Dionne Rogers** came into shooting through an after-school job and hasn't looked back since, as she explains to **Alex Sayer**.

Based in Chris Potter's Country Sports shop since day one, interviews with Dionne are rare but here she speaks out about her experience as a woman rising to the top in one of clay shooting's quirkiest disciplines.

Helice is known as ZZ because of the sound the targets make as they whirr away into the distance. The name also has links to the heritage of the sport, as the first ZZ targets were made of zinc and imitated the zurrito, a particularly tricky pigeon used in live pigeon shooting. A mix of skill and fortune, Helice demands that not only must the white centre be separated from the orange wings by the impact, but that the heavier white middle component must fall within an established boundary.

This condition is incidental compared to the real challenge of Helice, the clever and unique design of the target makes their flightpath entirely unpredictable. Even when you know which trap the bird is coming from due to the panel dropping down, you still don't know which direction it will go. This lulls competitors into a false sense of security, only to catch them out on both the hold and the break point and, if great care isn't taken, one can very often end up moving the gun in the opposite way to which the wily bird is going

IN THE BEGINNING...

A real champion for the discipline, Dionne tells us how it all began for her. "It was just an after-school job really, serving tea and coffee to staff and the customers that came into Chris Potter's Country Sports. Then it became a Saturday job." At such a young age neither Dionne nor Chris Potter could have envisaged the success she was to have in her future. She became a trapper at the (now closed) Lidsing ground at the top of Bloxley Hill.

The ground in those days had just two layouts. One skeet layout and an Automatic Ball Trap (ABT) layout. It was here that Dionne first shot ABT and fell in love with shooting. Rather than receive a wage for her trapping, Dionne learnt a valuable skill and was able to shoot for free. Honing her skills and target acquisition, she became a force to be reckoned with.

Then Chris Potter acquired a sporting ground at Detling Showground in Maidstone just less than an hour away from his shop in Tunbridge Wells where it stands to this day. Dionne was 16 by this time and was looking forward to being able to drive. After passing her test she was swiftly promoted to delivery driver. Dropping off clays, traps, parts and orders became a full-time job, and Dionne still works side by side with Chris in the Tunbridge Wells shop and has done since the day she left school.

THE IMPORTANCE OF GUN FIT

The shop specialises in shotguns catering for the clay and game market. Gun fit is paramount, and Chris organises regular trips to the Perazzi and Beretta factories in Italy. Furthermore, they are the exclusive UK importers for a little-known Italian brand called Salvinelli, with whom they can offer a custom model for an off-the-shelf price. Due to the extensive level of understanding of gun fit that the staff, including Dionne, possess, you can get measured up there and your dimensions are sent over and a custom stock fitted to the action of your choice, for the same price.

In the days when Dionne started shooting, a custom stock wasn't such an easy option. With a standard 682 from Gunmark, she achieved six world championships. She shot that Beretta for 25 years and it is still in her cabinet today. She shoots a DT11L now, but speaks so fondly of the 682 which was also favoured by the likes of George Digweed and Barry Simpson.

THE BENEFIT OF HINDSIGHT

Talking of her sporting success I get the feeling she is enjoying it far more in

retrospect: "If only I had seen what I was doing, I could have used it to pave the way more for women."

Speaking of Team GB's success in the recent Olympics, Dionne goes on to praise Amber Rutter and Nathan Hales for the excellent exposure they have given to our sport. Dionne has had a hand in Nathan's shooting journey and her time in the shop means she has helped a great many athletes on their way. Being on the competition circuit, both locally and internationally, means

she understands the sport and the challenges the competitors face.

As for being a woman in the sport she describes herself as feeling "incredibly lucky" because she has "never felt belittled in any way or during any competition because I'm a girl."

Dionne's sporting career is showing no signs of slowing down. She has recently started shooting ABT again and also won the English Open Ladies Helice championship this year. Having been so heavily involved in clay shooting for so long she encourages anyone to give it a go or get in touch.

The connection to the shop means she is a great contact for anyone, from beginners to budding Olympians. Although she does admit some people still come in the shop asking to "talk to one of the men" which used to bother her, but she says with a laugh: "These days if someone says that I'm more than happy to pass them on."

WINNING HEARTS AND MINDS

The Olympics delivered great success for the Team GB shooters and **Anita North** reflects on their memorable performances.

Well, 2024 has been a year to remember. The Paris Olympics saw four CPSA members (Amber Rutter, Lucy Hall, Matthew Coward Holley and Nathan Hales) representing Team GB in the clay shooting events. All four of them demonstrate the highest level of dedication and commitment to their sport and make me proud to be associated with clay shooting.

Lucy was competing in Paris while still a Junior and unforgettably both Nathan and Amber finished their events on the podium, as Matthew did at Tokyo 2020.

I think it's worth emphasising that it is an incredible achievement to have anyone even representing our country in the Olympics.

The places for the clay shooting events are very tightly capped and it takes a tremendous team effort to get one athlete to the greatest show on earth. So, for Team GB to have four competitors there was a triumph in itself.

There are only 30 spots in each event and every quota place must be earned at one of the ISSF list of competitions during the selection period. The competition is fierce and takes an astronomical amount of planned and detailed work for each individual. I cannot stress how much sheer effort is involved, and that's why anyone who gets to an Olympics deserves our highest praise.

TRAILBLAZING AMBER

Amber qualified for the Tokyo Olympics back in 2021, but heartbreakingly couldn't go because she tested positive for Covid just before departure. So this was her first time pulling the trigger at the main event, and she demonstrated a very



cool head under extreme pressure to come away with the silver medal. The magnitude of her achievement is amplified by the fact that she is a very new mum. Her son Tommy was born in April of this year, so Amber did not have months of preparation time. However, she is a seasoned competitor, having amassed some 27 medals in individual and team events at ISSF competitions since collecting her first gold in 2013 at the tender age of 15 years old.

She is the first woman to bring home a medal in a shooting event for Team GB and her medal is GB's first ever in Skeet.

In addition, the way in which she dealt with the media attention before and after the Olympics was exemplary. As a new mum there were interviews to be conducted before the Games, then came the frenzy of attention after winning a silver but seeming to be the victim of an injustice. A controversial refereeing decision during her shoot-off might have sent some shooters into an absolute rage, but Amber handled it with grace and dignity and came out smiling, like a true champion sportsperson. I am sure she won the hearts of an incredible number of people outside our sport.

GOLDEN MOMENTS

The gold medal that Nathan Hales so memorably won in the baking heat of Chateauroux on that Tuesday afternoon in late July is the result of relentless hard work, preparation, resilience and perseverance. Nathan secured a quota for GB by taking silver at the World Championships in 2022, and after that ►

he worked diligently to ensure his competition readiness for the Olympics.

And remember, Paris was his first time at the Olympics. You wouldn't have guessed that watching him barely blink as he set a new Olympic record on his dominant route to gold. His remarkable composure throughout surely had an impact on his competitors on the day. There didn't appear to be a chink in his armour.

A LIFE CHANGING MEDAL

As you can imagine, life has been hectic since the return from Paris for both our medallists, but I managed to have a quick word with Nathan to find out how things have been since Paris. "I feel absolutely on top of the world since I have returned from the Olympics. I don't think I have really realised quite what I have achieved yet, and I'm not sure I will for some time yet. I was so happy to be able to win in front of my family and friends. I think it is going to

be completely life changing for me and my family."

As mentioned above, even getting to the Olympics is the result of a mammoth team effort and to win gold is the pinnacle of the sport, so I wanted to give Nathan the chance to mention

a few people who have helped him along the way: "Thank you so much to everyone who has been part of the journey: my coach Marco Micheli, Ed and Nicky Barker at Nuthampstead Shooting Ground, Beretta and GMK, Promatic, Clever Mirage Cartridges, SWATCOM, De.La.Ro Glasses, Chris Potter and Dionne Rogers at Chris Potter Country Sports, my partner Charlotte, mum (Stella) and dad (Colin).

"I would also like to thank my mentor/coach Peter Wilson (the Team GB Olympic Trap gold medallist from London 2012), stocker Ugo Sabatti, the late Kevin Gill, Martin Barker, British Shooting, UK Sport and National Lottery Funding.


When I asked Nathan if he had a message for CPSA members, especially anyone relatively new in the sport, he said: "I think more people should come and try the Olympic disciplines, especially juniors. British Shooting's Pathway programme is a great way to get into the disciplines and learn how to shoot them under good guidance. But most of all enjoy your shooting!"

ROLL ON LOS ANGELES

It truly was a glorious summer and once again a big thank you to all the Team GB shooters and massive congratulations to Amber and Nathan for their incredible Olympic medals. I don't know about you, but I am most certainly looking forward to the coming years and the lead up to the next Olympic Games – roll on Los Angeles in 2028. 🏴





FALCON PRO RIACT



Richard Worthington reviews the Falcon Pro RIACT shooting glasses from Ranger.

I never need an excuse to go shooting, so when I was asked to review the Falcon Pro RIACT shooting glasses from Ranger who was I to argue!

On the day in question, I took the opportunity to shoot the Bisley Shooting Ground Sub-Gauge competition (as reported on page 30) on a purely targets only basis using my trusty 12 gauge. The weather conditions at the time were about 23°, overcast and humid, so I opted for the Falcon Pro RIACT A.I.™ FN72.ML Mid Light Lens, having found this the most suitable lens for brown/green backgrounds shooting English Sporting in a woodland setting.

The Frame comes in two sizes, Small (64mm) and Large (72mm) and is sealed with CombatCoat™, an ultra-resilient ceramic coating that surpasses abrasion and wear testing, corrosion and chemical resistance, and handles most weather conditions.

The aerodynamic and stylish lens shape covers a large overall facial surface providing a clear field of view and there is a minimalist nosepiece with virtually zero visual obstruction. The RIACT A.I. lens offer enhanced depth perception which separates the target from the background, and precious metals boost target colours to enhance focus. The Mid Light Lens I used keeps colours natural, highlights orange and offers 52% light transmittance through the lens.

The lens clips to the frame very easily and is therefore very easy to swap should the conditions change during the day. I particularly liked the slim bayonet arms, which fit very comfortably under the gel ear-seals of my Swatcom hearing protection, creating a snug fit with negligible break in the seal around my ears. Also, the glasses sit quite high on the face, with a built-in sweat-bar to help prevent fogging, so the frame is well above my eyeline, and I really didn't notice it all.

Overall, I was very impressed and if you are in the market for a new set of shooting glasses then I would certainly recommend these.

Sporting Targets High Tower Challenge 2024






Results of the Inter County ABT competition – well done to our Ladies and Junior teams for winning their respective categories.






