GENERAL INFORMATION

1. DATE OF THE EVENT

28 – 30 October 2016

2. COMPETITION PROGRAMME

The International Grand Prix will be scheduled as follows:

27	Oct.	Arrival of participants
28	Oct.	Classification tests and Pre event Training
29	Oct.	Competition Day 1 (75 targets)
30	Oct.	Competition Day 2 (50 targets) + Finals

3. PARTICIPATION – EVENTS – CATEGORIES

Events: **TRAP SHOOTING**

Cat.: Standing (StCS – 1, 2); Sitting (SiCS) - See enclosed Proposed Classification Document

4. RULES AND REGULATIONS

The competition will be conducted in accordance with the ISSF Rules and Regulations.

5. ENTRY PROCESS

Registration Forms for the athletes and Officials must be sent directly to the FITAV Headquarters.

6. LOCATION AND VENUE

The competition will take place at the “T.A.V. Accademia Lombarda” Shooting Range in Battuda (PV – Italy), a modern and advanced shooting complex equipped with **6** ranges (Trap/Double Trap). The ranges are oriented to the North. The Club is situated at a distance of approx. 15 km from Milan, not far from the Brescia district, the golden area of the historical gun manufacturing companies.

Arrival “T.a.v. Accademia Lombarda” can be reached:

By plane: Milan Linate (40 km), Milan Malpensa (72 km) or Orio al Serio (86 km).

Catering: The Shooting Club has full restaurant facilities that can offer meals, lunch, dinner, snacks and refreshments, at very reasonable prices.

Training: The ranges will be available for unofficial trainings prior to the competition every day from Monday to Friday.



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7. ENTRY VISAS

European Union Nationals possessing a valid passport or Identity Card can enter Italy without any problem. As for non-European Union participants, they are advised to check the matter of visas well in advance and apply to F.I.T.A.V. - Federazione Italiana Tiro a Volo, e-mail: internazionale@fitav.it for the required nominative invitation letter **no later than August 30th 2016**. These applicants must contact the nearest Italian Embassy/Consulate to apply for a Sport Visa.

8. GUN LICENCE, POLICE AND CUSTOMS FORMALITIES

A maximum of three shotguns and 1.000 cartridges are allowed to enter in Italy. European Union Citizens are advised to obtain the necessary EU Firearms Certificate which allows them to travel and dispatch with ease the Police formalities at the Italian Border/airport. As for the other shooters (non-European Union) the Italian Shooting Federation, upon receipt of the "Firearms and Ammunition" form duly filled, will send a special form (**FITAV** permit) to be shown at custom controls. The same procedure must be repeated upon departure from Italy, returning the form at custom controls: at the Border if they travel by car or at the airport in case they travel by plane.

Police and Customs firearms formalities will take place upon arrival at the first airport on the Italian Territory and upon departure.

9. WEAPON SECURITY TAX

At departure from Italy, according to the different Carriers and destinations, passengers will be charged a "Weapon Tax" for each gun. This fee varies from one Company to another and is subject to changes at any time in accordance with the Carrier's rules.

10. ARRIVAL, ASSISTANCE, AIRPORT PICK UP

The Official Airports are MILAN LINATE (LIN), MILAN MALPENSA (MXP) and ORIO AL SERIO (BGY). Assistance upon arrival/departure and transfers for international athletes and staff will be offered for free from FITAV upon early notice from the participating delegations.

Any athlete planning his/her trip on other dates than the official arrival/departure scheduled days will have to make own arrangements for the transfers.

11. LOCAL TRANSPORTATION

The Organizing Committee will provide for all participants free round trip transportation from the Official hotel to the range as from **Oct. 27, 2016**.

13. INFORMATION ON RANGE EQUIPMENT

The Trap ranges are equipped with “Mattarelli” (90 machines). The targets used during the International Grand Prix will be “Eurotarget” from Italy: standard orange for Qualification rounds, flash for Finals

14. AMMUNITION

The Italian Customs Authority will allow all participating shooters to import with them a maximum of 1.000 cartridges (per shooter) which will be used for the competition. The use of steel pellets is not allowed. A wide range of local and international ammunition will be available for sale at the shooting club. *Shooters travelling by air, on departing from Italy will be allowed to re-export a maximum quantity of 125 cartridges only, packed into a single ammunition case which must not exceed 5 Kg. in weight, provided that the quantity declared on arrival into Italy, is in excess of this amount.*

15. STORAGE OF GUNS AND AMMUNITION

Storage of guns and ammunition will be available at the armoury on shooting range. Shooters are also allowed to take their shotguns in the hotel room.

16. ENTRY AND TRAINING FEES

Entry fee per shooter and/or official is free of charge

Training per round of Trap (25 targets) **Euro 6,50**

17. JURY OF APPEAL, JURY, RANGE REFEREES

Jury and Jury of Appeal that will be designated by FITAV will supervise the competition. Qualified Range Referees holding a valid official ISSF Shotgun Referee license will officiate at the competition.

18. EQUIPMENT CONTROL

The equipment control will be carried out at the shooting range on the day as the pre-event training for that discipline takes place.

19. CEREMONIES

The Technical Meeting will take place at the shooting range on October 28th, 2016.

Award Ceremonies: will take place 15 minutes after the last final is completed.

20. WEATHER INFORMATION

The climatic conditions in September are normally mild. The average temperatures are expected to be 12°/15° degrees Celsius during the day and 8°/10° during the night.
