



excellent 24 to Mike's 22. Guy took the Runner-

up spot but Mike had done enough to secure top place in the Masters category.

Scores in the classed and other categories were all very close. Philip Marks won A Class on 131 from William Page on countback. Chip Smith won B Class on 131 from Emma Stacy on countback. Barry Green won C Class on 126. Mark Doyal won D Class on 119. Emma Stacy, William Page and Chip Smith all scored 131 to take the Ladies, Juniors and Veterans titles respectively.

Thundering out of the stalls on day one with 98ex100 was Duane Mculloch to lead the Veteran's High Gun, alongside David Lloyd, Adam Gutteridge, and Nick McCarthy of Northern Ireland. The standard of shooting was particularly high with eight scores above 95 for the English Senior team. 





The OVER-TUNDER

To the chagrin of traditionalists the favoured barrel alignment has switched over the years, and **Alex Sayer** speaks to an expert to find out why.

arl Langton is a gunsmith and fitter perhaps best known for taking care of Peter Wilson's gun in the run up to the 2012 London Olympics when Peter won gold in the Double Trap.
Carl (the Langton in Ladbrook & Langton gunmakers in Hertfordshire) likes

to work closely with customers to help them improve their shooting. For example, when people are struggling with a left to right crosser he can just pop some cast on the stock or maybe add a bit of weight in the back.

He puts a lot of his success down to the fact that when someone calls the shop to make an enquiry, they are talking to the actual gunsmith. This is a distinctive feature that avoids anything getting lost in translation which is more common than one may think.

With a passion for his trade and for the way the guns he works on perform in the field he knows as much as anyone about the relative performance values of our tools of the trade over the centuries. Nobody can deny that the late 20th century and the first 24 years of the 21st have seen the over-under take centre stage in almost every shotgun shooting scenario.

Carl makes the pertinent point that entrants to the sport are almost exclusively handed an over-under for 'have-a-go' experiences at shooting grounds or outdoor shows. This also applies to corporate days and hen and stag parties, which goes some way to explain the social rise of the over-under the fashion if you will.

THE APPEAL OF THE OVER-UNDER

Here we delve deeper into the added benefits, workings, components and attributes of the over-under which have

helped this style of gun finds its way into the majority of cabinets the length and breadth of the land.

The evolution of the over-under began in 1909 when Thomas Boss offered the first breech loading over-under. Edwinson Green followed suit two years later, and in 1913 the acclaimed Woodward version was born, and is still desirable to this day.

John Moses Browning introduced the B25 in 1925, with Beretta's first over-under later released in 1933. So the development of the over-under happened rapidly in the first part of the 20th century, but it has taken much longer to get where we are today with vertical barrel alignment overtaking the sale and manufacture of side-by-sides around the world.

UNDERNEATH THE BONNET

Carl highlights the fact that mechanically, things haven't changed much at all over the years. "Most over-unders are very similar in design and you only have to look at how close the B525 is to the B25 to see this. Most over-unders are powered by coil springs which are cheap to manufacture and replace, but some of the more premium guns still use a traditional leaf spring."

Generally speaking, the guns of today have single selective triggers which tend to be selected from the switch on the safety catch. However, there are some exceptions, such as continental guns like the Franchi or indeed the AYA Yeoman which have the selector switch attached to the trigger.

A core feature of the over-under is indeed the single trigger. Some rely on recoil to initiate the selection from one barrel to the other and some triggers are totally mechanical, meaning no reliance on recoil to pick up the second shot.

Another feature of the over-under is they almost all have ejectors. Browning

and Miroku guns have free floating ejectors on the barrels with 'hammers' powered by coil springs in the fore-end. When activated these fly forward and hit the ejectors. Other manufacturers such as Perazzi or Beretta have sprung ejectors in the barrels which are put under tension and 'tripped' when the gun is fired.

RESULTS DON'T LIE

The main advantage of an over-under for the shooter is the narrower sight plane. This is what makes the real difference, and in layman's terms it means it is far easier to pick up the target. Of course, advocates and exponents of the sideby-side argue for and demonstrate its capabilities on a regular basis, however the Olympic podiums don't lie. When it comes to pure measurable performance, there is no doubting the superiority of the newer style. If you are a traditionalist and that makes you wince, then fear not – the side-by-side is not obsolete, but you might be able to pick up some very good value second hand examples on the auction market.

Beyond the performance advantage, over-unders are also that bit heavier which of course helps keep the gun steady and reduce recoil. Another reason they are so popular for beginners. Nothing sends someone away from clay shooting more quickly than a painful impact to the shoulder, followed by a colourful bruise.

Furthermore, with the over-under there is the flexibility to do a proper gun fit and adjust the comb, and enjoy a variety of fore-ends, grips and stock shapes. If you get all this right it makes an unbelievable difference to your target acquisition and subsequently, your score.

Carl truly believes the over-under is part of the evolution of shooting and enjoys watching some of the manufacturers tear up the design rulebook: "For instance, Longthorne and Benelli are two gun companies doing things differently."

From his point of view as a gunsmith, Carl enjoys both over-under and sideby-side repairs and gun fits, because it presents variety in the job.



QTell us about your links with gunmakers and customers?

We manufacture a range of chokes from flush to extended and super extended and supply versions for all major brands. We work closely with many manufacturers, such as Browning, Miroku and Caesar Guerini. Our relationship with the gunmakers is an integral part of ensuring our customers continue to benefit from the best performance delivered by Teague Chokes.

We attend game fairs, competitions and

championships all through the year and these events are perfect for promoting our products and letting the shooters try the chokes. But beyond that it's a brilliant opportunity for us to listen to customer feedback, learn about new developments, identify trends in the market and understand what might work best.

What has been your best selling product this year?

During the clay season, extended and super extended chokes are very popular. Sporting shooters in particular analyse the distance of the targets and work out which choke will be appropriate for that range.

During the game season customers tend to want flush chokes, because it's not so desirable to have visible extended chokes on a game day. Game shooters also want light barrels, so titanium chokes are very popular for that market.

How do you approach research and design for new products?

com Again we work with a lot of the manufacturers. For instance we have a great relationship with Matt Panter at Caesar Guerini which involves regular contact; all with a view to maximising performance of the gun and choke combination. And this goes for the likes of Browning, Miroku and GMK as well. Another example of the way we look at development is the Parcours choke which came about after a visit to the Krieghoff factory with Alan Rhone.

What impact will steel shot have?

Of course the advent of steel shot will have an impact, and we have undertaken extensive research. For instance, in collaboration with Hull Cartridge, we booked an underground test centre and spent a couple of days pattern testing steel shot for penetration and distance fall out. We work with all the major cartridge producers to ensure our customers continue to enjoy the best possible performance from their kit when they are out shooting. Obviously, for steel it's a different choke and must be more open. Ultimately,

Obviously, for steel it's a different choke and must be more open. Ultimately, steel shot will be fine, but it has limitations in terms of range. Therefore shooters will have to understand that and alter their expectations accordingly.

QDo you have shooters who help you to promote and develop new ideas?

Richard Faulds and Peter Wilson both won the Olympics using our products. Richard has a multi-choke gun, and he has helped us develop the super cylinder for those horrible floppy short-range targets.

George Digweed who has a selection of fixed barrels which we have regulated to his cartridge choice.

But it's not all about the big names. We believe in supporting

the next generation, and that's why we support up-and-coming shooters like Billy Greenwood who has just made the England team for the first time.

QHow often should people change their chokes?

Sporting shooters like to analyse the targets on each stand and change the choke accordingly. But the real question here is how often should you clean your chokes and check them for damage? We have noticed in the past few years that we have had a lot more damaged barrels and chokes from all manufacturers, due to them not being checked and cleaned regularly or fitted correctly. We recommend chokes to be checked after every stand and taken out and cleaned after every shoot.

What has your support for the CPSA entailed?

We support the CPSA at all the major events with our products. The CPSA is essential and it's a pleasure to work with them. They work very hard for all their members and for the development of clay shooting. I have been shooting for more than 30 years and absolutely love it. We will continue to support the CPSA for all forthcoming events.

REVIEW

FALCONSTRIKE RECOIL REDUCTION

This month Mark Brown steps into the world of equipment beyond the gun.

This month we are looking at the issue of recoil and an exciting product called FalconStrike that works to lessen the effects of recoil fatigue and issues around flinching when shooting.

Many of us shoot with no issues or concern around recoil but for those that do it is a huge issue and any product that can address this problem should be looked upon very favourably. Over the years we have reviewed a number of products to help with recoil, but the FalconStrike seems to approach it from a different perspective and actually uses technology from the aerospace industry to achieve its impressive performance.

This product has got to be a game changer for anyone having issues with recoil

So, what is in this device and how exactly does it work? When you pick up the FalconStrike the first thing that you notice is that when pressing down on it it's very malleable and that is because it is filled with a hydraulic fluid, and this ensures that the gun moulds to your body shape rather than your body altering to fit the gun stock, and this is the first imperative step in reducing felt recoil. The elastic bladder that holds the fluid then expands by around 10% when the gun is fired spreading the energy produced by the recoil to a larger surface area. Lastly, there is an energy conversion dampener (used on aircraft landing gear) that converts peak force into heat that then gets distributed evenly at the point of contact.

So that's the science but what does that relate to in real world shooting? Well, the manufacturer

claims up to 80% less recoil energy, 35% less muzzle flip, 25% less peak force and 35% less rock back. It's always going to be hard to translate these numbers into what it feels like but having fitted it to one of my "lumpier" guns I can say that there was an impressive difference in what it was like to shoot and that is from someone who does not have any issue with recoil at this time. There is no doubt that it takes a massive edge off the impact you feel when shooting and I can see that using it permanently on your gun has got to allow you to shoot for longer as your body is not soaking up all that recoil energy.

This product has got to be a game changer for anyone having issues with recoil either because of a shoulder or neck injury or from excessive shooting. It is a low investment cost (£195) and really quick and easy to fit so a no brainer to give it a try. I could also see a massive use for the FalconStrike on starter guns at clubs and grounds to reduce that initial "shock" when newcomers start shooting for the first time. Anything that makes that first experience as pleasant as possible gets my vote every time.
