Over recent months it has become apparent that we need to remind a few shooting grounds and individual members of some of the basic rules of organising or entering Registered Shoots.

- Scores for all entries must be submitted to the CPSA electronically within 7 days of the shoot.
- If you retire from shooting part way through a shoot, for whatever reason, your scorecard must still be handed in and the ground must submit your score out of the amount of targets attempted (e.g. by round or stand).
- 'Targets Only' scores must still be returned to CPSA for classification purposes. This just means that you will not be entitled to any prize fund available.
- Non submission of score cards will result in your name/club name being listed on the CPSA website as per Booklet 5 rule1.20
- Master score cards must be used for English Sporting shoots and clubs must submit scores from these if scorecards are missing.
- Once a registered shoot has commenced no coaching or tuition is permitted at shooting stands or during a round.
- Hearing and Eye Protection is compulsory and must be used while shooting, refereeing, scoring, trapping, officiating in any capacity, or spectating near the shooting stands
- Viewing of targets within cages is not permitted.
- No practice is permitted on competition layouts until the prize-giving has been completed.
- Clubman members entering a registered shoot do so on a 'have a go' basis only and will not be part of the competition, whether at their nominated shooting ground or by purchasing a day pass elsewhere. This facility is designed to allow Clubman members to experience registered competition shooting with a view to upgrading to full competition membership.
- Classifications: -
 - New members are entitled to request a temporary classification certificate to be issued to them once they have shot a minimum of 300 registered targets in any given discipline.
 - Members can only gain or move up in classification once they have registered a minimum of 100 targets during the scores period and must have registered a minimum of 300 targets to move down a class (which is further restricted to one class per 12 month period).
