

The selection procedure for the England Sporting Team of 15 Seniors, 2 Ladies, 2 Juniors (under the age of 21 on the day of the H/I) and 2 Veterans (60 and over on the date of the H/I) to compete in the Home International Tournament to be held in Jersey, on Saturday 12th September 2009 is as follows:

Applicants are to submit their best four scores from the seven designated shoots below, one of which must be from either the British Open 2008, or the English Open Championship 2009. The points system of selection will be used. The points achieved at the English Open will be used to decide any ties for last place(s). Should a tie still exist, the lowest points achieved at the last selection shoot attended by all tied parties will decide the place.

- White collared shirt or blouse
